Army Closing 4 OCS Sites

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Army, after building up a backlog of officers, intends to phase out officer training programs at four sites.

The Army announced Thursday it had commissioned more than 16,000 officers during the year ended last June 30, compared with 3,672 officers commissioned through the program in the previous year. During the last 10 years, it said, it commissioned a yearly average of 1,107 officers.

Officer training programs will be phased out during the next seven months at Ft. Gordon, Ga.; Ft. Knox, Ky.; Ft. Lee and Fort Detrick, Va., and at the Aberdeen, Md., proving ground.

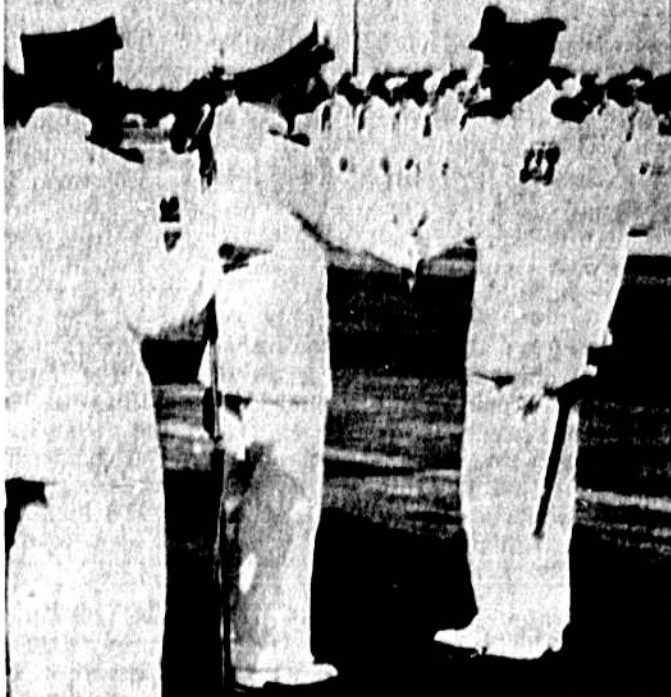

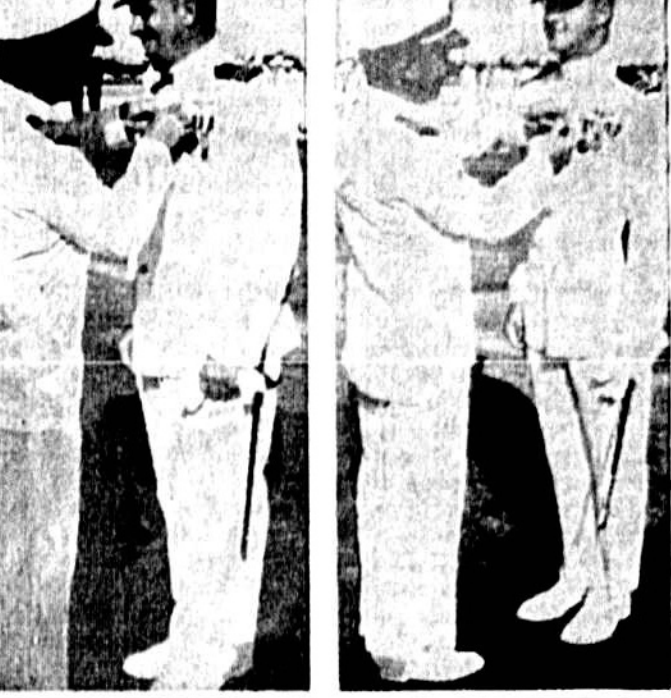

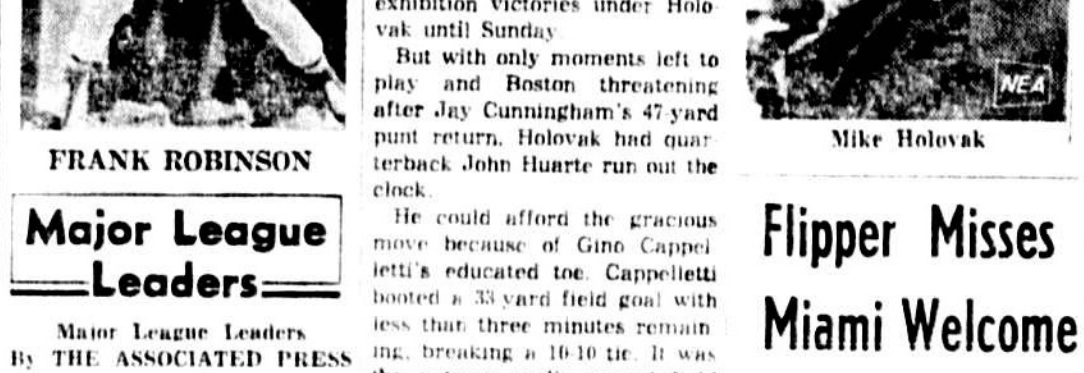
