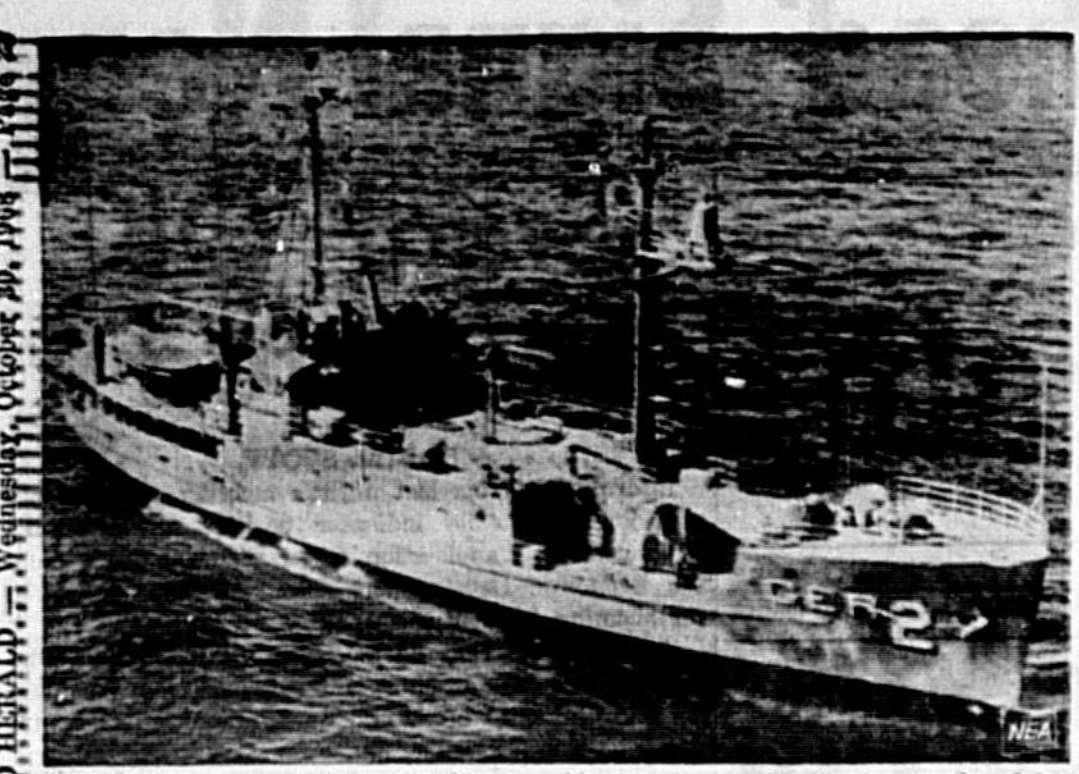

Editorial Comment

Try Out Campaign Literature For The Facts

One week from today it will be too late! Ballots will have been cast and voters will have performed their basic duty of citizenship!

It is not too late now, however, for the registered voters of Seminole County to prepare a base of factual understanding against which the emotions can be projected without undue distortion of the political process.

We are referring to the extraordinary number of "headquarters" which have been established by the Democratic and Republican organizations where campaign literature can be picked up and where questions can be asked and replies received from party workers.

They are located in all sections of our county. In addition to these pick-up spots the candidates—especially for local and state offices—have been lavish in leaving their propaganda in handy places where the public calls often and congregates.

Off The Record!

What does a conscientious reporter do when a meeting is put "off the record" and he looks around at a dozen or so persons who immediately prick up their ears, smack their lips as disclosure of something of more than ordinary interest is anticipated?

This is a situation which has haunted us personally for quite some time. The obvious answer is to nod agreement and stop talking notes. Yet there have been times when we have, prodded by said experience, pointed out that there is, in fact, no such thing as "off the record" when more than one person is listening.

Will all present hold their tongues? Will there be no further discussion about their veiled topic elsewhere? Can it be logically expected that everyone who is present will surely make what he hears a prisoner in his mind?

We are reminded of one-time President Calvin Coolidge—"Silent Cal"—whose Vermont breed of common sense is given as the basis of his description of an effective committee: "Three's enough—two of them out sick!"

What spurred this comment comes not only from personal experience but from a recent article in the LaGrange (Ga.) Daily News by Alan Thomas of the LaGrange College News Service.

He referred to meetings where "public figures" address audiences had requested memoranda of the press to "put away their notebooks."

