1 and one-third cups water
two-thirds cup uncooked regular rice
1/2 cup chopped celery
1 teaspoon instant minced onion
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 can (10 3/4 oz.) condensed cream of celery soup, undiluted
3/4 cup chopped cooked chicken or turkey OR 1 can (5 to 6 1/2 oz.) boned chicken
1/4 cup milk
1 jar (2 oz.) chopped pimiento
1 tablespoon lemon juice
8 hard-cooked eggs, wedged (See below)
2 tablespoons fine dry bread crumbs
2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese
1/2 teaspoon paprika

PARLEY SPRIGS, OPTIONAL
In large saucepan bring water, rice, celery, onion and salt to boil. Reduce heat, cover and simmer until water is absorbed, about 15 to 20 minutes. Stir in soup, chicken, milk, pimiento and lemon juice. Add eggs and toss lightly to mix. Turn into greased 1 1/2-quart casserole. Combine crumbs, cheese and paprika. Sprinkle over casserole. Bake in preheated 350 degree F. oven until heated through, about 20 minutes. Garnish with parley sprigs, if desired.

To hard-cook, put eggs in single layer in saucepan. Add enough tap water to come at least 1 inch above eggs. Cover and quickly bring just to boiling. Turn off heat. If necessary, remove pan from burner to prevent further boiling. Let eggs stand covered in the hot water 15 to 17 minutes for Large eggs. (Adjust time up or down by about 3 minutes for each size larger or smaller.) Immediately run cold water over eggs or put them in ice water until completely cooled. To remove shell, crackle it by tapping gently all over. Roll egg between hands to loosen shell, then peel, starting at large end. Hold egg under running cold water or dip in bowl of water to help ease off shell.

SWEET AND SOUR CHICKEN

1 medium green pepper, cut in squares
1 cup sliced carrot
2 tablespoons salad oil
1 can (10 1/2 ounces) au jus gravy
1 cup cubed cooked chicken
1 tablespoon brown sugar
1 tablespoon soy sauce
2 teaspoons vinegar

In skillet, cook green pepper and carrot in oil until tender. Add remaining ingredients except rice. Cook a few minutes to blend flavors. Serve with rice. This kitchen-tested recipe makes about 2 1/2 cups, 3 servings.

PARMESAN CHICKEN BAKE

6 medium baking potatoes (about 2 pounds)
2 tablespoons butter or margarine
1 can (10 3/4 ounces) condensed cream of chicken soup
1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
2 tablespoons chopped parsley
1 cup cubed cooked chicken

Bake potatoes until done. Cut potatoes in half lengthwise; scoop out insides leaving a thin shell. With electric mixer, mash potatoes with butter. Gradually add soup, cheese and parsley; beat until light and fluffy. Fold in chicken. Spoon into shells; sprinkle with additional Parmesan cheese. Arrange potatoes in 3-quart shallow baking dish (13-by-9-by-2-inch). Bake at 400-degrees for 15 minutes or until hot. This kitchen-tested recipe makes 3 to 4 servings.

SAN FRANCISCO CHICKEN AND RICE

2 to 3 cups sliced uncooked chicken
2 tablespoons butter or margarine
1 cup sliced onions
1 cup diagonally sliced celery
1 can (5 to 6 ounces) sliced bamboo shoots, drained
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
1/4 cup chicken broth
3 tablespoons soy sauce
3 cups cooked rice

Cook chicken in butter 5 minutes, stirring often. Add onions and celery and cook 5 minutes more. Add remaining ingredients and cook until liquid is absorbed. Serve with additional soy sauce, if desired. Makes 6 servings.

East meets West on Feb. 5 to celebrate Chinese New Year. On that day, the old Year of the Monkey will give way to the New Year of the Rooster.

In Chinese communities, fireworks and good wishes hail the New Year. At midnight, cries of "Gung Ho Y Fet Toy" (Happy New Year) ring in the streets and throughout the household. Chinese New Year also is a "delicious time" as it is the occasion for the biggest feast of the year in China. To celebrate the festive day, home economists have created a welcoming menu sure to please even the fussiest dinner guest.

The dish features chicken nestled in a bed of spinach seasoned with garlic and sesame. Sply hot Imperial Chicken is as divine to look at as it is delightful to eat. And it's not difficult to make.

CHINESE IMPERIAL CHICKEN

- 1 1/2 lbs. skinned, boned chicken breasts, cut into 1-inch pieces
- MARINADE:**
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
 - 1/2 teaspoon dry vermouth
 - 1 teaspoon Oriental sesame oil
 - 2 tablespoons cold water
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- SPINACH MIXTURE**
- 2 packages (10 oz. each) frozen spinach
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 1 teaspoon Oriental sesame oil
 - 1 tablespoon minced garlic
- VEGETABLE MIXTURE**
- 2 tablespoons mixed green onion
 - 2 tablespoons minced fresh ginger
 - 2 tablespoons minced garlic
 - 3 cans (8 oz. each) water chestnuts, drained and halved
- SAUCE MIXTURE**
- 2 tablespoons dry vermouth
 - 2 tablespoons soy sauce
 - 1 1/2 tablespoons sugar
 - 1 1/2 teaspoons Oriental sesame oil
 - 1/4 teaspoon hot pepper sauce, or to taste
 - one-third cup chicken broth
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch
 - 1 qt. cooking oil
 - 1/2 cups roasted cashews (if salted, shake in sieve to remove salt)

Combine all ingredients for marinade and pour over chicken, mixing well. Let stand 20 minutes at room temperature.

Meanwhile, cook spinach according to package directions. Rinse under cold water to stop cooking; drain. Toss with seasonings. Arrange around border of serving platter. Set aside. Combine sauce mixture; set aside.

In wok or deep saucer, heat oil for deep frying. Drain chicken pieces; fry a few at a time until golden brown. Drain on paper towels.

In a large skillet or wok placed over medium high heat, heat three tablespoons cooking oil. Add vegetable mixture; cook and stir until sauce thickens. Add chicken pieces and cashews; cook and stir 1 to 2 minutes or until chicken is heated through. Spoon into center of serving platter. Serve immediately.

ORIENTAL BROCCOLI AND BEAN SPROUT SALAD (8 Servings)

2 lbs. fresh broccoli
1/4 cup soy sauce
1/4 cup cooking oil
1 cup drained pineapple chunks (reserve syrup)
1 can (8 oz.) water chestnuts, drained, cut in half
1/4 cup reserved pineapple syrup
1/4 cup chicken broth
1/4 cup sugar
1/4 cup cornstarch
