## Teamsters Union

 Needs MonitoringThe International Brotherhood of
Teamsters is one of the nation's largest and Teamsters is one of the nation's largest and
most politically sophisticated labor unions. The Teamsters also have the dublous distinction of being one of the nation's most corrupt labor unlons.
Labor Secre
Labor Secretary William Brock ventilated that sordid distinction in an unusually tough
speech before the recent Tcamsters convention in Las Vegas. Brock's blast, which came just four days after the Indictment of union
president Jackie Presser. put the Teamsters president Jackie Presser. put the Teamsters
on notice that continued failure to rid the further federal probes into the union's Secretary Brock was right on target. A union is long overdue.
Teamster ties to organized crime go back to the early 1930s. when the unlon's strong-arm boys extorted protection money from vulner
able shippers. Such criminal actuvity has grown over the years as a succession of
Teamster presidents have betrayed the union's rank-and-file.
During the 1950s. Dave Beck misappropriuse. Convicted of larceny and income-tax use. Convicted of larceny and income-tax
evasion. he served 30 months in prison. His
successor. Jimmy Hoffa. so abused the successor, Jimmy Hoffa. so abused the
Teamster pension fund that new laws were Teamster pension fund that new laws were
enacted to safeguard such funds. Convicted of jury tampering. he did time and then disappeared in 1975 . presumed murdered by the mob. Hoffa's deslgnated stand.In. Frank Fitzsimmons, was indicted for accepting
payoffs from employers. but plea-bargained payoffs from employers. but plea-bargatned
his way out of a prison term. Roy Willams was convicted in 1983 of trying to bribe a
U.S. senator and is currently serving a U.S. senator and is currently serving a
10-year sentence. Which brings us back to Presser. Who
stands accused of skimming $\$ 700.000$ from his Cleveland local in a payroll-padding scheme. If convicted of federal racketecring
and embezzlement charges. he faces up to 51 years imprisonment. Undaunted, the conven tngly to another five-year term.

| Healthy trees that have sustatned only moderatle damage usually can be saved by proper pruning. Try to get this done as somon as possible. Broken branches should be cut back to the next lower crotch. If it is a very large itmb. you may want to cut it back in manageable pteces to sound wood in the middle of the branch. This involvess sawing about a third of the way through the limb from the underside between healthy wood and the broken limb-preferably a foot or so from the inches out and cut down from the top unill the limb is severed cleanly. # Marilyn Monroe: Still A Hot Property

beverly hills (NEA) Marlyn Monroe would have been 60 years old on June 1. and to celebrate her birthday lind to make lots of money). more than 40 companles plan to the Monroe name and tmage to hustic their products.
An electronically animated photo of the star will be seen munching on a Hershey's bar on TV commerctals. Monres's face will grace the cover of mall-order catalogs. Women will be able to slip into bathing sults adorned with pictures of the actress's face. There are illso Marilyn Monroc dolls la limited edition of 300 at 86.500 aplece is already sold out). pens. calendars. greeting cards. dresses and coal hangers.
Those are some of the legal. authurlzed licensees of the late star.
Roger Richinan. the exclusive licensing agent of the Monroe estate. spends much of his time kecping unauthorized Monroe merchandlse off the market.
An attorney and former film producer. Richman sees himself as both a licensing agent and a quality control acsthete. Unauthorized merchandise not only cheats the Monroe estate out of royalty rights, but is invartably tacky.
In his Beverly Hills sulte adorned with both tasteful and grotesquemonroc memorablla, Rlehman. 42. holds court. "l'm_chargud-wth
not only making money for the estate. but with stopping abuse. too." he says.
Richman recently stopped distribution of ${ }^{\text {•Inside }}$ Marllyn." a German porno fllm which used a look-alike actress. Why should the Firs Amendment proleet that sort of thing?" he asks. "We're dealing with a legend here!'
Richman has also stopped mail-order businesses from selling nowers and rubbings from the star's grave and pic ces of bed sheets allegedly slept on by Monroc. A "Bearhyn Monroce" teddy bear is another product he's trying to have removed from the market.
Various federal court rulings and a 1984 California law that forbld the use of celebrity likenesses without permission have put muscle into Richman's fight against Monroe ripoffs.
Royallies range from 7 to 12.5 percent of wholesale revenues, depending on the product's profit margin. The estate earns anywhere from $\$ 2,500$ to $\$ 50.000$ per product en. dorsement.
Richman won't say what his cut of the royalties is, but he defends himself form accusallons of profiting from the dead. "I'm not dealling with dead prople. I.m not licensing Marilyn Monroe. but the character she developed. It's a rademark. And It goes to a

Monroe left the bulk of her estate to her acting coach, Lee Strasberg. and her psychlatrist. who was instructed to set up a fund for the study of child psycholopy. The psychalrist Lave the money to the Anna Freud Cilnte in l.ondon, which sprelalizes in child psychology. Monroc's bequests reflect the high and low polnts of her life. Sirasberg is credited with turnlag lier inio a serious actress. Monroe's support of child psychology may have derlved from her own childhood experiences with sexual abuse.
Richman also represents the estates of W.C. Fields. Albert Elnsteln. Clark Gable and Mae West. as well as living legends like Marlene Dietrich and Elizabeth Taylor, among others.
When Richman was trying to ram the Callfornia Celebrity Rights Act through the state legislature in 1984. only Taylor, of the 80 stars solictied by Richman, agreed to testily before the state Senate Richman credits her appear. ance with getting the bill passed.
Living as well as deceased legends have always attracted thejr share of crazy men with crazy Ideas, and as the representative of these legends. so has Richman. He says he recelves letters and phone calls from people claiming to be Monroe's illeglitinate children.

