**Take Flu Shots Now, Dr. Leone Warns Residents**

There were almost five times as many flu cases in Florida this past season compared with that of last year and the State Board of Health says indications are for as many or even more the coming season.

Consequently, said Dr. Frank Leone, county health officer, inoculations should be taken no later than September because the vaccine takes two to four weeks to become effective.

He said one shot should be taken certainly, but that two — two months apart — would be more effective. "The vaccine might not prevent a case of flu, but would most certainly lessen its severity," he said. A single booster would be sufficient if you've had a two-shot series within the past year, he added.

Immunization is especially recommended for the high-risk groups: persons suffering chronic diseases; persons under five and over 65, especially those over 65; and pregnant women.

Dr. Leone said the vaccine will do no good if you've already contracted the disease. "The immunization is good but not perfect. Tests have shown it to be 80 and 80 per cent effective. One trouble is that the virus tend to change from time to time, thus making ineffective next year a vaccine which is effective this year."

He said the vaccine virus are produced in eggs and as persons overly sensitive to eggs or egg products might have to forego the immunization.

"There's no specific treatment for flu," Dr. Leone said. "If you get it, consult your doctor and take good care of yourself because it could lead into pneumonia. Best treatment is bed rest, good food, plenty of liquids and aspirin or nose drops to relieve discomfort."

During the last flu season, nearly 10,000 cases were reported against 1,000 the season before, Dr. Leone said. This would not represent all cases since many are not reported.

### Federal Aides To Get Pay Hike

WASHINGTON (UPI) — A House committee is expected to approve this week a proposed pay raise for government white collar workers.

A House post office and civil service subcommittee passed a bill authorizing a 4.5 per cent increase as of next October 1. A second pay raise of about four per cent would go into effect the following year.

The legislation, which is expected to reach the taxpayer about \$1.5 billion, would affect 1.8 million employees—1.1 million so-called classified employees, and 100,000 individuals working in miscellaneous agencies.

Under the plan, the lowest classified employee would get \$3,836 a year and the highest \$22,000. The minimum does not include the higher-paid agency heads, assistant secretaries and secretaries.
