TREMENDOUS ADVANCES IN PEST CONTROL SEEM-AROUT READY FOR USE

The war has brought trementious advances in pest control and it now seems that the farmer is on the verge of getting benefits from these advances. New remedies found effective for posts both here and in far places, but which were largely taken by the armed forces until the war ended, give promise of being excellent for controlling household and farm pests. In future. Many of the aigrly publicized new materials already are on the civilian market.

Farmers have found DDT to be highly effective in controlling files mosquitoes, roaches and otherpests, but already have registered experiences which emphasize the accessity for caution in its use, t will kill some beneficial insects as well as harmful ones and it has killed farm animals when imvoperly applied.

Aerosol bombs, of which more han 16 million have been used during the rast three years by the armed forces, also will be available for the control of household insects. They contain insecticities dissolved in an liquicities of study in the container. When a valve is openaded the sudden change in pressure allows the contained solution to boil violently. The escaping liquid, forced through a small origine, turns to vapor as it hits the air. This disperset the insecticide as a very fine colloidal sucersion in the air, which is quite effective in controlling insects in enclosures or other places where the air is still.


