Legislature in Week-end Recess With Major Problems Still Unresolved

TALLAHASSEE, Apr. 12.—(AP)—The Legislature, with nearly one-fourth of its allotted 60 days passed, stood in week-end recess today with all major problems still unresolved while Governor Sholtz repeated "There won't be a special session."

Legislative action was not among the 600 measures introduced since the session started April 2. It was expected that the Legislature would act on the income tax, but the Governor's veto of the bill has delayed the action. The Governor also vetoed a bill to amend the constitution regarding the judicial branch.
