Sadat Said Angered At Israeli Proposals

Medic Who Saved Lives Dies

Toronto (UPI) — Dr. Charles Herbert Best, credited with saving the lives of millions of diabetics around the world as co-discoverer of insulin, died today. He was 70. As a 21-year-old researcher at the University of Toronto in 1916, Best and a colleague, Dr. Frederick Banting, then 30, made medical history when they isolated the hormone insulin from a steer pancreas. The discovery saved or lengthened the lives of an estimated 40 million diabetics.

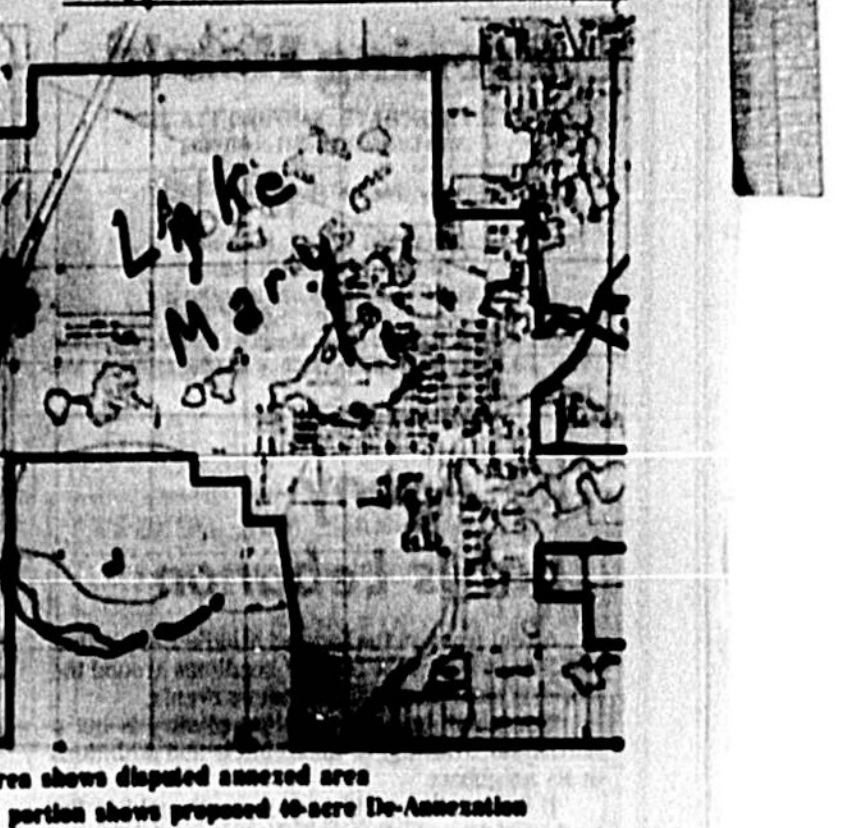

The Agony That Is Lebanon

A road away in the tangled Middle East is that Lebanon, which in the face of headlines around the world, is not a principled in the news events. This small and low-lying country is not a historical, it belongs to the conflicts and misdeeds of its neighbors.

It is since the world gave more thought to the neglected tragedy that is Lebanon. Until the summer descended in the autumn of 1975, Lebanon's capital city, Beirut, was the Paris of the Middle East — the region's fashion, financial and tourist center.

The roughly three million Lebanese, despite their Arabic heritage, scrupulously maintained a Beirut neutrality through all the fire and furore between Israel and other Arab states during the last 50 years.

But within the brief, the Lebanese never fortified their neutrality with armed strength and did not take their stand.

It is instructive now to contemplate how this peaceful, prosperous little country has been reduced to ruin. This is the old story of what happens to sheep too fat and complacent to be alarmed by prowling wolves.

Lebanon's time of trouble began in 1973 when the Palestine Liberation Organization, consisting of about 15,000 guerrillas, infiltrated the country and set up its headquarters.

This state within a state had been driven out of Jordan after bloody fighting in 1970, harried from operating out of Egypt and then chased out of Syria.

Of the Arab states bordering Israel, only Lebanon was too weak to fund of the P.L.O. Unbridled calamity was the consequence.

The P.L.O. initiated its first disaster on Lebanon by precipitating a civil war three years ago; it shattered the governmental power structure equally apportioned between Christians and Muslims.

And the Palestinian then took place in the initial Lebanese, strengthened by 50,000 Palestinian refugees, and the rightist Christians; the P.L.O. formed three warring divisions into a configuration that consumed the country.

When, in November, 1975, it appeared the P.L.O. would emerge as ruler over the warring, Syrian troops and limits swept in under the guise of Arab troops.

Actually, Syria, which had entered Lebanon, was exploiting the opportunity to extend its control over the present country and enhance its prestige in the Arab world, as the continued presence of 30,000 Syrian troops would indicate.

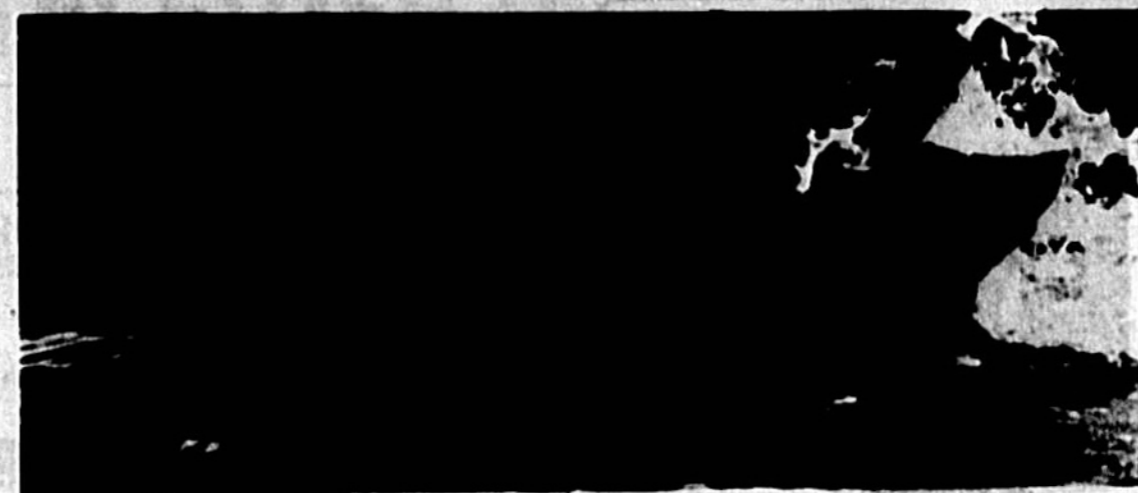
