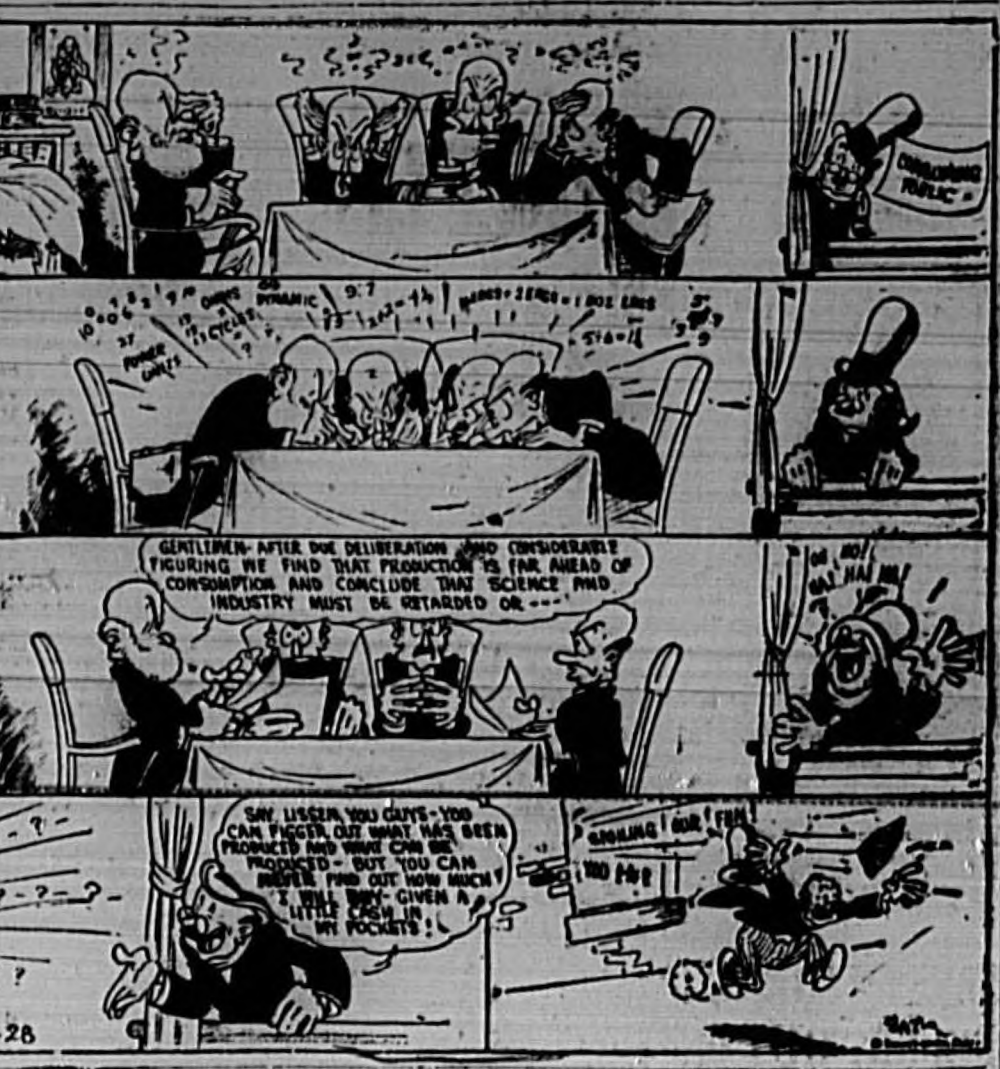
"I am just sorry his mind is so deranged," the mayor said in his comment concerning Zangara. "The nation should learn from the incident is that we should all work together for the common good..."

Palatka Is Hit By Mild Epidemic Of Peculiar Ailment

PALATKA, Feb. 22.—A mild epidemic which manifests itself in violent stomach pains, accompanied by nausea, usually passing off within 36 to 48 hours was puzzling Palatka physicians yesterday...

Most of the local physicians, interviewed by The News yesterday were of the opinion that the disease, which strikes suddenly and leaves in similar manner, was not traceable to food or water...

Dr. John T. Hosay was positive that the illness was caused by an atmospheric condition, similar to that frequently experienced in the spring of the year in Middle Mississippi, Alabama and Georgia.

The local epidemic is of mild nature, it was reported, and many cases were not reported to the medical authorities at all. Many of the afflicted thought that the indisposition was caused by something, which they had eaten and took only home remedies it was reported.

Dr. H. A. Johnson reported that he had between 75 and 100 cases, many of which did not visit the office but called on the telephone for advice. This was generally the experience of other doctors.
