These guerrillas include the tactics employed by the Viet Cong in South Vietnam. They infiltrate the peasant villages and suppress opposition through propaganda and terror. Their methods include kidnapping and assassination of local villagers. A large number of North Vietnamese refugees live in border towns in Thailand, instead of allowing them to return freely to their homes, the communists force them to be fund raisers for the guerrillas, propagandists, intelligence gatherers and saboteurs. 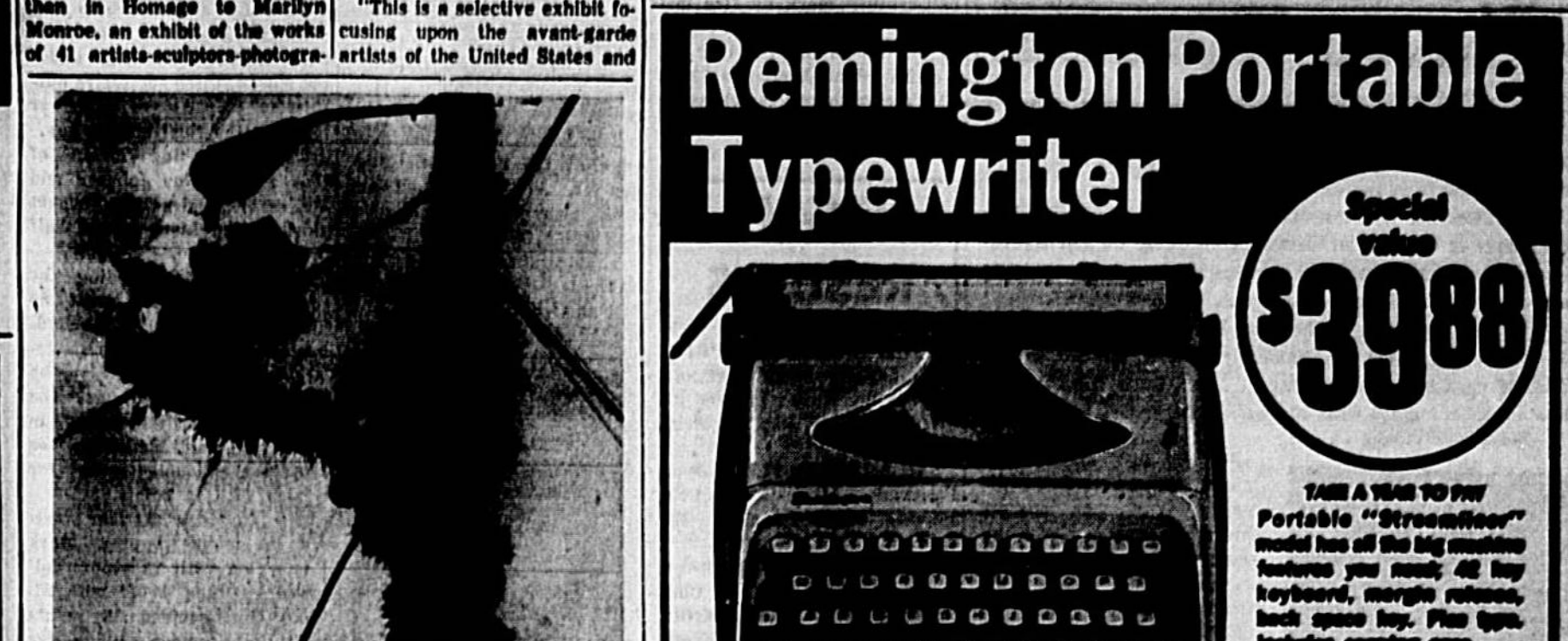

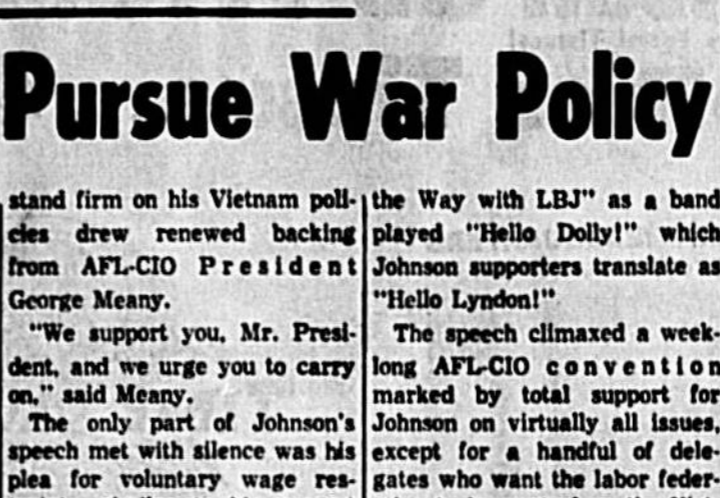
