Committed To Victory

Saturday night the Senate passed the British aid bill by a vote of 60 to 31, a majority of practically two to one, after nearly two months of debate since its introduction in the House...

But by the same token, if the British cannot win even with all the aid we are able to give them as contemplated by the bill, we have made war absolutely inevitable for this country by its passage...

Thus it becomes absolutely essential to us that the British win. We have committed ourselves to a policy from which there can be no turning back.

Having rejected their advice, we are now definitely committed to a British victory. We cannot have it both ways. We cannot give "all out" aid to Britain, and then if Britain loses, expect to escape the consequences of defeat...

For that reason loyal and patriotic Americans, even though some of them may dislike the British, even though they may think the policy we have adopted is not the best one for the country, even though they may heartily dislike President Roosevelt and fear his dictatorial powers...

Our course has been set. We cannot turn back. We must fight our way through.
