Israelis Bomb Damascus, Heavy Damage Reported

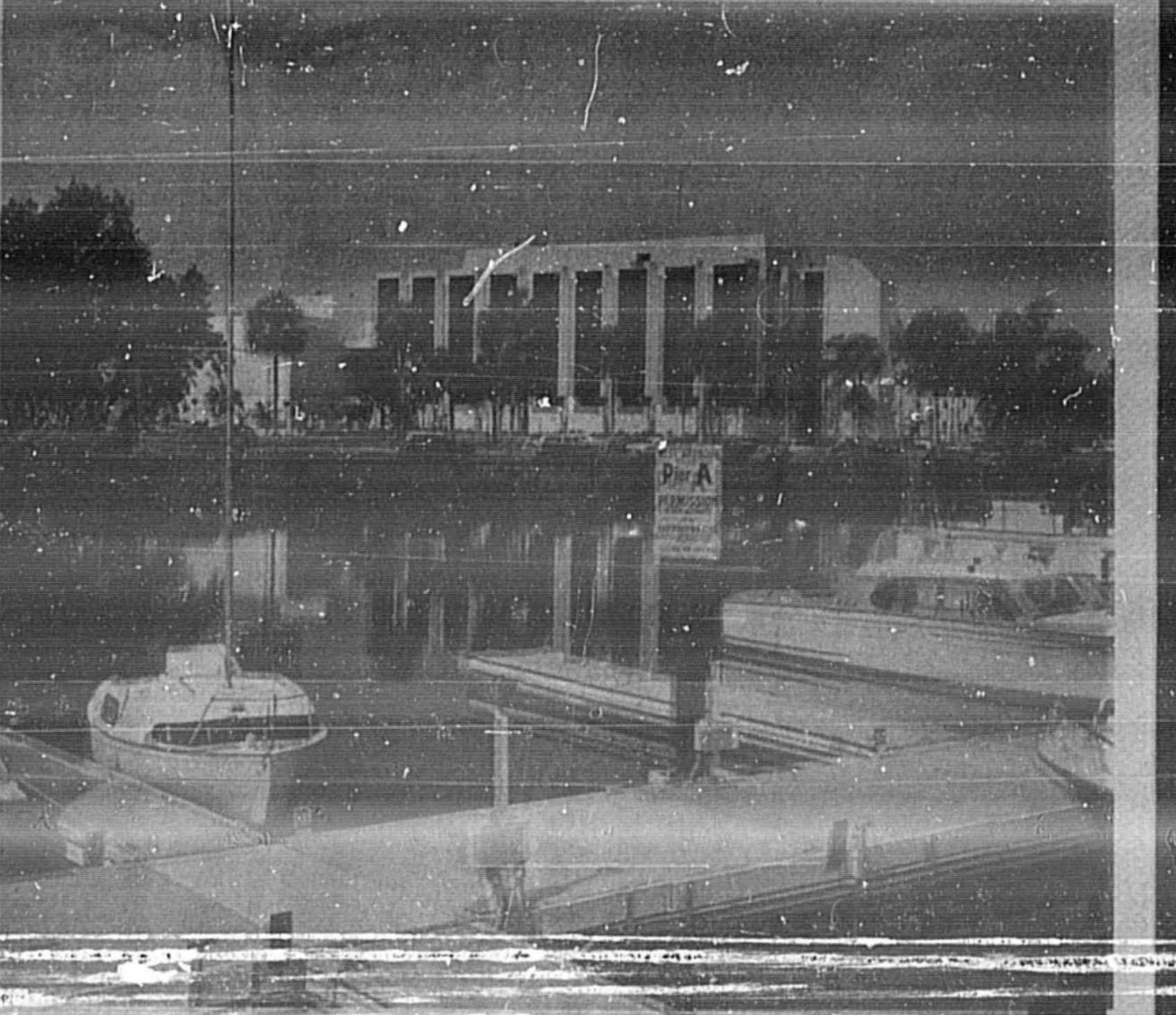
DAMASCUS, Syria (AP) — Israeli Phantom jets bombed the Syrian Defense Ministry 2nd radio station in Damascus today, heavily damaging the buildings and inflicting casualties. (Related story on Page 1B) It was the first reported air raid over the capitals of any of the three countries fighting in the fourth Arab-Israeli war. Syria immediately threatened retaliation. The Israeli jets left several bomb craters in the large square in front of the Defense Ministry on the eastern fringe of the city. They also hit a house about half a mile away. Many residents flattened themselves to the ground as the raid brought the new Middle East war home to this ancient Syrian capital. Bystanders watched as more than half a dozen ambulances evacuated dead and wounded.

