'Such Stars In Lynda's Eyes,' Says Lady Bird

WASHINGTON (AP) — "I'm happy," said the President's wife, "there are such stars in Lynda's eyes."

Lady Bird Johnson's comment summed up a day of talk about a White House wedding, the complications presented by the prospective bridegroom's forthcoming assignment to Vietnam, and the difficulties involved in the marriage of a Marine captain to the daughter of the commander in chief.

Lynda Bird Johnson, 23, and her fiancé, Capt. Charles S. Robb, 28, met reporters today on the South Lawn of the White House. Robb's duty station on occasion is a White House social aide. Robb, whose family lives in Milwaukee, Wis., said he asked President Johnson for Lynda's hand in marriage.

But he said he didn't want to try to meet the new because "I wouldn't want to misquote him."

Bea Abbott, the first lady's press secretary, said the wedding, set for an unspecified date in early December, would be in the East Room of the White House.

And the Pentagon, reacting to the matter of interest in the said Marine career officer, assigned him his own press aide — 25-year-old Nancy L. Ryan, lamb of Lafayette, Ind. The White House immediately began referring all queries to Lynda, who is on the staff of the assistant secretary of defense for public affairs.

One of his first tasks was to give out the information that Robb will be assigned to Vietnam in mid-March, not February as first announced.

Lynda and Robb said most of their plans for the future have not been worked out. Lynda said she didn't know whether she will continue to live in the White House after Robb is sent to Vietnam.

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn. (AP) — Ronald Hoover, 16, a student at Central High School, was struck in a car Aug. 26 and his leg fractured in the accident as he rode to school.

Hoover was taken to police hospital, where an ambulance call promising to "do a better job next time."

Hoover was walking in front of the high school when a car turned by barely missing him. Police believe the incident was "aggravated assault with an automobile."

Hoover said police had no leads on the matter.

Fix Chopper's Radio Fast

WASHINGTON (AP) — A trio of compact radios, designed to speed servicing and allow helicopters to return rapidly to regular operations was described here by Fred W. Wilkins.

Wilkins, a deputy program manager for the Light Observation Helicopter Avionics Package of Sikorsky, said the American Helicopter Society's annual national forum. "For the first time, the Army can predict how long it will take to repair a radio."

Built-in automatic monitoring circuits will allow crews to detect within seconds a faulty receiver or transmitter. A portable test set permits isolation and replacement of the faulty module or subassembly in the radio.

The three transceivers weigh less than one-third the weight of comparable radios, Wilkins said, and are small enough to be mounted in the helicopter's instrument panel.

