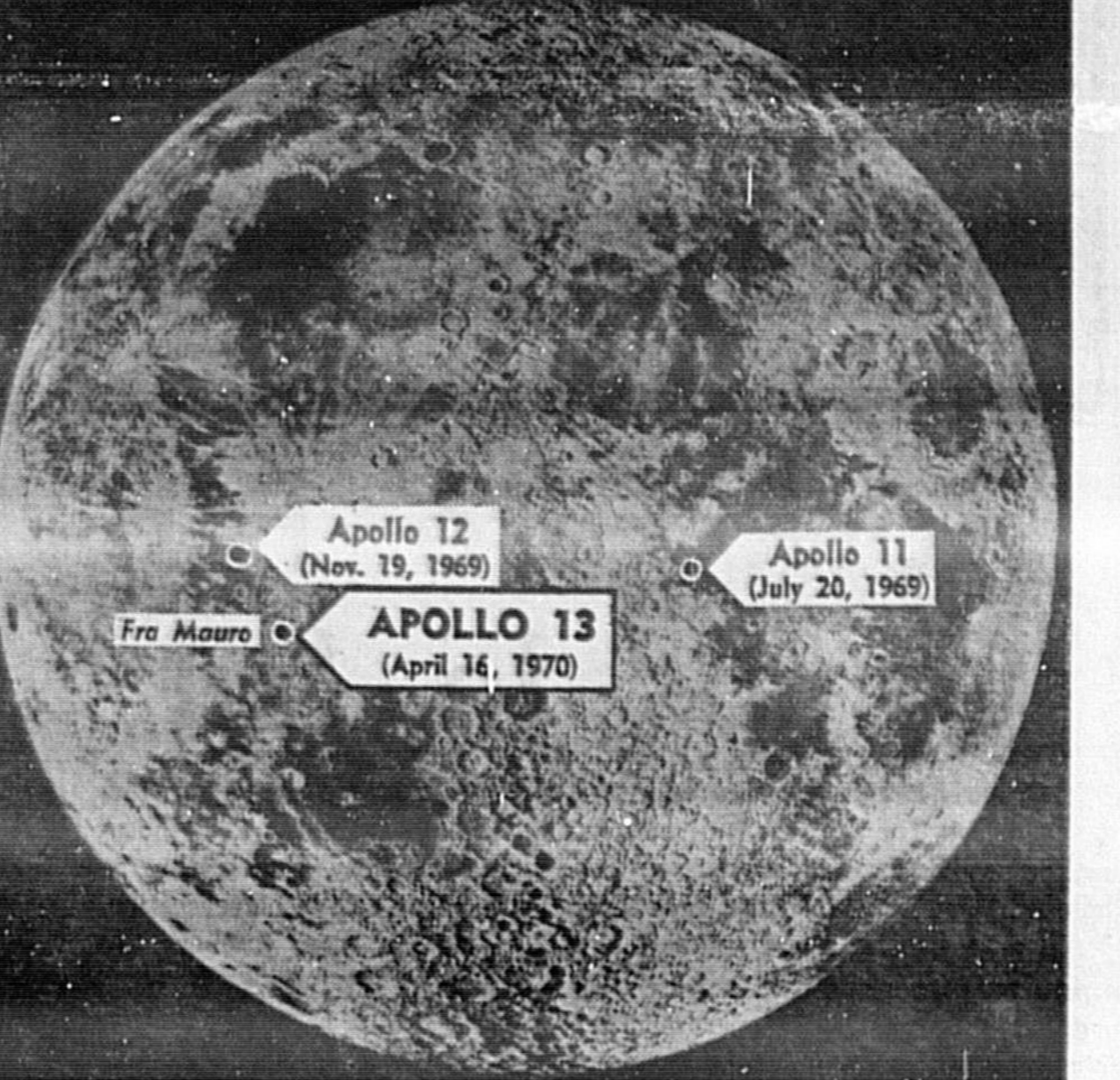

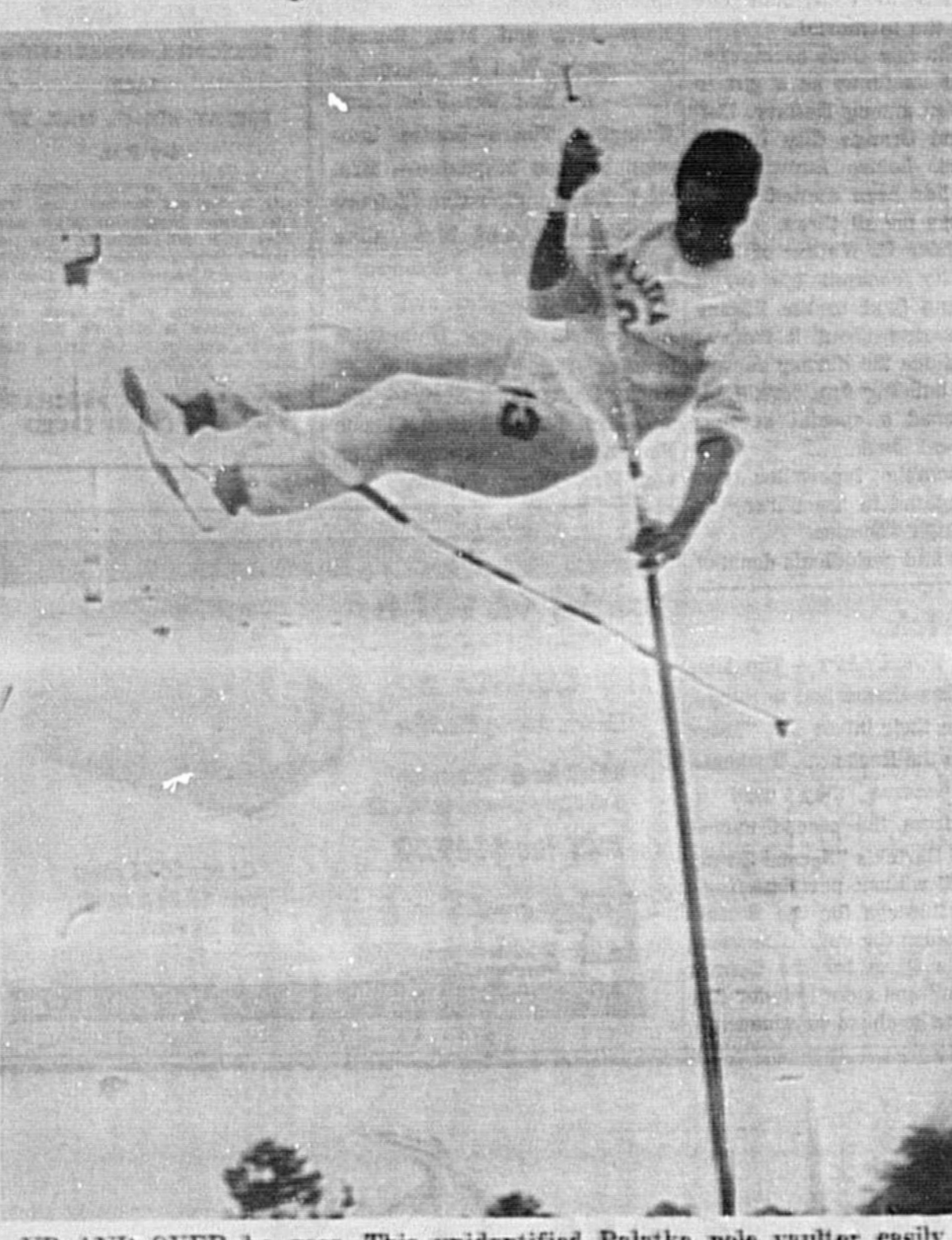

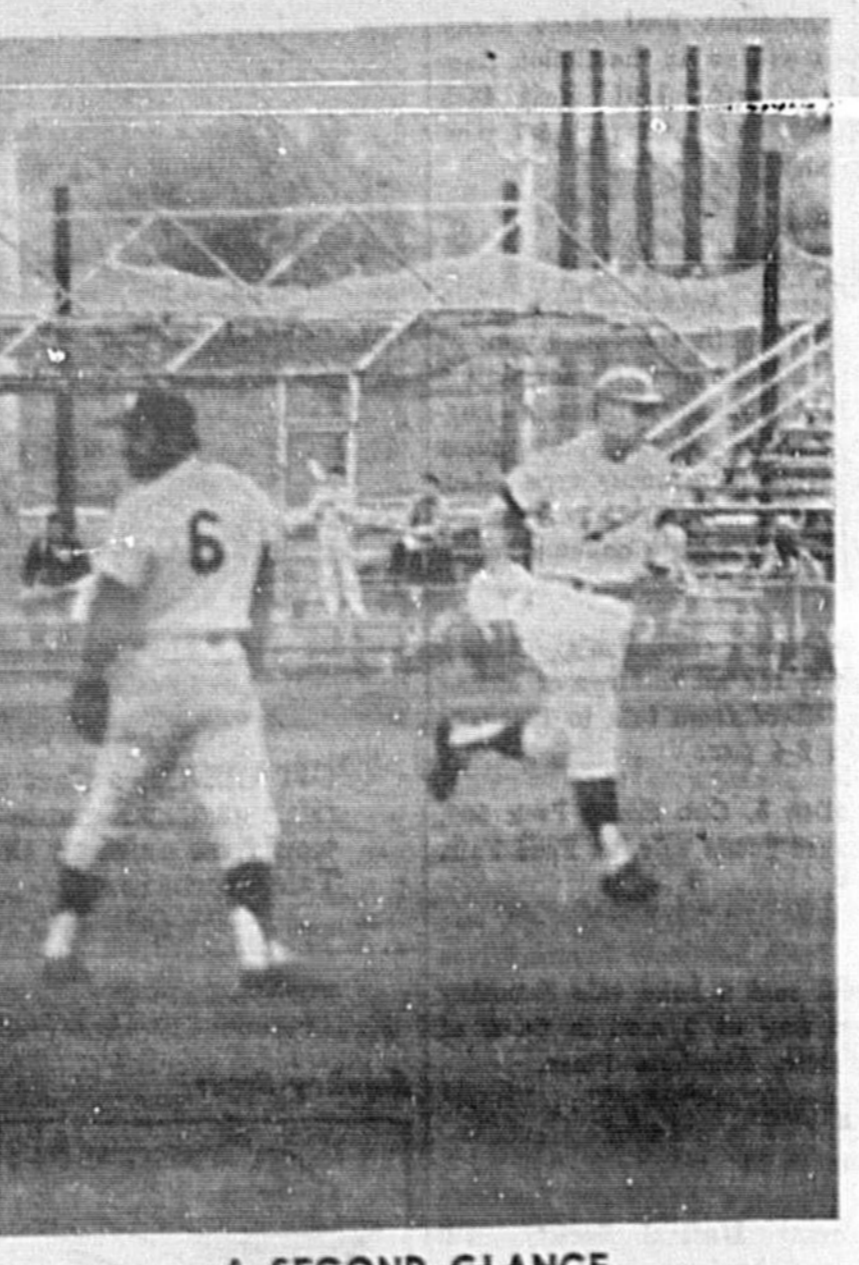

Committee OKs Top-heavy Budget

Solons, Nixon Hassle On Education Fund

WASHINGTON (AP) — House appropriations subcommittee has set the stage for another confrontation with the White House over education spending by approving a bill

that goes \$300 million over President Nixon's budget. The subcommittee voted the extra funds for the Office of Education despite Nixon's last minute attempt to head off the fight by agreeing to a substantial increase of his own.

The President sent up a supplemental request Monday for an additional \$270.5 million for the Office of Education but the subcommittee tacked its own increase onto that.

It all adds up to a replay of the nine-month struggle over the education budget for the current fiscal year, which featured a Presidential veto, the upholding of the veto and Nixon's final acceptance of a bill still far over his budget.

to next year's budget would bring several programs up to the level Congress set in the final version of this year's bill. But education supporters in Congress say federal aid has to be increased at least 10 per cent each year to permit the school districts receiving it to stay even. And they want to do more than that.