Wrote Mr. Thomas: "Off the record statements are aggravating, insulting, cowardly, undemocratic and immoral." These are pretty harsh words. And we certainly do understand the need for mutual understanding and respect between news sources and members of the Fourth Estate.

Here in Sanford we have taken long steps towards the creating of such a climate. But there are times when news leaks are sprung and when this takes place, then it must be attributed to the frailties of the flesh, and not any desire to violate confidences on the part of the reporter!

# Elector College Picks Prexy

WASHINGTON (AP) — Citizens going to the polls next Tuesday thinking they will be voting for Richard M. Nixon or Hubert H. Humphrey, or George C. Wallace, will be wrong. Instead, they actually will be voting for a group of people called electoral electors. The electors picked will decide who will be the next president—unless, for the third time in the nation's history, the issue gets passed on to the U.S. House of Representatives.

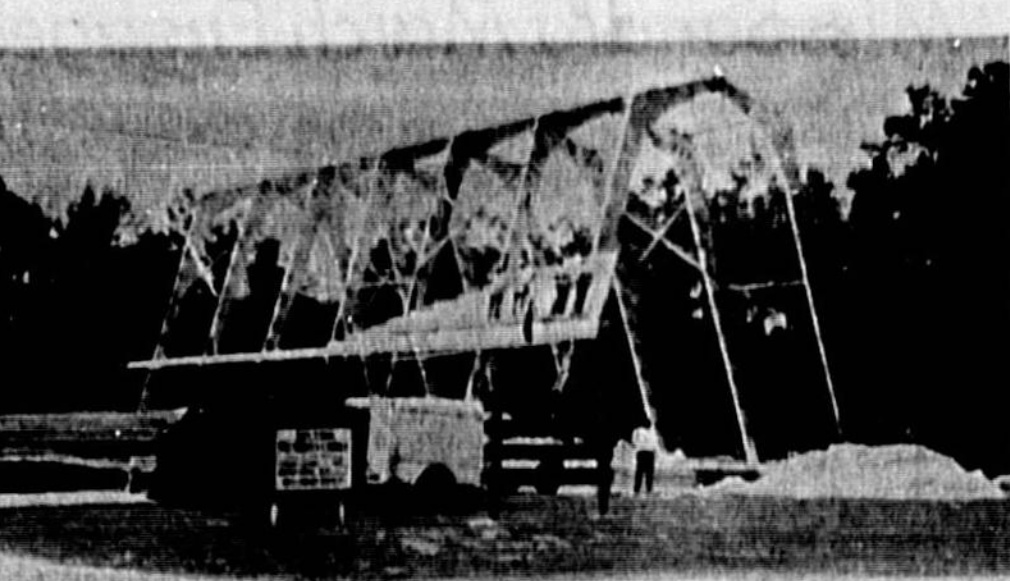
It's all because of the indirect system for election of a president developed by the framers of the Constitution. Originally, the state legislatures picked the electors, but that was soon changed to give the job to the people.