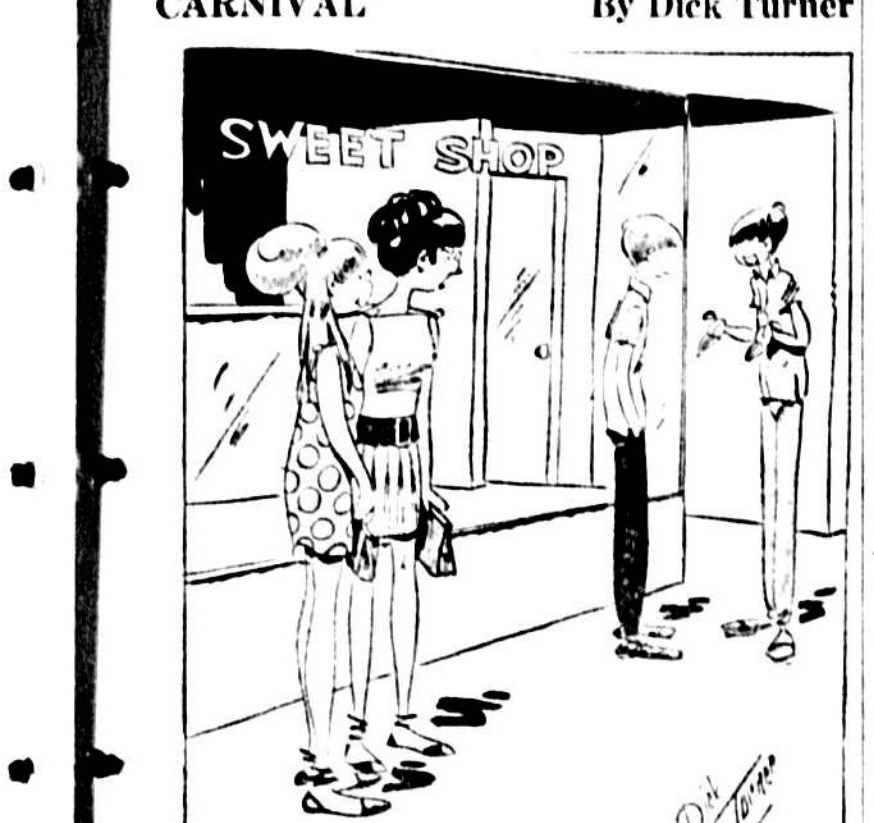

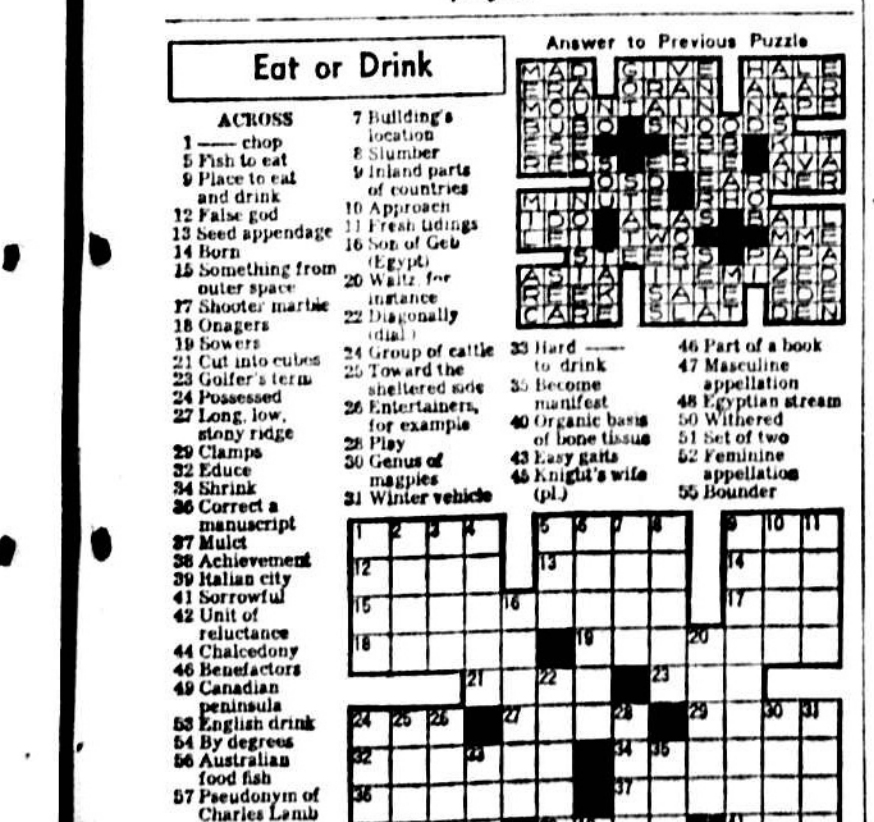

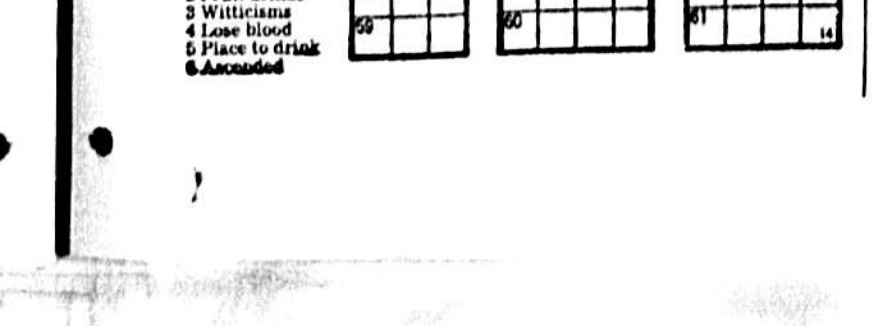
