County Pushing Case Against Duncan

Not Suspended Yet, He Says

W. Hugh Duncan, already in trouble with the State of Florida, is in for even more trouble with Seminole County. County Attorney Harold Johnson told The Herald today preliminary work is proceeding to recover some \$5,000 in overcollections by the peace justice from the county.

Meanwhile, no official word has been received from Tallahassee on the suspension. Duncan said today, and none is expected before the first part of next week.

Peace Justice Al Davis reports he has not received official confirmation of his appointment to the Duncan post or who is in line for appointment to his office in the South Seminole district.

Johnson said that the state comptroller's office and state county officials advised him in March of this year that deficiencies in the audit period from Sept. 1, 1961 to May 31, 1966 in Judge Duncan's accounts should be collected by the county.

"I was told to institute such action deemed necessary—administrative or legal—to collect the funds," Johnson said. "This is a civil matter like any other lawsuit."

The county attorney explained that he has been conducting the required investigations and that "I will determine in my best judgment the proper time for filing suit if filing a suit is necessary."

Johnson said that considerable investigation has taken place and that he has held a number of conferences with Duncan's attorney, Gordon Frederick.

Word of Duncan's pending suspension case Wednesday when Frederick reported receipt of a communication from the governor's office telling Duncan to either resign or be suspended. Duncan refused the governor's "kind invitation" and determined to make a fight of it.

Duncan has maintained that his office had not exceeded its jurisdiction in certain cases and thus funds collected were done so legally. Duncan told The Herald early last year that he planned to take the suit report to court for a determination.

City To Get Utility Study

A study of water and sewerage needs for the Sanford-Seminole area made by Clark Diets and Associates will be submitted to the City Commission on Monday will be a definitive study based on projected population needs.

The City paid the firm \$5,000 for the study and some \$100,000 is budgeted for the project.

Although the details are not available for publication at this time it can be stated that whereas the needs of Seminole Junior College on the south end of the studied area may have prompted the study, the result is an overall research on needs for the entire Sanford region.

Useful in this were the findings and projections of the Orange-Seminole Joint Planning Commission. This study covered a larger area than the Diets report but its conclusions that by 1985 there would be 100,000 persons in the expanded Sanford area was an important factor.

Among the basic findings were a study of expansion of the sewerage treatment in light of new population needs. This demanded careful consideration of the two means of meeting a mounting demand.

One would point to the use of two treatment plants, another to the expansion of the plant already in operation with a large plus factor being its ability to transmit treated waste into the live and flowing water of the St. Johns River as it flows through and out of Lake Monroe.

Palmist Loses Suit To Practice Here

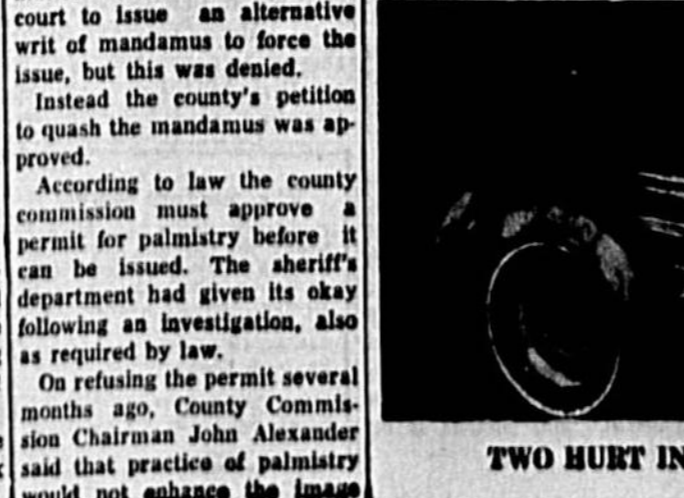
Mrs. Katherine Johnson of Cassberry lost her court suit this morning to force the county to approve a license to permit her to practice palmistry in Seminole.

According to law the county commission must approve a permit for palmistry before it can be issued. The sheriff's department had given its okay following an investigation, also as required by law.

How A 15-Year-Old Boy Shot 'Largest Buck Of Season'

Thanksgiving Day 1967 is one day which 15-year-old Rodney Goble of Lake Mary will never forget.

