any prospect of serious disagreement among the powers—that relating to the abolition of undersea craft. It can be stated now that there is exceed only little prospect of success on this point, Japan, France and Italy—but particularly France—regard the submarine as "the poor man's defense" and can be expected to fight the proposal to the last.

The position of the American government toward the submarine is one of almost indifference. Favored by geographical isolation and assured of surface naval power equal to any in the world, the United States is not dependent upon the submarine in any sense.

It was with some significance that the conference invitation contained no hint or intimation of extending the naval ratio established at the Washington conference to all classes of ships. That ratio was fixed as 5 for Great Britain and the United States; 3 for Japan, and 1.6 each for France and Italy.

From Tokyo have come repeated intimations that Japan is going into the forthcoming conference prepared to contest for an increased ratio in cruisers and submarines. From Paris and Rome have come more positive indications that France and Italy, rival powers on the Mediterranean, are not going to be content with the relatively minor roles assigned them in world naval power.

This is one, and perhaps the chief one, of the points which will be discussed and negotiated in the three months of private discussions between the two major powers have significantly allowed for in advance of the January gathering.
