

U. S. Position In Second Front Is Established

Warning Is Given Of Impending Allied Attack On Nazis; Axis Troops Gain

A warning to Hitler of an impending Allied second front came today with the announcement that the European theater of operations for United States forces has been formally established at Washington. It was said Maj. Gen. Dwight Eisenhower has been made commanding general for the American forces in Europe.

Hitler's field headquarters said Axis shock troops had knifed deeper into the fortifications of Sevastopol today. Soviet dispatches pictured Russian troops as inflicting a terrible toll on the Germans.

The Nazis maintained furious pressure against the Allies for a week. The Russian front was again equally scornful of heavy losses, pouring overwhelming numbers of men against the front but heavily outnumbered defenders. These attacks were repulsed by the Crimean defenders.

On the Khar'kov front where a heavy German attack opened Monday and forced the Russians to fall back on Tuesday, the Soviet defenders inflicted great losses in men and material on the invading midnight command.

Despite this valiant defense, however, the Germans persisted in their attack, hurling hundreds of tanks into the battle with the support of vast numbers of tanks.

The midnight command reported that Soviet warplanes were attacking the German bases in the North Sea in an enemy surprise attack. The Russian picture from the southern front indicated that the Nazi commander had determined to launch an offensive in the direction of the Caucasus and its oil resources.

LONDON, June 25, (AP)—Defining the Free French political aims for the first time, General DeGaulle issued a declaration today founded upon the principles of the Atlantic charter and providing for the election of a national assembly by the French people to determine their own future when the Germans are driven out.

The five points of the declaration were understood to have been approved by leaders of resistance in the German occupation of France through four months of the most remarkable secret negotiations yet conducted between England and the occupied homeland of the Free French.
