The commission's powers will include the ability to appoint and remove Development Authority board members; the power to levy taxes and to approve millage.

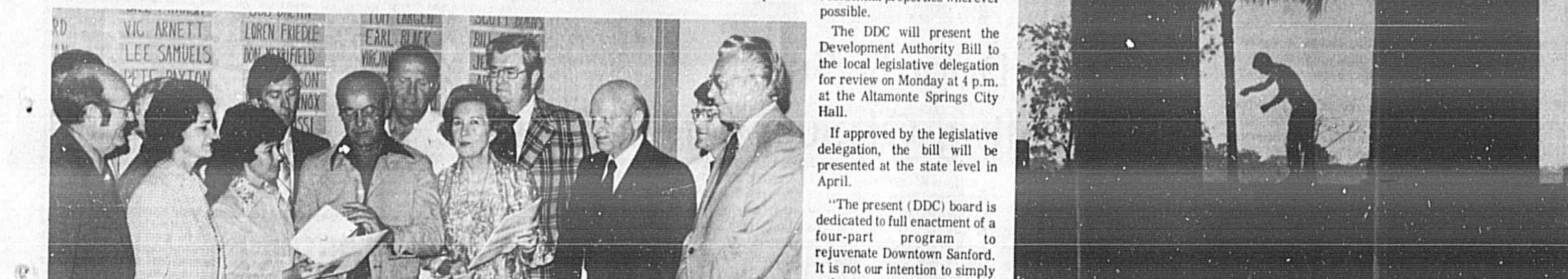
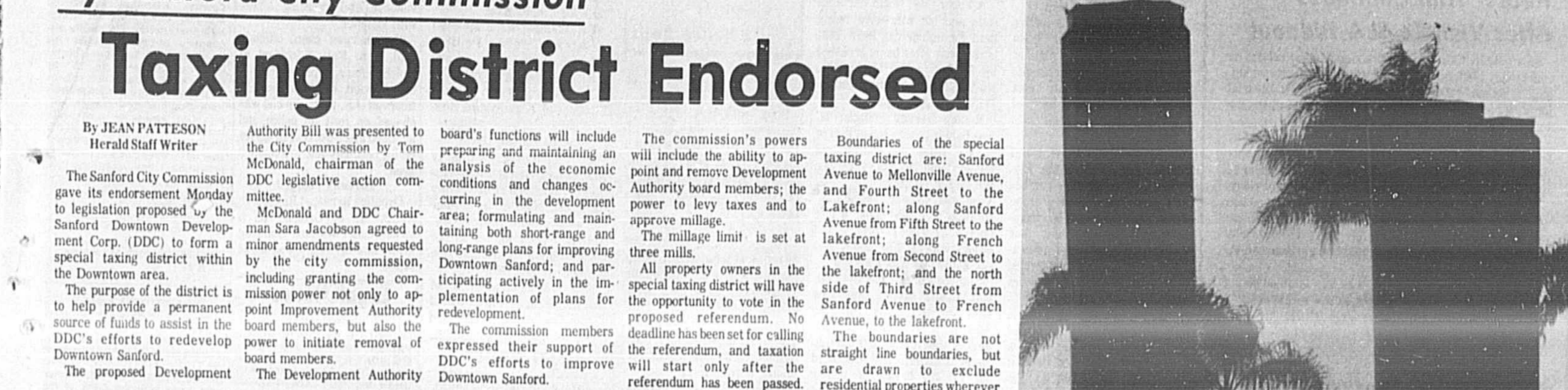
The DDC will present the Development Authority Bill to the local legislative delegation for review on Monday at 4 p.m. at the Altamonte Springs City Hall.
