

Oil Shortage A. Myth

Secretary Ickes, sometimes known as "Petroleum Coordinator," among other things, has lifted the ban in gasoline sales and filling stations may now sell as much as they like, or as little, and stay open after the surfew rings if they want to. It seems that when Mr. Ickes first anticipated the oil shortage, he was merely seeing things

Of course there never has been an oil shortage in this country. And Mr. Ickes never even contended there was one. What he did contend was that reserve stocks on the eastern seaboard were being depleted because of the transfer of tankers to the British and that if gasoline were not conserved there would be a shortage at some future

So he rode through the country like Paul Revere sounding the alarm that the British are coming and our oil is going and issued any number of ukases trying to get people to quit driving their cars, and ordering filling stations to close and all that sort of thing, while railroad managers insisted they could transport all the oil neces sary for the east in tank cars.

And now after getting the country in a state of almost nervous collapse over the prospects of a gasoline shortage, the Secretary finally lifts the ban and reveals there is no danger of an oil shortage at all but that it is electric current in the southeast which must be conserved.

It may be that some time this country will run out of supplies, but Secretary Ickes should not cry "wolf" too often or the people are liable not to believe him.


