School Clerical Workers Get Pay Raise

Seminole County property taxes will contribute approximately \$118,000 towards the total pay and benefit increase negotiated by school clerical workers for their 1980 to 1981 contract.

The total negotiated increase will cost the school board \$692,800 the difference to be paid from state funds, said Roger L. Harris, Seminole County School Board assistant superintendent for business and finance.

The Seminole County School Board and the Seminole Educational Clerical Association reached agreement Tuesday on the three-year contract which will affect about 570 school employees including secretaries, bookkeepers, clerical aides, audio visual technicians and data entry operators.

The agreement will increase the base salaries of instructional aides, clerical aides, technical aides and bus instructional aides by \$111 annually, from the 1979 to 1980 base salary of \$5,275 to \$5,794. With 15 years experience, employees in this category could earn a salary of \$9,168.

In the highest paid clerical category, salaries will go from the 1979 to 1980 range of \$8,217 to \$11,462 to the new range of \$9,025 to \$12,880. The top salary is achieved only after 15 years experience, Harris said.

There are 11 other salary schedules, he said. The contract agreement will cost the school board more than last year, Harris said. Negotiators for the clerical workers had asked for a 30 percent increase.

The salary increase itself accounts for a 9.8 percent increase, Harris said.
