### Tammany Hall, Roosevelt Feud Still Going Without FDR

WASHINGTON (UPI) — There were the Hatfields and the McCoys and there are the Roosevelt and Tammany Hall—feudists—all.

The Roosevelt feud with Tammany goes back to FDR's youthful service in the New York Legislature, 1910-13. Bucking against the leadership of Tammany Boss Charles F. Murphy was not recommended strategy for freshmen Democratic politicians. For FDR it paid off big in good publicity.

The Roosevelt feud with Tammany as recently as this week. Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt was co-leader of a primary election crusade in New York City to cut down Tammany Boss Carmine De Sapio. The reformers licked three of De Sapio's candidates for the Legislature.

Boss De Sapio's political prestige was hurt badly. The next Roosevelt move will be to seek to oust him as Tammany leader and as New York's Democratic national committeeman. There doubtless will be more episodes in the feud so long as there are Roosevelt and Tammany around.

Franklin Jr., got into the act on his return from naval service after World War II. FDR Jr. wanted a New York City nomination for the U. S. House of Representatives. Tammany refused.

FDR Jr. said Tammany had a great nerve to deny a Roosevelt such political negotiation. He accepted the nomination of the splinter Liberal Party and won the House seat. Tammany does not forget, however. The young man next wanted to be nominated for

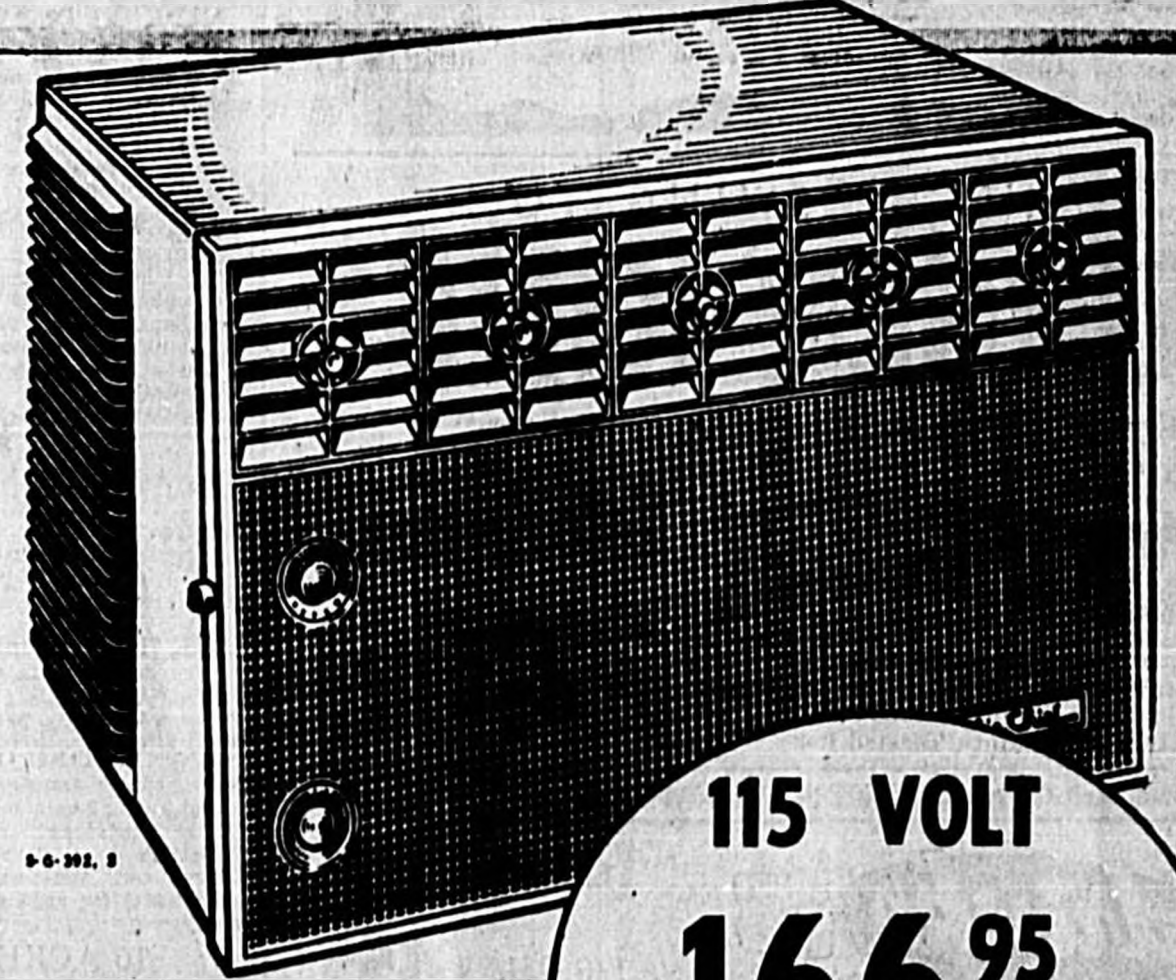

BOSTON (UPI)—A father who sacrificed many of his possessions and a precious kidney to save his son from certain death began the longest wait of his life today.

Physicians at Peter Bent Brigham Hospital said it may be weeks or even months before they will be able to determine if the operation, believed to be the first father-son transplant, was a success.

Successful. Whether the transferred kidney will "take" is another question, doctors explained. The body tends to reject substances not grown within itself, in this case the new kidney. This tendency is greatly reduced when doctors deal with identical twins and to some extent in the cases of fraternal twins.

Should the transplant take effect, young Reck would still have to undergo further surgery for the removal of his diseased kidneys. The boy has been at the hospital since April 21 and recently was placed in a sterile room to reduce the danger of infection. The long delay between the admission and the actual operation was to provide time for various tests and to improve the boy's general health.