In last year's fight, the appropriations committee also tried to hold the increase over the budget to about \$300 million. But when the bill reached the

floor the increase was boosted to \$1 billion, and a similar effort is certain to be made this year. Not included in the \$300 million increase is the most controversial section of all—the impacted areas program which aids school districts affected by federal activity. Congress likes to increase it each year and Nixon wants to cut it drastically.

Nixon didn't budget a penny for it this year in its present form but said he would put \$425 million into a substantially revised program. There is no chance Congress will accept the proposed revisions and it will be increased to more than \$425 million into impacted aid, which would further dent Nixon's budget.

Carswell Nomination Appears To Be Doomed

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Senate Republican leaders have told the White House that G. Harold Carswell cannot win confirmation to the Supreme Court. The Senate will vote April 6 on a motion to send the nomination back to committee — tantamount to killing it.

The GOP leadership vigorously denied late Wednesday they gave such a report to President Nixon. But UPI learned through a GOP source that Senate Republican leaders had indeed forwarded to the White House a memo on vote breakdowns. The memo said the Republicans could not defeat a motion to return the nomination to committee.

The disclosure touched off speculation Nixon will withdraw the nomination to avoid the spectacle of public defeat. A Democrat active in the battle to deny Carswell a seat on the court says the anti-Carswell bloc has won over 12 Republicans. They, combined

with the 39 Democrats who voted to deny confirmation to Clement F. Haynsworth Jr., Nixon's first choice for the vacancy, would produce the 51 votes necessary to defeat Carswell.

The April 5 vote will come on a motion to resubmit the nomination to the Judiciary Committee. Even Carswell's supporters, including Assistant Republican Leader Robert P. Griffin, admit such a move would in effect kill the nomination.

The anti-Carswell bloc was hopeful Senate Democratic Leader Mike Mansfield, so far could not defeat a motion to return the nomination to committee.

