

# **Altamonte Tables** Zoning

By MONA GRINSTEAD Altamonte Springs Council action on the proposed soning plan for the town calling for 12 separate and distinct districts was tabled at Monday's business session until council members, at a private and Closed meeting tonight, give the recommendations further recom-

A public hearing on the proposals, drawn by the Town Planning and Zoning Commission, was held in the community at a meeting on July 31. The council's legal representa-

tive, S. J. Davis of the Sanford firm, Stenstrom, Davis and Mc-Intosh, explained steps taken by the Planning and Zoning Board before Monday's council meeting. saying, "I feel that the town will be, and has been, more informed on these zoning recommendations than it ever has been in the past on its zoning regulations."

Before the action was tabled until tonight's meeting, Councilman John Wolf had made the recommendation that, in the RIAA single family dwelling, one block on each side of SR 436, all the way through the municipal limits, be included in the C1 commercial elassification. The same proposal was discussed for the R3 one and two family dwelling areas with be included along the route but that he would bring it up for further discussion at the council's private meeting.






