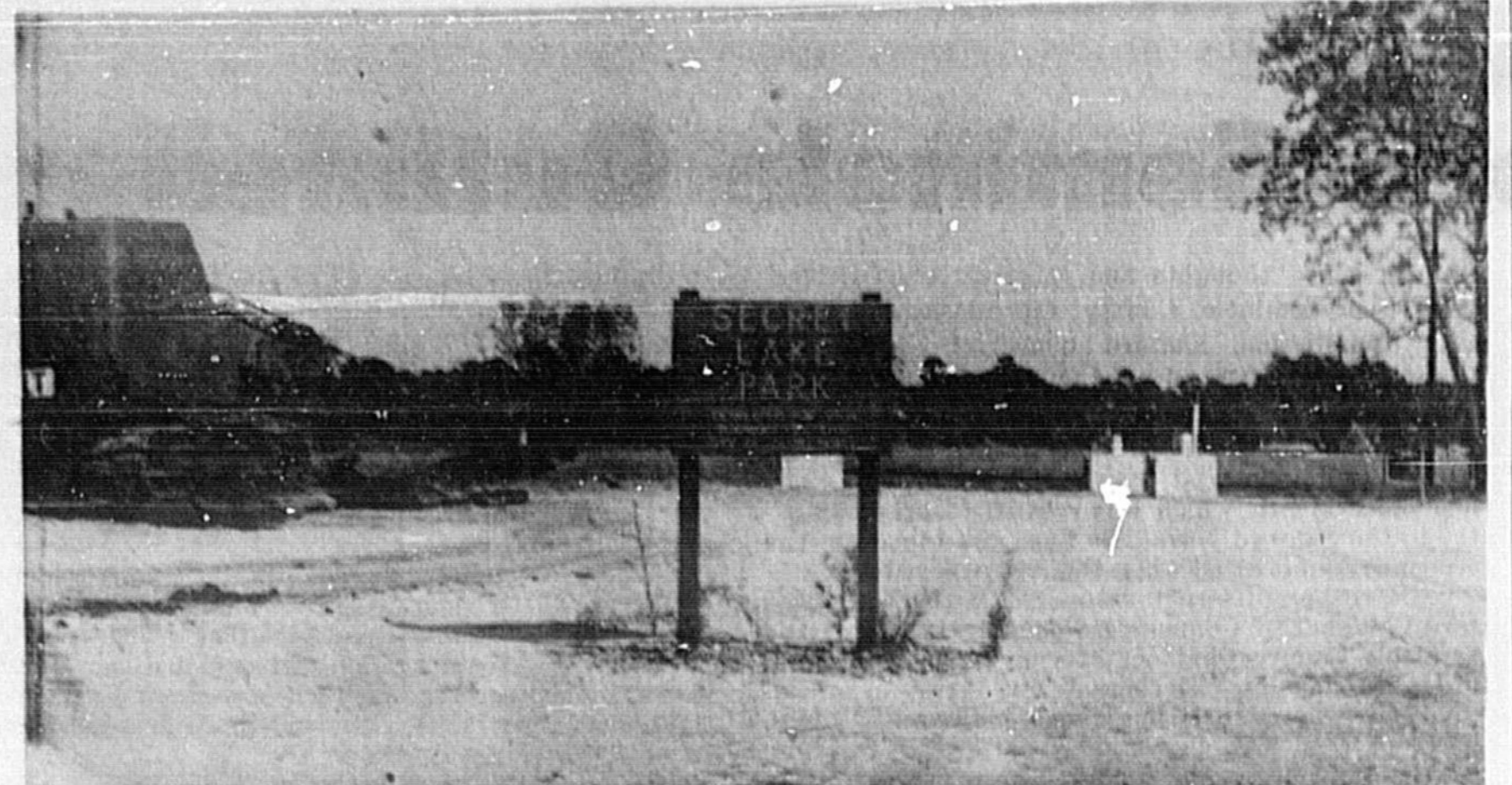

Parents Dispute Federal Mix Plan

ORLANDO, Fla. (AP) — A school desegregation plan that drew sharp cries of rejection from white parents has been cast aside by federal officials as being in violation of Nixon administration policies. ... The plan called for 80-20 busing of children to most of Orange County's 97 schools — left school officials empty-handed only two days away from a court-ordered deadline.

