Hook Worm Leads Double Life Says Dr. Frank Quillman

By DR. FRANK QUILLMAN. The hook worm is like Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde, he leads a double life. One part of his life is in the soil and the other in the human body.

The hook worm eggs hatch in about 8 to 12 hours under favorable conditions. They must have moisture, heat and oxygen. They eat organic matter during the stage. It goes through the first molt in about two days. In about a week it goes through a second molt and loses its shell. It is now ready to attach the human host.

The hook worm larvae enter the human body by piercing the skin, usually tender skin between the legs and fingers. The symptoms of this stage may be absent, or one may have a "swelling" around the point of entry. The larvae then enters the lymph stream, is carried to the blood stream, and through the heart to the pulmonary veins and arteries. When they reach the lungs they eat through the tissues and find their way to the air sacs of the lungs. They cause irritation here, and they are coughed up. Many are spit out, but some are swallowed, and finally reach the intestine.

The infections are classified as follows: (1) Intestinal, (2) very light (1 to 25 worms), (3) light (25 to 100 worms), (4) moderate (100 to 500 worms), (5) heavy (500 to 1000 worms), (6) very heavy (1000 to 2000 worms). The first three classifications give little or no symptoms, and infection is shown by fine lines on the skin.

We do not have as much worm in the United States, or in Florida, as we have in other countries. In the United States, the worm is found in the soil around the feet of the traveler.

During the year of 1945 the health of the United States is being improved by the use of synthetic materials. The synthetic materials are made from petroleum products and are not subject to the same diseases as the natural materials.

The disease can be prevented by each family having a fresh coat of paint on their floors and walls. Never eat human excreta into soil.

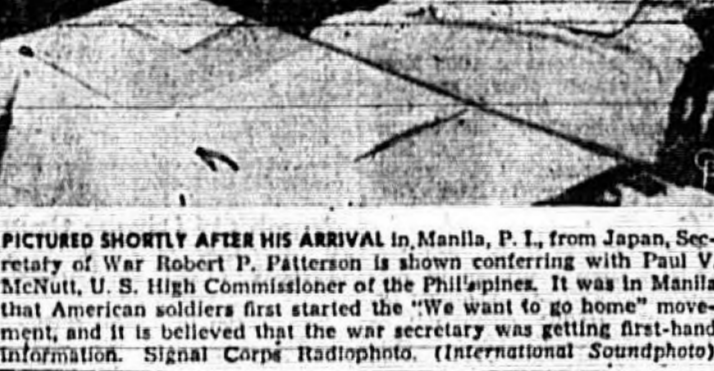
