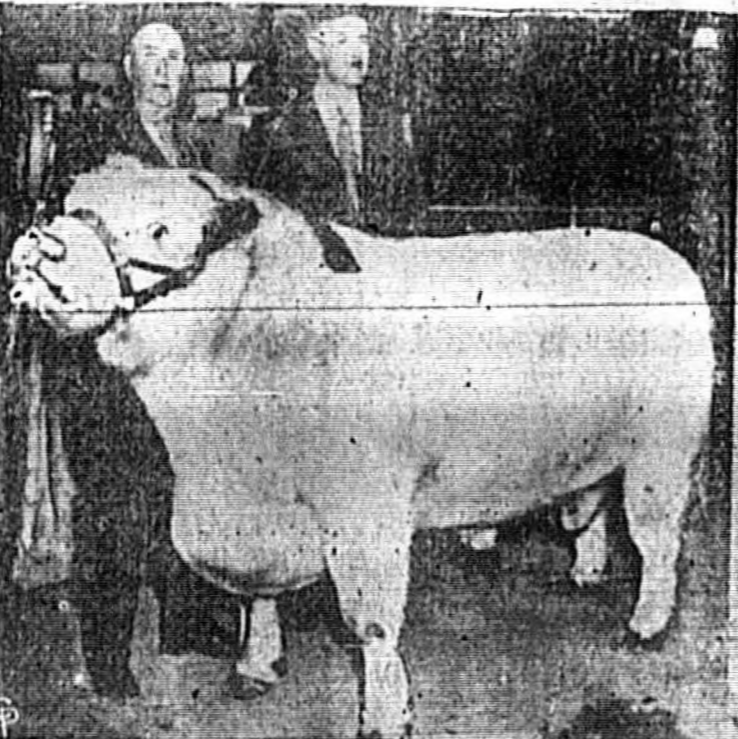

Just A Little Guy, He's Best Texas Harrier

AUSTIN, Tex. (AP)—The little guy just circles and circles, pounds and pounds—and gets ready for a new fling at glory in national trackdom.

Tiny Jerry Thompson, who has to bewitch the scales to show 127 pounds, is the greatest cross-country runner ever developed by Coach Clyde Littlefield of the University of Texas.

He started there before the war, went to Great Lakes Naval Training Station for some more running but was out of track from 1944 until he showed up this year at the university, to

complete his course in engineering. Jerry not only has taken up where he left off but is even better. Recently he ran in a three-way cross-country meet and whipped out the first two miles of a 2.7-mile course in 9:26—more than six seconds under the Southwest Conference two-mile record set more than 20 years ago.

Thompson was third in the national collegiate cross-country meet at East Lansing, Mich., recently, in his first race since returning from Navy duty.

Jerry will run next at New Orleans in the 1947 Sugar Bowl meet.

Thompson was Texas inter-scholastic league mile champion

in '41, came to Texas that fall and won the cross-country championship of the Southwest Conference in '42 and in '43. Also in '43 he was two-mile titlist of the conference, the Southern AAU and the NCAA meet.

