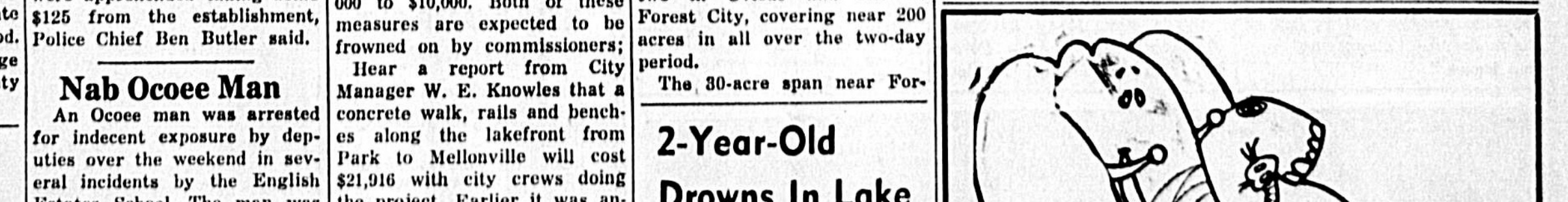
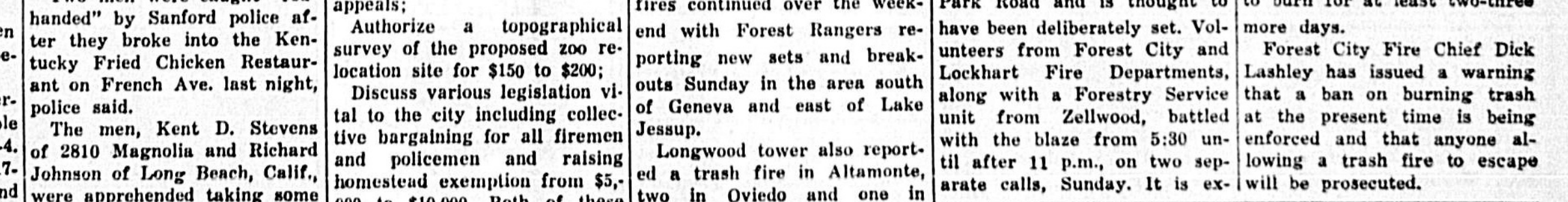
Mrs. Blanton Owen won the sweepstakes award for her arrangement in the annual flower show of the Garden Club of Sanford.
