One of the big industrial regions, now completely occupied with war work, reports that last Dec. A. Pari Harbor Day, one worker out of every 19 was absent from his job. The same ratio was found a week later. A previous survey in November had shown one out of 16 absent. Normal absences, as figured by the War Manpower Commission, would be only one worker out of 40.



HOW TO COMPUTE TAXES TO BE PAID THIS YEAR

Comparison of 1942-43 Taxes

Here is a table comparing Federal income tax paid in 1942 with those you will have to pay in 1943. The grant total income figure, at the left, is everything earned in any manner by the taxpayer during 1942. The tax-payment figures have been calculated after deducting all personal and dependency allowances and substracting another 10 percent, which is a reasonable average figure to cover all other allowable deductions. In some cases the tax-payment figure may be slightly high or

In some cases the tax-payment figure may be signify night or all the loss if an individual has a little more or a little less than the 10 parsent average deduction for all deduction allowances other than parsonal and dependency allowances. But the variation probably is very small.
