Mr. Sadat said the time has come for the United States to cease being a naive mediator in the Middle East and become a full partner and participant (to pressure Israel into meeting his demands).

And his call for peace in the Middle East has become a matter of concern and conscience for the whole world.

As for the latter statement, we have only to remember the hope and excitement created throughout the world when Mr. Sadat made his dramatic peace pilgrimage to Israel in November.

The frustrated reception by the Israelis made it seem that Mr. Sadat had, indeed, cut the Gordian knot that had defied peace makers during 20 years of hatred and warfare.

Mr. Sadat is correct; the United States should wade into the Middle East negotiation in an active way.

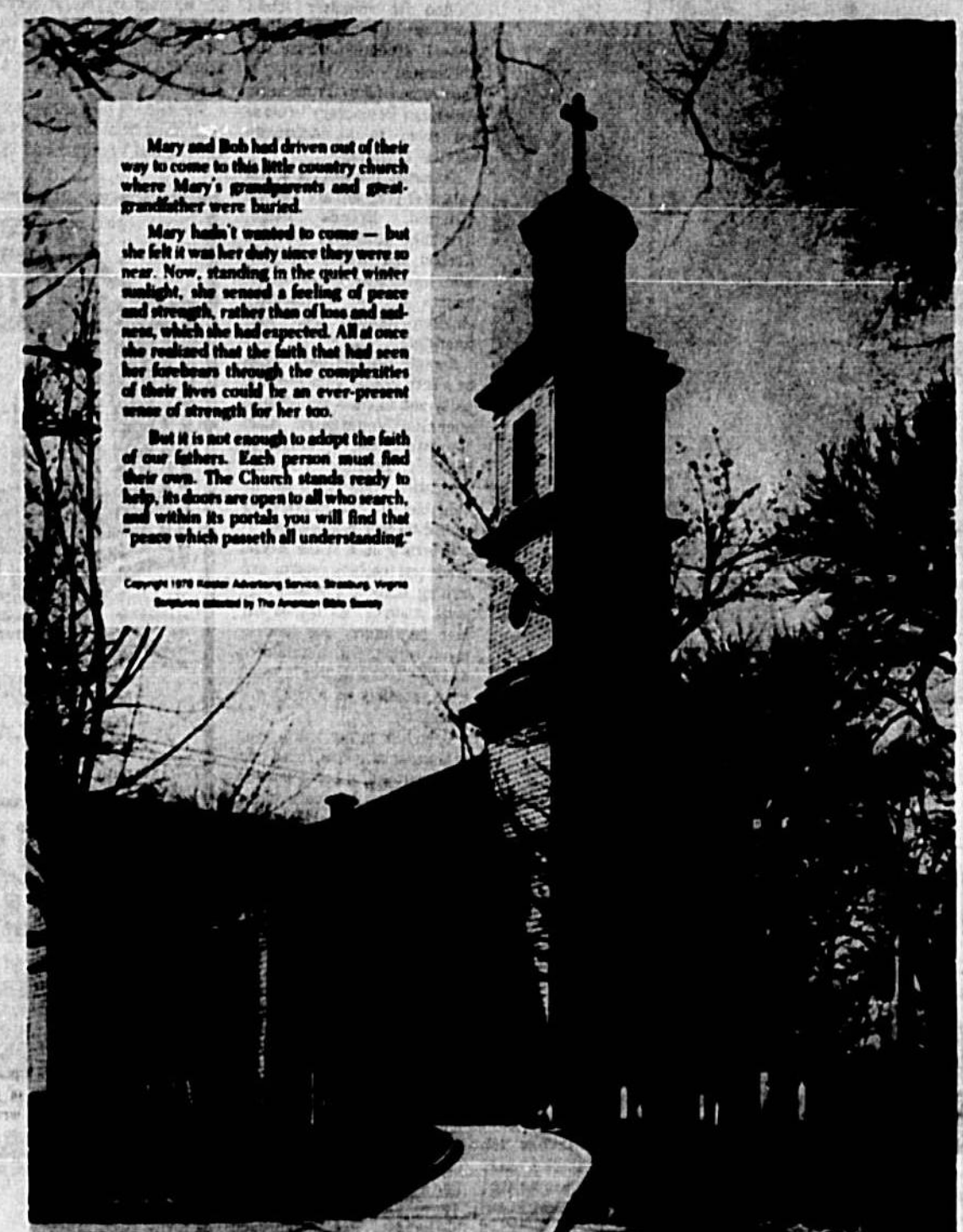
