## Powell excellent leadership choice

is one of the younfeat for American peace-time hituory and would leap-frog over davene of more-centor officess to become JCS chief.

wide knowled ife of international politics. Like the retiring chairman. Adm. Wuliam Crowe, Gen. Pow outlook tranacende the Joint Chiefs of Staff in the past. And he already has establiahed pervonal relationshipe
with preabent buth and other inemberi of with preildent buish and other pramben of Sho matoona cecurty tean - Eetret Dick Chency, NSC Ediviser Beat