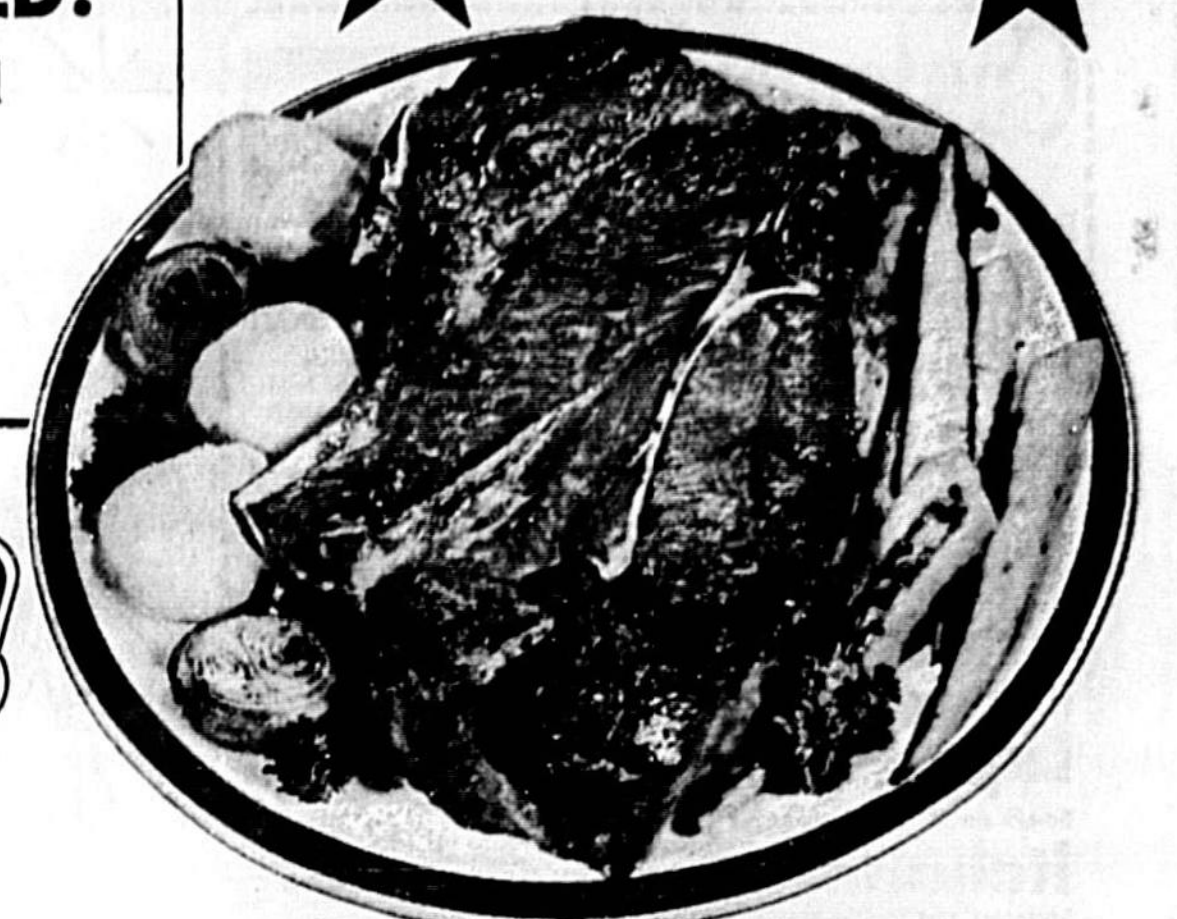
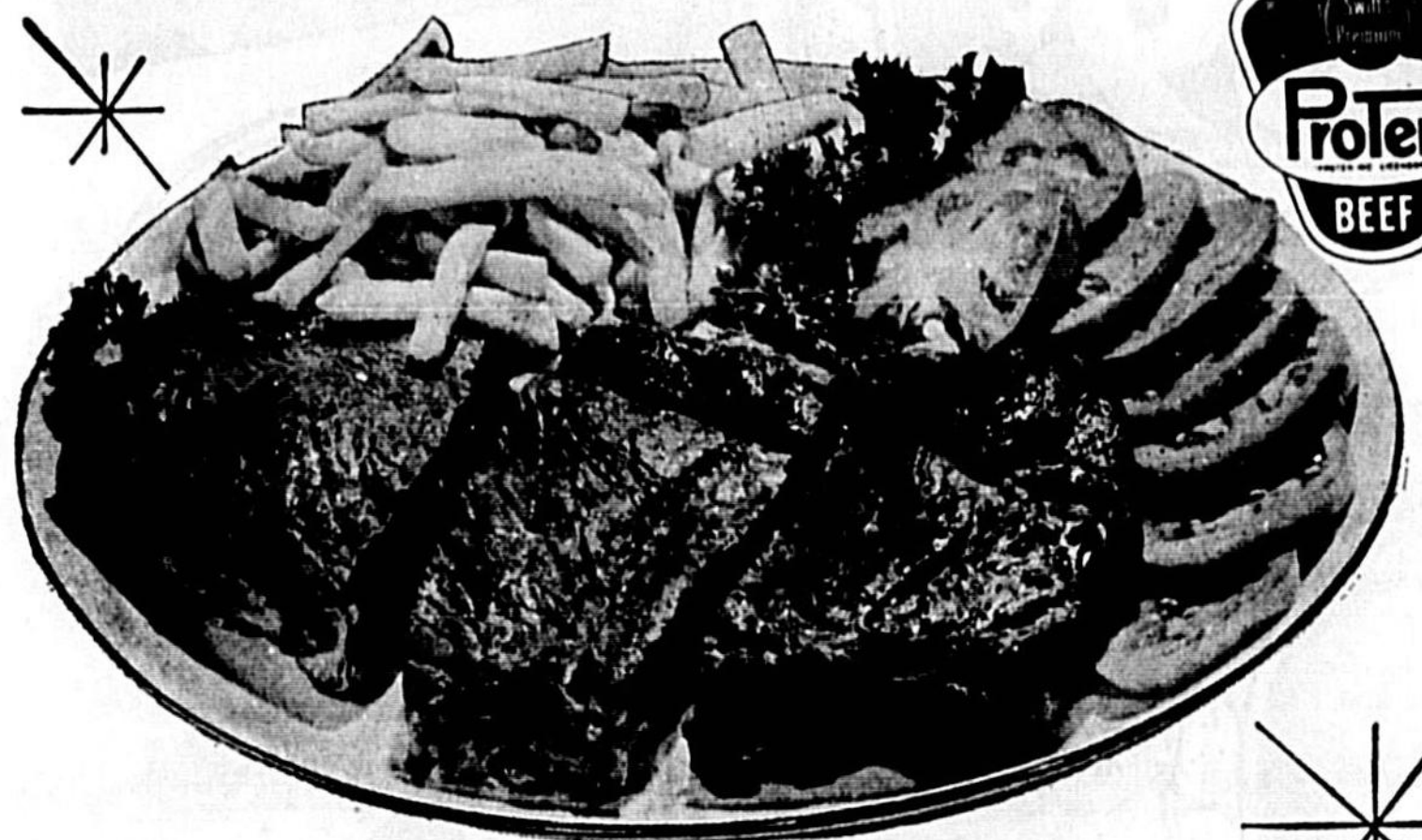