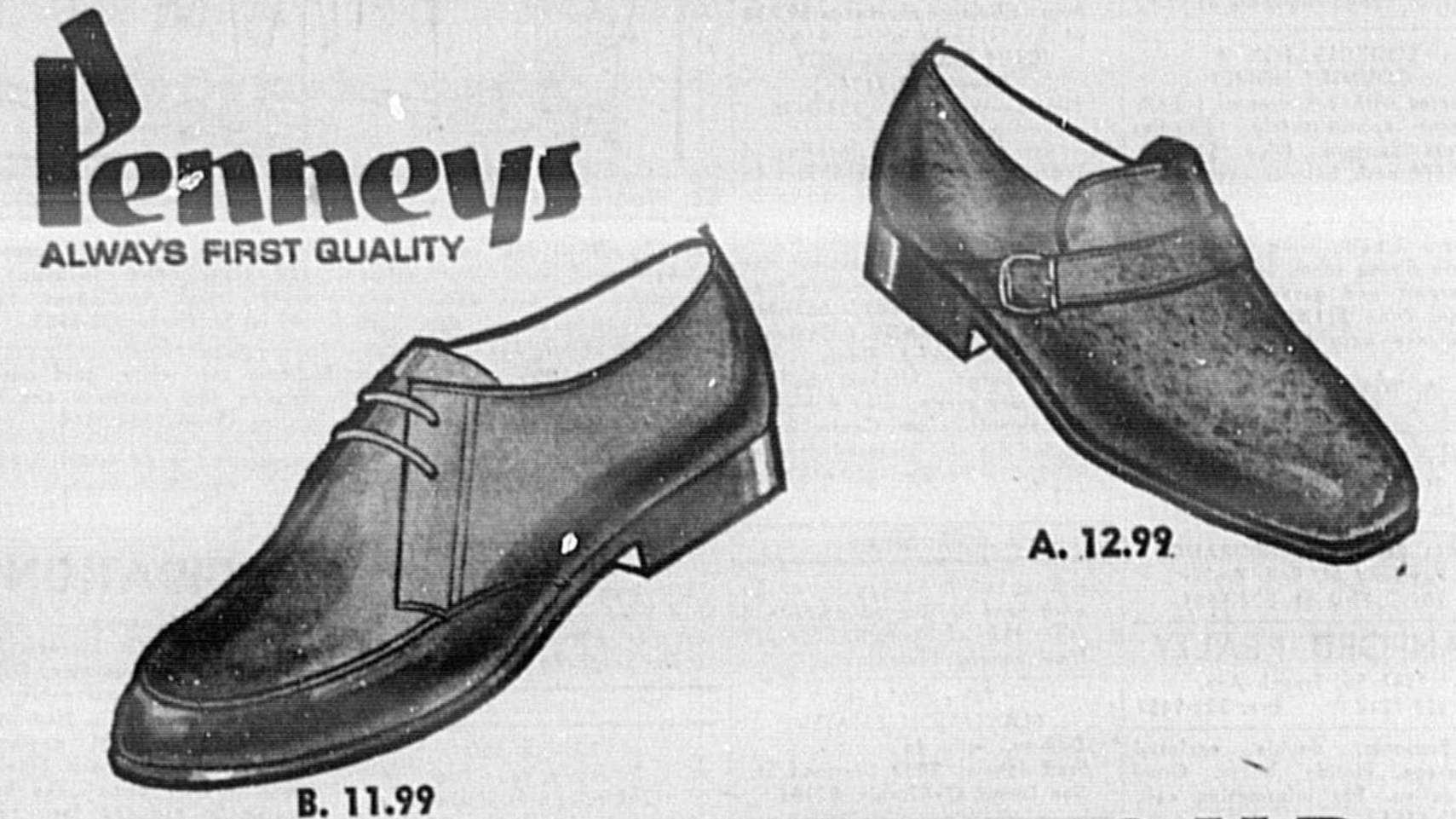

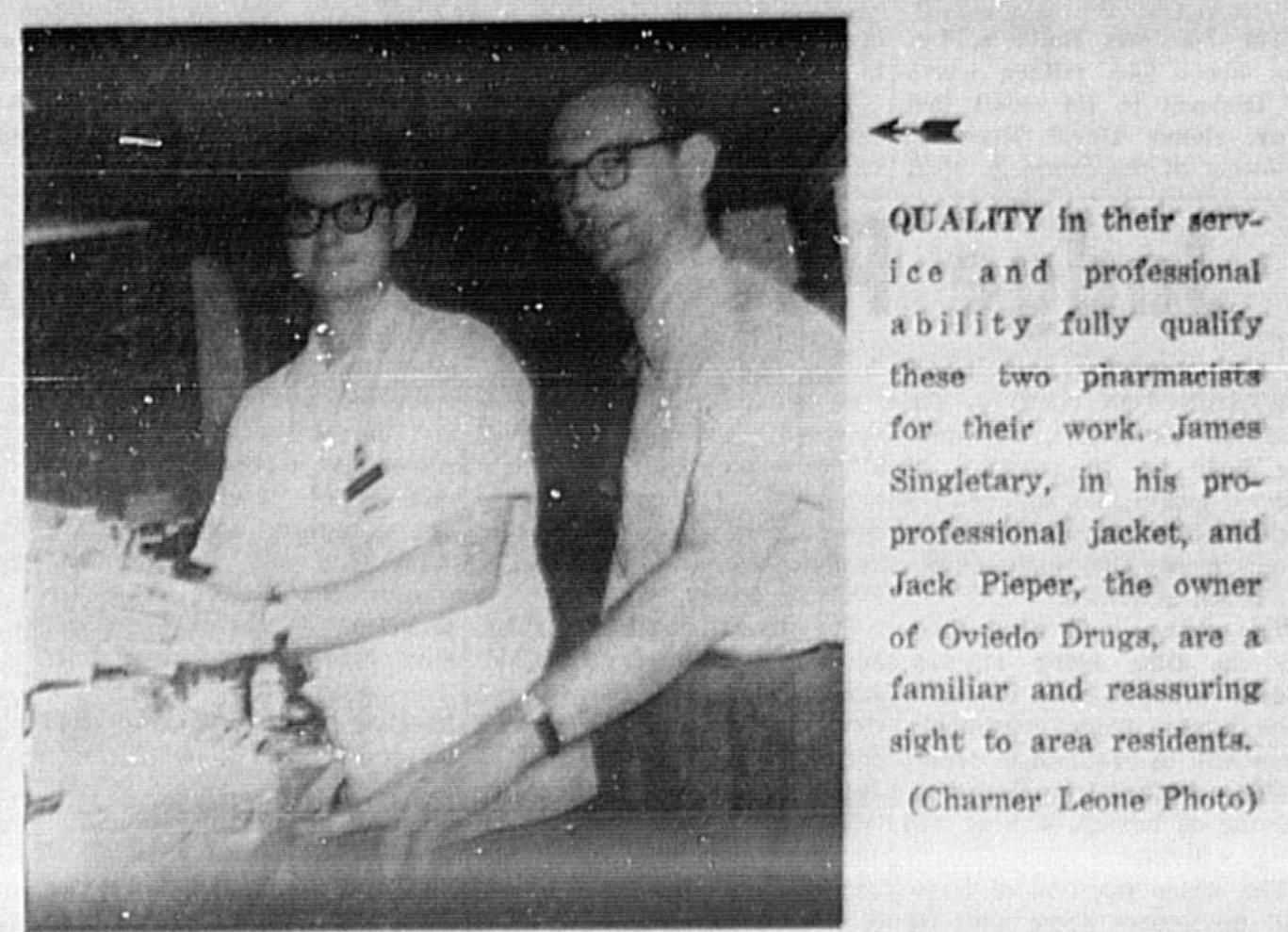

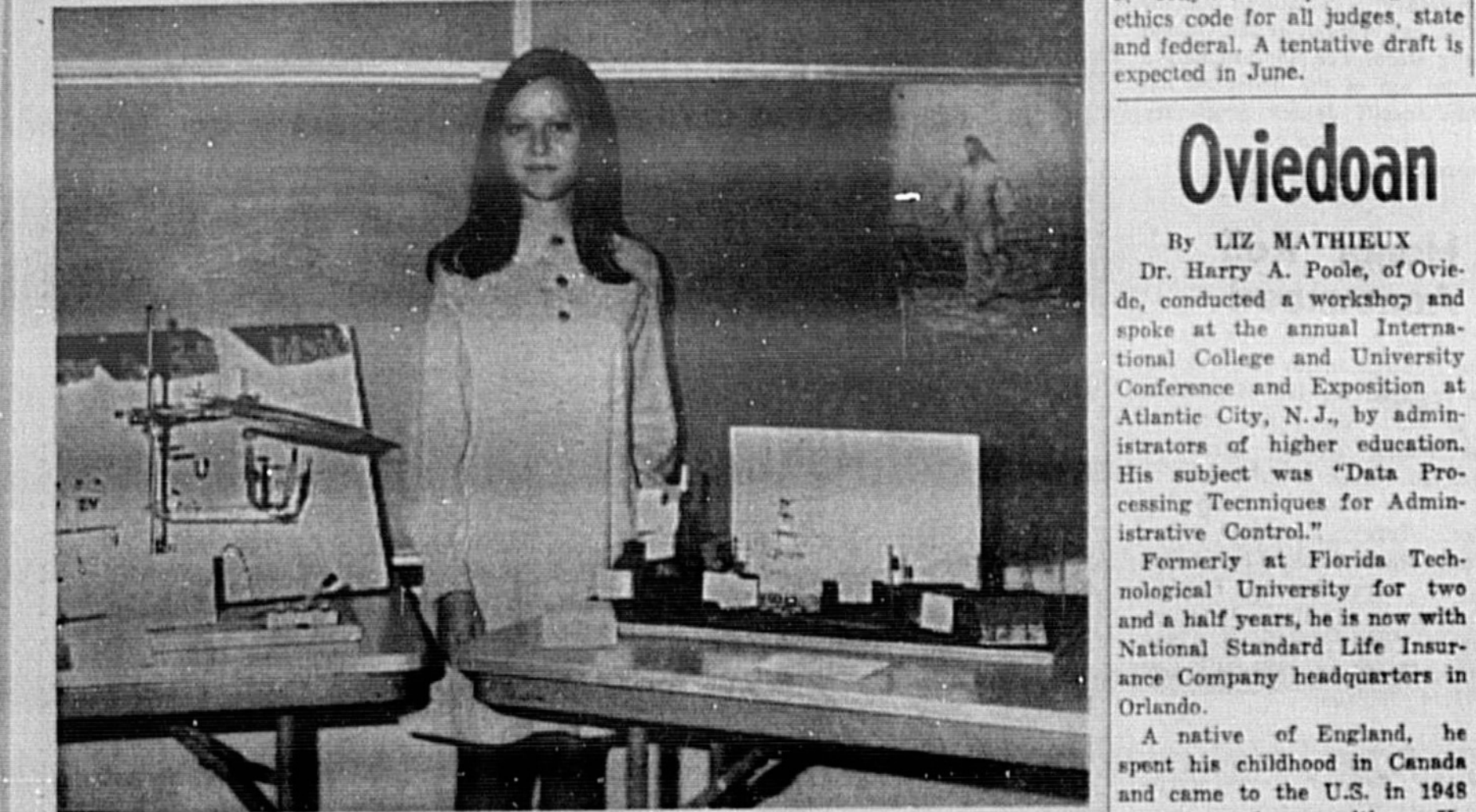
Judge Pay Rules Are Softened

Justice Abe Fortas last May. He left the bench after it was revealed he had received \$25,000 a year from the family foundation of Louis Wolfson, a man later jailed on charges involving the sale of unregistered securities.

Under the Warren disclosure program, judges also would have made annual reports of their income from all sources, including "investments and other assets." The character of U.S. Circuit Court Judge Clement F. Haynsworth Jr.'s investment portfolio was one of the factors that led to the rejection by the Senate of his nomination for the Supreme Court.