What started out as a normal hunting day while accompanying his father, Rodney, on the shores of the Wakiva River, the tenth grade Seminole High School student bagged the largest buck of this season, a 15-pointer.

As a matter of records, area residents were hard pressed to remember when a buck with such a large rack was ever killed, not only in Seminole County, but in all of Florida.

"This was the first buck which Rodney has ever even had a shot at," said the elder Goble. "It was field dressed at 14 pounds."

"I must have been around 9:15 in the morning when I saw this giant walk down from the forest's edge, and stop by the river for a drink of water," chimed in the happy youngster. "We weren't using any dogs or anything like that. I was just still hunting and standing by the tree when I heard this movement and before I knew it, there he was."

"I picked up my M1 Carbine and BANG!"

After checking the carcass, and confirming the sounds heard by Mr. Goble, there must have been at least six bang-bangs, by the number of expended shells found on the ground.

"By the time I reached Rod, all I could see were his succor-like eyes staring at the fallen prize. He couldn't say a word. He just stood there looking at the deer and was in a world all by himself," added the jubilant father.

Seminole County Port Authority will continue in its efforts to obtain all of 80 acres needed for the Port of Sanford despite an adverse ruling by Circuit Judge Tom Waddell, Administrator Francis Roumillat said today.

In ruling earlier this week, Judge Waddell approved an "order of taking" for the 80 acres, permitting the Authority to use the land for port construction prior to a trial of condemnation proceedings to determine the cash value of the property for payment to owners.

On Wednesday Judge Waddell telephoned the port attorney, Gordon Frederick, that he intended to amend his ruling to permit Mr. and Mrs. Edwin Cain to retain the 200-foot square site of their home for 19 years. Authority building plans provide for a roadway through the 200-foot square.

The Cains were represented by Sanford attorney Mack Cleveland Jr.

Roumillat said today Frederick has requested Waddell to again reverse himself. If not, Roumillat said, the matter will be included in the condemnation suit under the right of eminent domain.

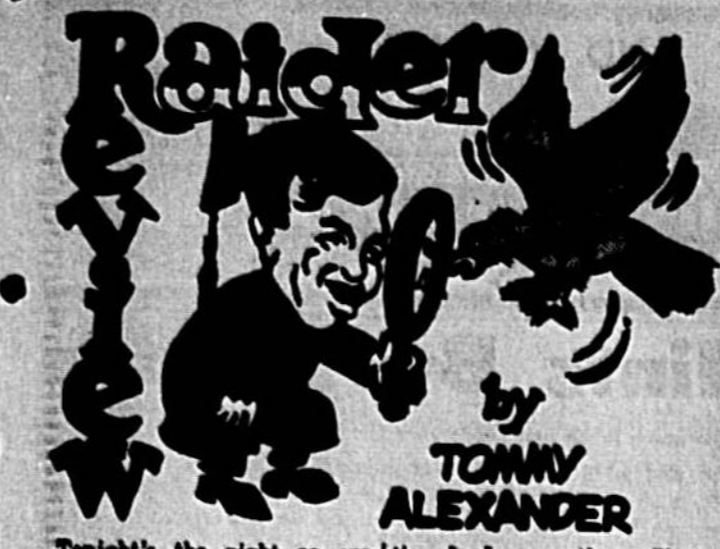

Pesticides Use Defended By State Entomologist

A vigorous defense of the use of pesticides, especially in agriculture, was voiced by Dr. Gerald L. Green, entomologist, at the weekly meeting of the Sanford Rotary Club in the club dining room.

Green is a noted authority on this subject and is based at the Central Florida Experimental Station in Sanford. He has been handling pest control problems as global as the rice fly in the Philippines and as local as the fact that there would be no sweet corn raised in Florida were there no pesticides.

Green, he explained, is not a theoretical danger. Over 40 million people a year will be dying from lack of proper nutrition in 1980. The abundant bread basket in the United States, he explained, is due to the use of pesticides.

Pesticides have made production more stable with fewer crop losses. One man used to be able to raise enough food to feed six others. Now the state of Florida grows 20 times as much food.

