### Children Lacking A Country To Get West Indies Home

WASHINGTON—Since December last year a small group of men and women has been planning to help the thousands of children who are being separated from their parents in the West Indies.

Incorporated here as the National Children's Sanctuary, the group expects to start its program by setting up a home for 50 of these children in the island of Nevis in the West Indies.

President of the group is the Rev. Albert J. D. Bois, former head of the Army Chaplains in the West Indies. Commanding the moving spirit of the Sanctuary is Mrs. Vera Stuart-Alexander, who came to this country with her three children in 1940 from England.

Mrs. Stuart-Alexander, who is living here with her daughter, Phyllis, 16, who works at the British Embassy, says she became interested in the movement when she learned how many children were living in old concentration camps abroad because there was no place for them to go.

She says she feels that since her three children were well-adjusted in this country, she should like to see other children who have been abandoned, most of whom are too young to know their own home, or country of their birth.

"It was especially Mrs. Stuart-Alexander's idea that a sanctuary be established at Nevis. She says, 'From the fact that every one of the British colonial possessions will be comparatively easy to effect—provided that we can show satisfactory financial support—the cost of solving in the island of Nevis the problem of these abandoned children is not too high. It is here, or in Nevis, that the plan of Nevis, with the attention to the children.'

We had hoped that such a procedure would not be necessary. We did not want to make an issue of our case. We felt that during the many years that we have resided here, we have had the good will of the community. We particularly desire the good will of EVERY person in the City of Sanford. But we cannot allow ignorance, information and prejudice to monopolize a progressive step which we know will be highly beneficial to Central Florida and to every resident of Sanford, as well as to ourselves.

In the meantime, if you have any queries, EVERY question to your satisfaction, please give us an opportunity to do so.

We had a grand celebration for our returning veterans. They are getting employment, entering in business, buying homes and taking an active interest in community affairs. Let us not make them worry they stopped here. Sanford is moving forward, not back, into its history. Let us not move BACKWARD this time.

We wish to thank those citizens who have come to us for facts. We are proud to report that EACH ONE who did was THIS in favor of the Plant. We are glad to thank those citizens who, although initially prejudiced against our plans, changed their opinion upon learning the facts.

We YOU citizens, show the community, the world, the FEW to prevail upon the City Commission that they permit us to proceed with our abattoir. Sanford's decision THROUGHOUT ONLY COMMERCIAL ZONE will be made.

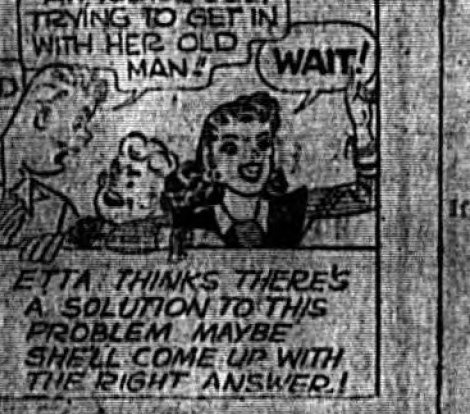