'A Mess Of The Economy' Nixon Is Brunt Of Meany's Attack

MIAMI BEACH, Fla. (AP) — AFL-CIO President George Meany today blamed President Nixon for making a mess of the economy and again called for an immediate end to wage-price controls. Only Monday, the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and the National Association of Manufacturers issued a similar appeal, urging Nixon to "end the entire wage-price control program promptly," without prior notice and without sector-by-sector phase-out. Addressing the AFL-CIO Building and Construction Trades Department convention, Meany said ending controls would cause some problems at first, but over the long run "it would restore some confidence on the part of the American people." The labor chief said that unless changes are made, workers' wages must increase substantially just to keep pace with the cost of living. Criticism of administration economic policies and demands for wage settlements above the 5.5 per cent allowed by current guidelines were expected to be the focus of attention throughout the two-week labor meeting here. "After two freezes and four phases, the annual inflation rate, which Nixon found unacceptable at 4.8 per cent in 1968, was a per cent in the first half of 1973," Meany said. "The dollar, he said, has been devalued several times, interest rates have shot through the roof and the housing industry is strangling, but big business and the banks are feeling no pain." Meany said he was not an economic expert, but he added he didn't feel too ignorant in view of what he called the propaganda from Nixon's economic advisors. "If they're experts, I prefer to be a plumber," he said. At the opening session Monday, 17 construction unions broke with the AFL-CIO to oppose a labor-backed pension reform bill now before Congress. The bill, approved 93 to 6 last month by the Senate and sent to the House, calls for an overhaul of the private pension system to assure employees of retirement benefits. Opposition to the measure from the 17 unions making up the AFL-CIO Building and Construction Trades Department was expressed during the meeting. "The issue came up Monday during the opening of the department's 57th convention. When a delegate noted that the legislation has the support of the AFL-CIO, department President Frank Bonadio retorted, 'I don't want to get into politics over the bill; we're opposed to it.'" One labor source indicated heavy pressure may have been brought on the unions by some of the major contractor associations. As now written, to finance the insurance system, the bill includes a tax on each player of \$1 a year for each worker covered by a pension plan. In a resolution, the building trade unions urged the House to reject the bill unless it takes into account the unique circumstances of construction pension funds. The union said there is no need for termination insurance.

Parks Due \$12 Million?

A \$12 million county and city program to be completed by 1980 is being developed by the Seminole County Commission and the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council. Commissioner Mike Hattaway, board liaison officer for parks and recreation, today said "We are well on the way to meeting that goal," following Monday night's meeting to discuss RCFRPA's preliminary plans. According to Hattaway, the planning commission has drawn up an interlocking system of municipal, county and regional parks to incorporate parks already existing, and to stimulate development of parks by the individual governmental entities involved. In other business, commissioners report "good progress" in the words of Commissioner Dick Williams, following Monday evening's work session with CROP in developing a new agricultural zoning ordinance to permit placement of mobile homes. "We are close to finding something satisfactory now," Williams said, adding, "I can see no reason why we shouldn't have something ready for the commission in another month or so." The board has been working with CROP to develop a "one time only" zoning procedure to eliminate the present temporary permits and the conflict with a recently passed county ordinance banning trailers from agricultural land.