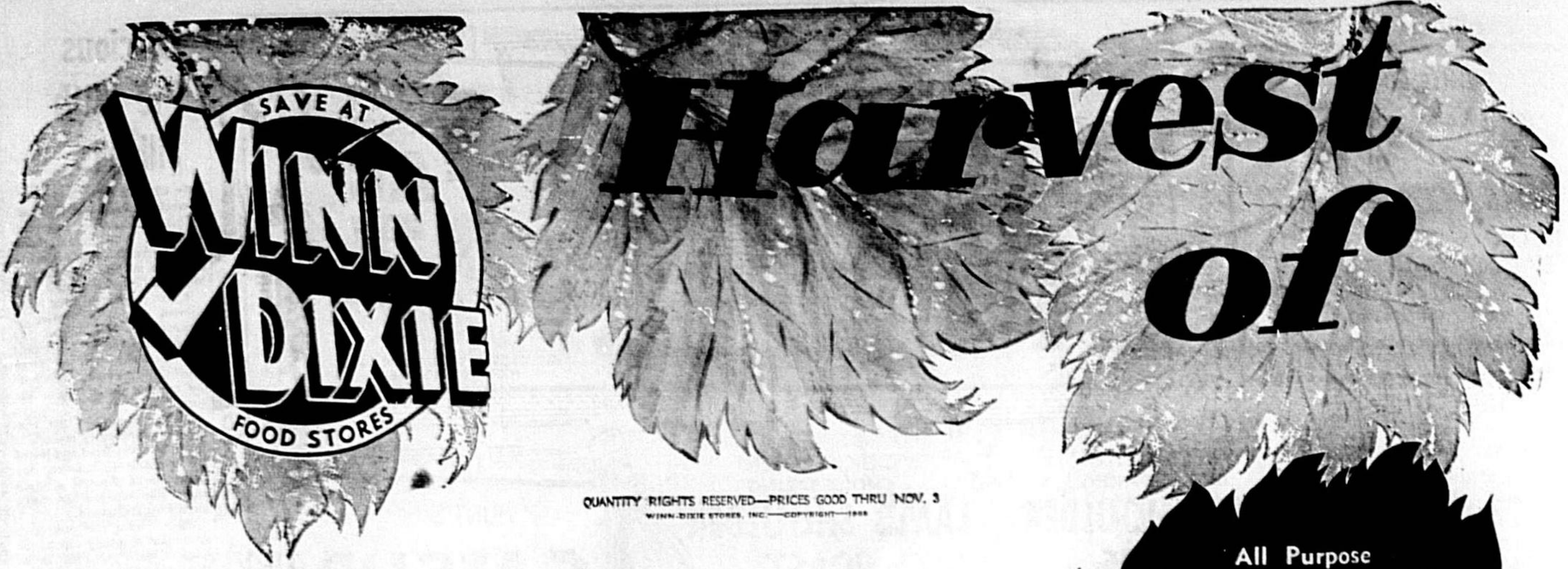
