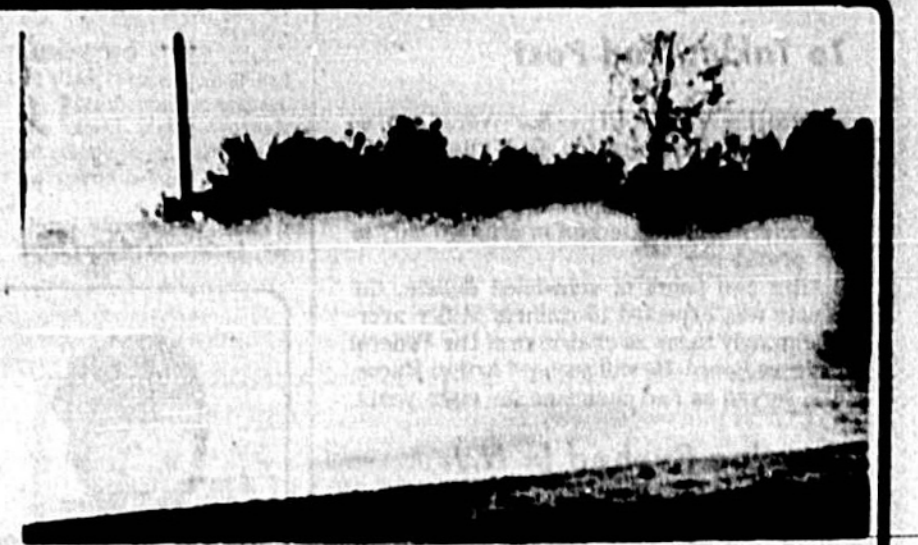

## Judge: No Bundy Samples; Lawyer Raps 'Expedition'

TALLAHASSEE (UPI) — A circuit judge today refused to order suspected mass murderer Theodore Bundy to give blood and handwriting samples and a public defender accused the state of conducting an illegal "fishing expedition."

Judge John Radd denied the motion by Assistant State Attorney Howard Holtendorff to force Bundy to furnish hair, blood, saliva and handwriting specimens, but said Holtendorff could try again later.

Radd agreed with Assistant Public Defender Joe Nurey that the state must be more specific in showing how the samples would be related to the charges Bundy now faces — car theft, forgery and burglary.

"This is merely a fishing expedition on the part of the state, trying to get body materials from Mr. Bundy they hope will tie up with something," Nurey said.

Bundy has been identified by authorities as the prime suspect in the Feb. 9 disappearance of Kimberly Elaine Louch of Lake City and the Jan. 13 deaths of two Florida State University students.

But the authorities have yet to produce any concrete evidence linking him to either crime.

Holtendorff said blood, hair and saliva samples are needed to compare with specimens taken from a white Dodge van Bundy is believed to have stolen from FBI and driven to Lake City about the time Kimberly disappeared.

The van was spotted near a land fill at Live Oak and the search for the 15-year-old girl was concentrated in that area.

"He (the child-care worker) has made a statement to both the state's attorney's office and HRS and he absolutely denies the striking of any child with his fist, as alleged," stated DuBocher.

DuBocher's client, a child-care worker for more than two years at the center, is charged with striking five youths in a Feb. 20 fight. He was suspended the following day without pay.

"All five youths, ranging in age from 11 to 17, were examined at Seminole County Memorial Hospital. One youth suffered an laceration on his forehead, according to HRS officials. The other four sustained light bruises in the chest area, they reported.

DuBocher said release of exact details of the incident would be "premature" until formal charges, if any are brought against his client.

However, he did say the child-care worker was trying to prevent a fight between youths, when the incident occurred.

"We think that one boy was trying to attack another boy," said DuBocher. "At any rate, my client had to place himself in between the two boys to prevent the fight. The one boy literally tried to climb over him."

DuBocher said he knows "I don't think there is evidence to indicate the overcrowding at the facility was a particular factor in this incident." Doug Whitney, district legal counsel for HRS, said at a news conference last week.

## 'New Evidence' Slows Juvenile Center Probe Report On 'Beatings'

The report of a Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services (HRS) probe into the alleged beating of five inmates at the Seminole County Juvenile Detention Center last week has been delayed due to "new evidence," according to a spokesman for HRS.

A spokesman for HRS said the center has been closed since the incident, which allegedly occurred the previous day. He now declines to say how long the center will be closed, according to HRS officials.

The new evidence, according to John Hoag, HRS spokesman, was supplied by the child-care worker and his attorney. The worker, whose name is not being revealed, is being represented by former Orange County Juvenile Court Judge Joseph W. DuBocher, Orlando.

exact details of the incident would be "premature" until formal charges, if any are brought against his client. However, he did say the child-care worker was trying to prevent a fight between youths, when the incident occurred.

"We think that one boy was trying to attack another boy," said DuBocher. "At any rate, my client had to place himself in between the two boys to prevent the fight. The one boy literally tried to climb over him."

DuBocher said he knows "I don't think there is evidence to indicate the overcrowding at the facility was a particular factor in this incident." Doug Whitney, district legal counsel for HRS, said at a news conference last week.

"The granddiggers can put away their shovels, the funeral of the Republican party has been called off," said gubernatorial candidate Jack Eckerd Thursday night in a speech before the Seminole County Young Republicans Club.

Eckerd said the party was in serious trouble three years ago after the Watergate scandal, but today Watergate is hardly ever mentioned by the voters as he travels the state.

"The people are returning to the basic Republican philosophy of the government doing for the people only what they can't do for themselves. This year the people are waking up to the problems of the government," Eckerd said.

He criticized the ad-

ministration of Gov. Robin Ashby for failing to make industry in Florida, saying that while new industry in the past three years in Georgia has exceeded 10,000 new jobs, Alabama 17,000, South Carolina 64,000, Florida has gained only 2,000.