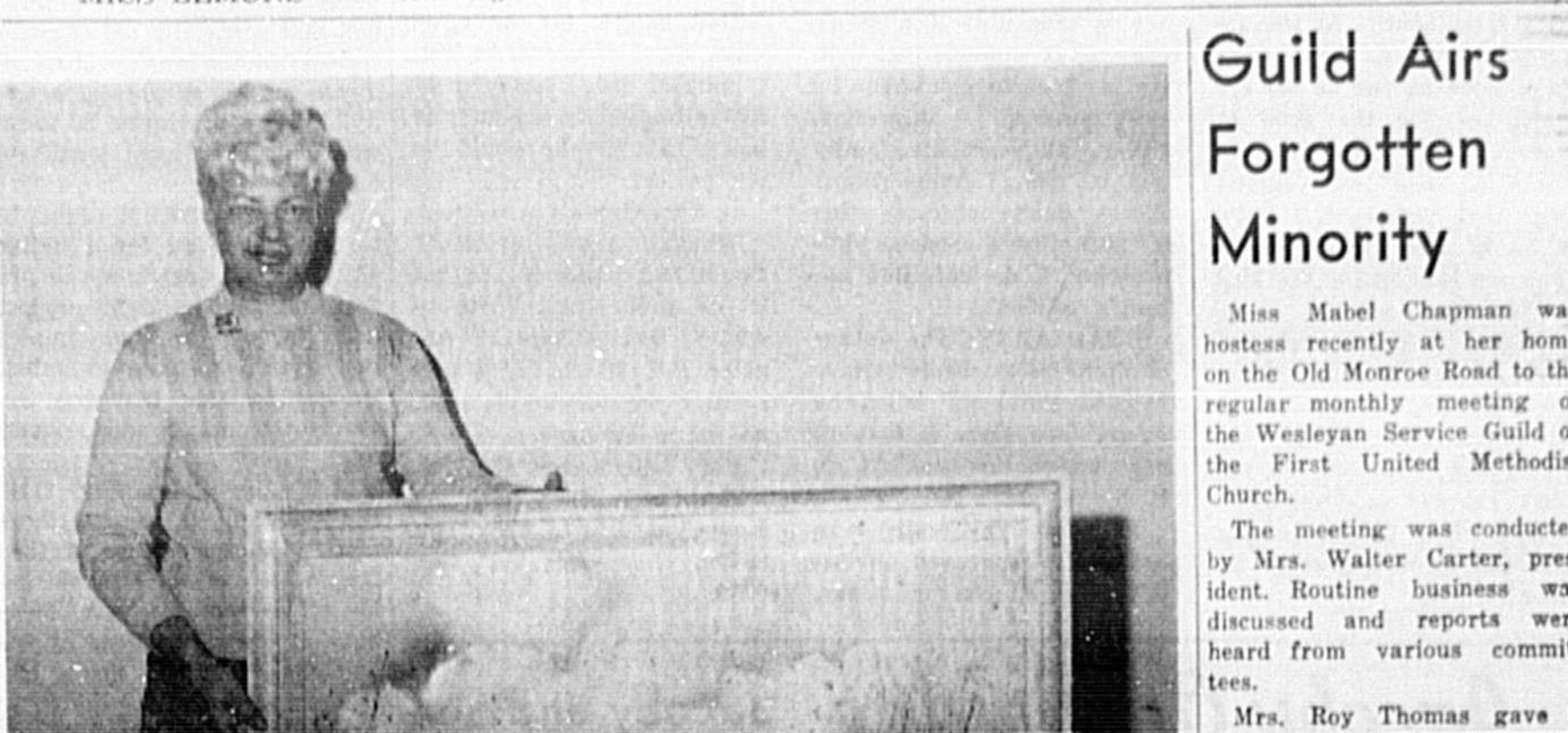
