Plorida Southern's new program is not one of shorgun generaltrics. It is based on specific couses whith provide students with 2 groundwork in principles that have made America strong; and which prepare them for the leadership they must assume tomorrow.

Significantly, the Plorida Southern ptogram lias been iwice honored (in 1951 and in 1992) by Freedoms Poundation of Valley Porge, Pa, "for oututanding achieventent in bringing sbout a beter understanding of the American way of Jife." The Department of American Culture received the first-place National College Awand for 's3.

Therefore," asid Dr. Glenn, the director, "with acs demic achlevement nationally resognized, we can with consistency present this important and urgently needed program to the buriness and profestomal leaders of Plorida."
"Thete are three divistont to the Depatiment of Ameri can Culture program:

1. The Chair of Americaniastion.

Spedally choven instructors offer courses for frethmen and senions. "The history of American Inatitutions" for frestimen; and, "The History of American Culsure" for seniors.
2. The Deparmeni of American Culure
"We bave broughe within the framewort of this De pertmom all importent Ameticen audies: via., Anericen

History and Government, the U. S. Constitution, Amers can Music and Art, the Hible in American Culture, Amer ican lieterature and all other specific cuurses dealing with the nature and purpose of our economic, industial and political syseems.
3. The Amesican Fotum
"Additional impact for the curriculum is provided ty the American Porum, a plan under which,authorinative speakers on national and woild problems are brought be fore the student body and faculty in a series of regularly schedulcal addresses.'

The "Education-In-Americanism" plan was inaugurated this summer by Dr. Glenn. This program is de signed primasily for high school seniors and gradustes. They will be invired to entet a contest for tuition scholarshiph A carefully prepared questionnaire will be sent to them, together with a lester of explanation. Those who submit the besp responses, will bue considered for 8600 ruition echolarships.

This is a non-coniroversial, non-political and interfaith program. It is non-commersinl, because only the winners will be benefitted financially.
"We have not tallored our academic pateetn to the selfserving specilications of any sroup individual. Subcervience to any individual, of gronp, would resule in corr srols which would destroy pilvate educstion," sald Dr. Glenn. "We belleve that pirvace educstion and privita enterprise ase dependent upon cach other; and that me have uninal respooaliblitice. This is in opportuaity for priving enserpolse to mite a sonad investument in Amed
