Local Barbers Hear Lectures By Expert On The Subject Of Efficient Barbering

Dr. E. A. Rainey, itinerant barber teacher, last night finished the third of ten lectures on barbering at the Post Office Barber Shop on First street.

Dr. Rainey is employed by the State Vocational Department and journeys about the state teaching barbers the fine points of their profession, details that they would not learn in the regular routine of business. He was in Sanford two years ago on the same mission, and gave a total of 21 lessons to the ambitious barbers who answered his call.

He has made a cycle of the state and is back to carry on this particular work of teaching barbers to be more efficient groomers of men. His course includes principally lectures on the anatomy, the head, the scalp disease, salesmanship and other subjects related to successful barbering.

The only barber who has been required to pay 25 cents for each lesson, says Dr. Rainey, for his time. Dr. Rainey at present has a class of pupils in Orlando, DeLand and Sanford. He teaches one night regularly in each city. He never has to be paid, but a sum of five dollars a week and the other two nights are held on the first and third nights of each week.