NEW YORK (UPI) - It is the dreps, the plts. Whe slop. the slime. the absolute worst you ran find and. all things consid. cred. It should make for pretty peod viewing.
A soda company is sponsoring what is perhaps the least annictpated serits in modern lelevision history. He "Canned Film Festival." a string of 13 talle-nght films over the next 13 weeks. (Cheek local lisilngs for day and time in your area).
The serjes was created by Dr. Prepper Co.'s aduertising abency. Young \& Rubicam. and targeted spectlically to Dr . I'epper's consumer profite -- young. independent thinkers with a taste for the unusual.
The soda folks make no tones about it. This series. natlonally syndicated to conough stations to cover 75 percent of the country, features "the best of the worst movies ever made." They are not grade A. nor are they even grade B. These are stricily grade $F$
classics.
Jayne Mansfleld. Mamte Van Doren. Bela Lusosi and Pla Zadora are Just al few of the film laminarles who. tor onse reason or another. are gallity of piritelpating in these flops.

Some of the flicks are proud wimers of the Golden Turkey Awards. Others smaghed Son of Golden Turkey Awards. For a seleat few. the only sultable shrine is the Hollywiod Hall of Shame.
The monsters are the best: a rubber oetopus. a crawling hand. a goкey brails. grimy blabs. a gorillat in deep-sea diving helmet and untamed istand women on the prowl for al lew geod men.
Besides these horrors, the films feature some of the worst directors and actors in fllm history.

But the gentle viewer does not only get the worst in film history. Introducing each novie and Interwoven Ifrough commerclal breaks are comedy vigneltes. each linked thematically to the feature
presentation. whether it be "las Vegas Hillbillies" or Simia Claus Conquers the Martlans.
The sertes revolves around a grand old theater in a small Millwestern lowill. Laralne Newman of "Sallurday Night l. Ive" fameplaysa down-on-her-luck usherette whose dad oner owned the Howater and whose mom stlll plays the organ there. She fantasizes about sell-oul crowds but seltles for the five regulars who show up every nipht.

The key to these creations, she sald, is simplicity in both materlals and design. But If's a simplicity that produces dramatic resulfs.

Mer first students, she sald, "dldn't have the concentration or the abllity to do large palntings. I needad some kind of prolect for them, so I daveloped this Iftie watercolor, which with very specific instructions they could come up with something they could be proud of.
"It's simple and I try to keep it that way. People who have had watercolors before want to bring in all of their colors. I really encourage them to bring only three and to look af this as a very simple
Impressionisfic painting.
"People who have never painfed before, who have never had a brush in their hand, who know nothing about color, cain still come up with something.
"I have broken if down into steps. First, 90 pound watercolor paper is mounted with concealed masking tape to a folded card. She uses only three colors, red, yellow and blue as her color mix," Mrs.


Harrington sald.
When she's ready to paint she puts a piece of masking tape where the horizon will be in the scene. "Then you mix the blue for your water and you palint. I encourge them to paint only two strokes across the paper. That's your wafer.
"Then you remove the tape and dilute that same paint and make the sky with just two strokes. You take the sky color that was left over and add a little bit more color to make a beach color. You put one stroke down for the beach.
"If I can keep them (students) from wanting to put in a little boat, a biro and a bather, it stays pretty simple.
"When I'm feaching how to paint the sunrise or sunset they follow the same steps, but I'm not opposed to using anything that will help." Mrs. Harrington confessed that she carries a container of tiny paper circles, the residue left from a paper punch, which she hands out to students who glve them to their scenes to serve as suns
"Usually when I teach this class I have the same people come back until they get it. It's a good way to discipline themselves to get time to paint. When I have a lot of people who have repeated the class I try to dosamathing different. usually do a session in

Ilowers."
Bypassing har on fest watercolor fechnique, in a flash Mrs. Herringlon cen also turn out a bembeo adorned card, with the design sketched with artist's pens. A fechnique she also passes aleng to students.
Beyond her wafercolor cards is Mrs. Harringiton's embossing, which can add raised names, Intlals, or designs to plain peper. Embossing too is a simple skill that produces charming results.
Mrs. Harrington works on aglass surface and first draws and cuts a pattern Into a paper sheet, using a hobby knlfe.
A paper card with a cutout center is used as a frame to lift from the surface of the glass the paper that will be embossed. Mrs.
Harringion's patfern is placed in reverse over the card paper and using a sharpened half of a springed-clothes pin she presses the design into the paper, creating a ralsed deslgn on the reversed side of the card paper.
Her technlques are quick and easy. Creatling your own greeting cards, it seems, can be easier than weeding through rack after rack of commercially produced cards to plek the one that has that special touch.