Pesticides have also reduced the cost of production so that the American housewife need not pay more than 10 percent of the family income for food. In Florida, the proportion needed to buy food is 30 percent and in some African countries it is as high as 70 percent.

Green also pointed out that the use of pesticides in agriculture has been able to raise the price of such crops as wheat, soybeans, and corn, while improving the quality of the product. 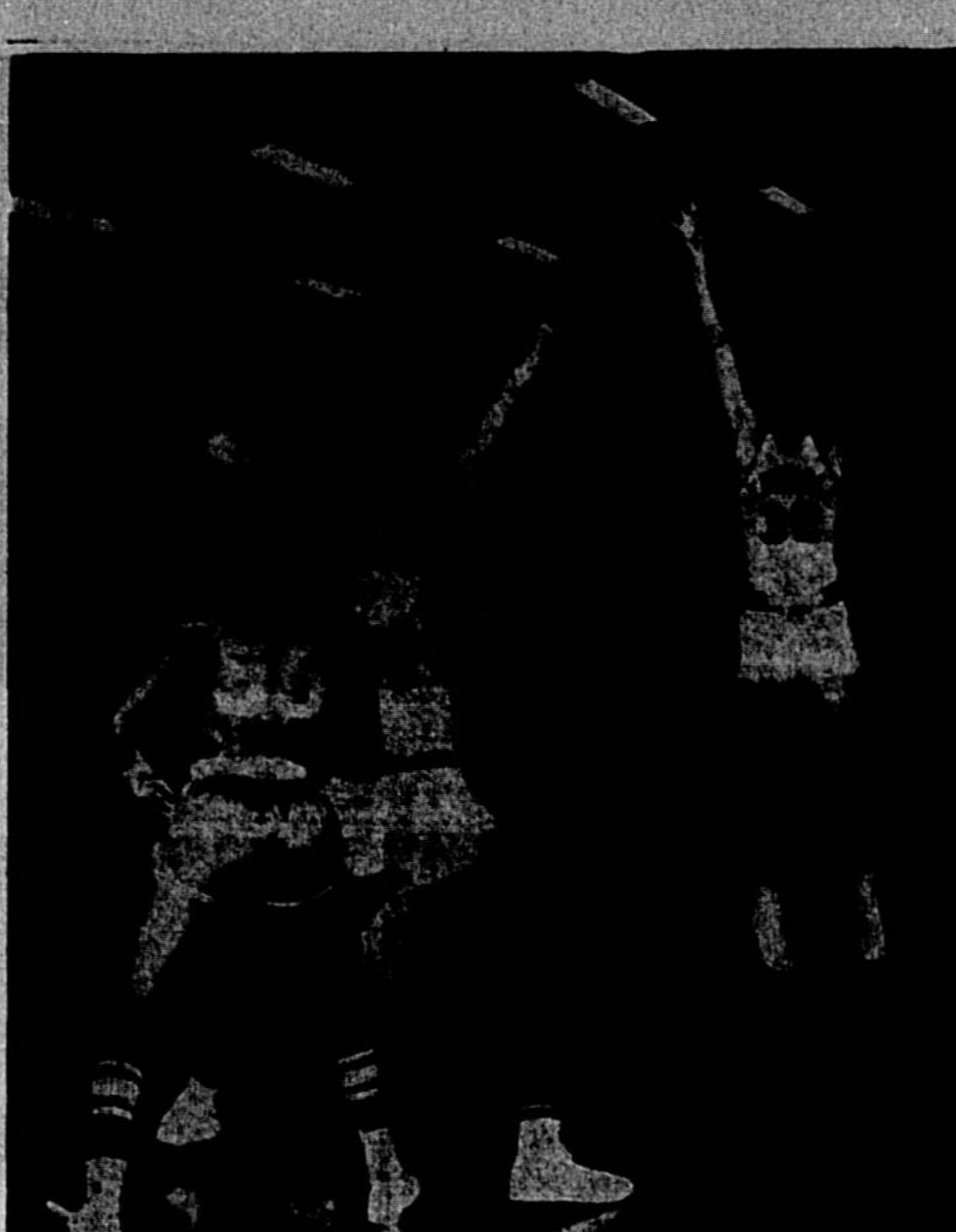
