Sanford's first reading of strong mayor ordinance passes with 6-2 vote

The Sanford City Commission took a significant step today in the process of changing the city's charter. The commission voted 6-2 to approve the first reading of a strong mayor ordinance.

The ordinance, which was introduced by Mayor [Name], would give the mayor the power to appoint and dismiss city officials, including the city manager and city council members.

The ordinance also would give the mayor the power to veto city council actions and to call special meetings of the council. The ordinance was passed by a vote of 6-2.

The ordinance is expected to be passed by the city council in the near future. The city council will have to vote on the ordinance at a public hearing.
