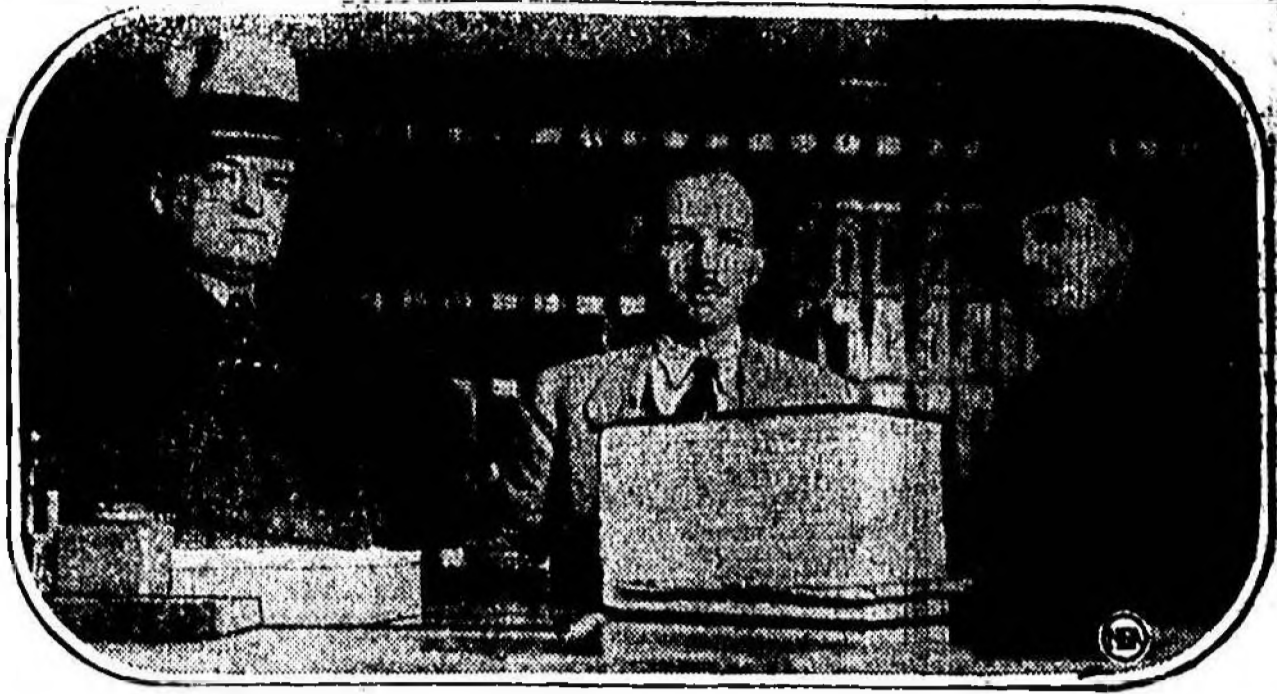


Stephenson Demands New Trial—in 2,300 Pages