But by virtue of Wednesday's conference action, a federal judge will report only income from services and gifts of more than \$10 to him or his immediate family.

These reports will be filed on June 30 and Dec. 31 with the conference committee, with the appropriate Circuit Judicial Council and in the clerk's office of the court in which the judge is a member. Reports in the clerk's offices are open to public inspection. All the rules are in effect only until an American Bar Association committee headed by former California Chief Justice Roger J. Traynor completes a new ethics code for all judges state and federal. A tentative draft is expected in June.

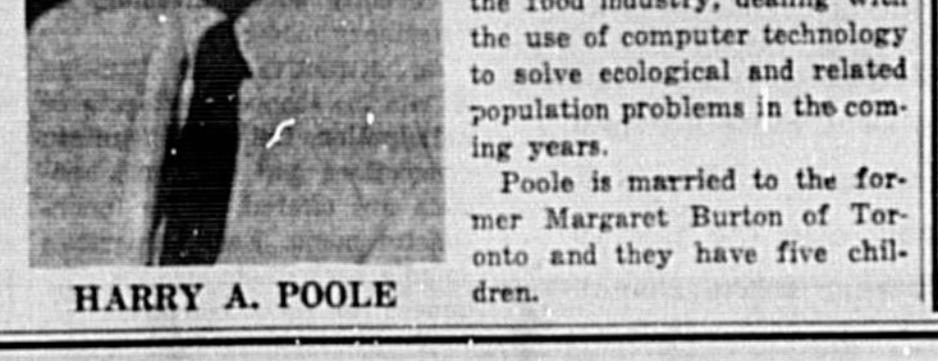

County Enacts Law For Rock Festivals

Board of Seminole County Commissioners met in special session to approve an ordinance to provide for the control and regulation of groups or gatherings of persons in the open, which would include "rock festivals."

The ordinance relates to musical or entertainment festivals within Seminole County, providing for definitions; requiring the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County to issue special entertainment permits for the holding of any musical or entertainment festival; setting standards for the issuance of permits; prohibiting operation of any festival for more than eight hours without an intervening 24-hour period; providing that children under the age of 17 years attending such festivals must be accompanied by a parent or guardian; authorizing the setting of fees and imposing penalties.