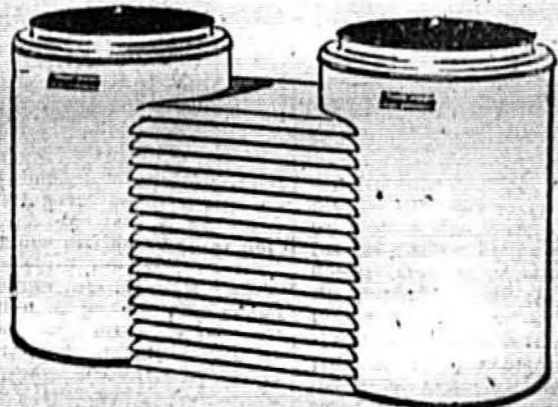

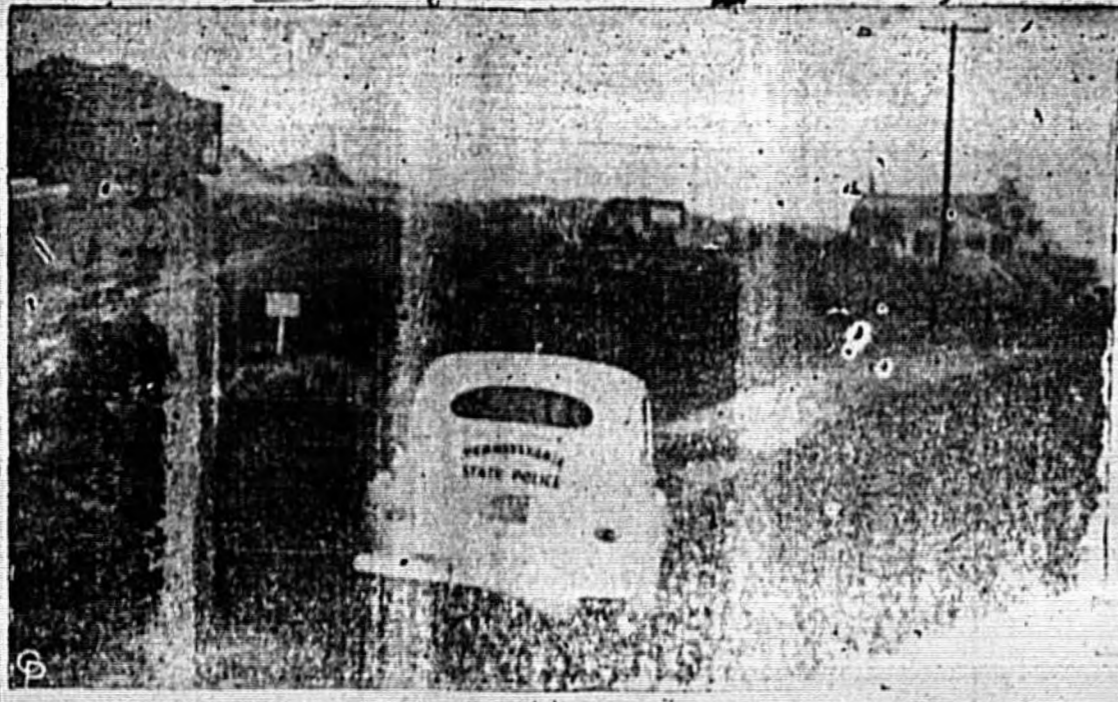

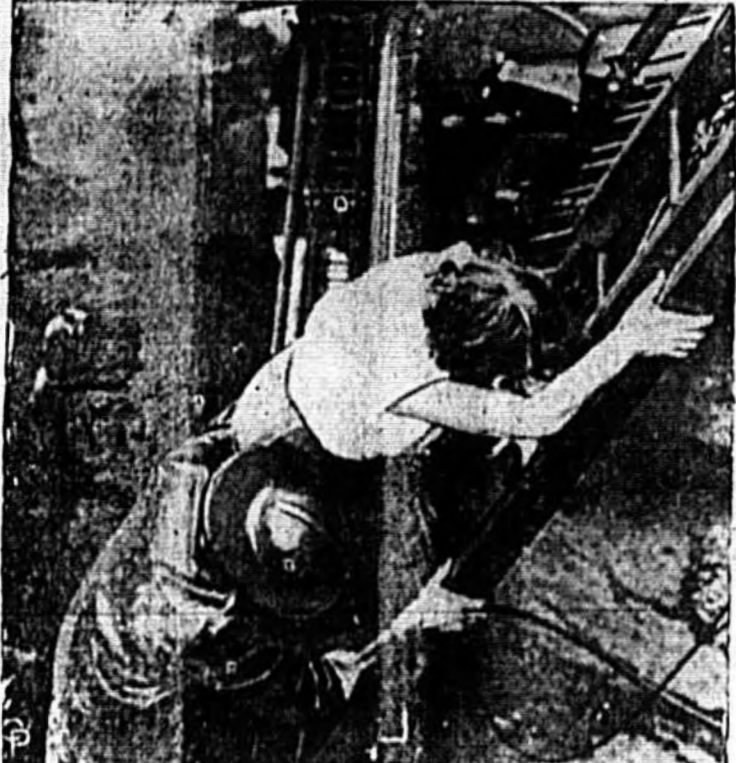

Civil War Flares Up In Oil Wealthy Middle East Area

 what sort of resistance was encountered.

Now that Iranian politics have reached the civil war stage, foreign diplomats are worried. They see the conflict as a test of Soviet influence in an area formerly occupied by the Russians. While there is no sign that Russia will back the Azerbaijanis with arms, there is no doubt where Moscow's sympathies lie.

Azerbaijan revolted last year while Soviet troops were occupying the area, and subsequently the province was granted some home rule. Parliamentary elections were scheduled throughout Iran for the two weeks that began last Saturday.

Premier Ahmed Qavam has insisted that he will not recognize the return from Azerbaijan unless the government forces watch the balloting. But local Azerbaijan leaders are suspicious. They say that Qavam is trying to control the election in favor of his own party.

According to Iran's chief of staff, General Bazmeh, the government troops made contact with the Azerbaijanis at the entrance to a strategic pass at Ghaflankuh. That pass straddles the main route into Azerbaijan, and might become the stage for violent fighting.

While there is some concern in Iranian government circles that Russia might give indirect aid to the Azerbaijan separatists, a British Foreign Office spokesman says Britain regards the new dispute as "a purely internal affair." This spokesman told newsmen that Britain's attitude would remain unaltered even if the current fight developed into an all-out conflict.

2 British Officers Hurt In Italian Riot

PADUA, Italy, Dec. 10, (AP)—Two British officers and several Italians were injured today in a two-hour riot set off when a British army truck ran into a group of Italian pedestrians.

Padua is the site of general headquarters of Britain's central Mediterranean force.

The Italians, estimated to be more than 150, attacked British personnel and tore down a British flag in the mistaken belief that the truck had killed two of their countrymen.
