In the reckicas speculative etmosphere of he 1800n, a ellmate that Drexel promoted and profited from. Junk bonds were held out as a kind of free lunch: high-Interest supposed to carry no more rek of default than bonds of investment grade. The rosy pleture. baved on a small selection of compantes operating in atmatgrowint economy, crashed
last fall againat a difterent reatity: the crumbling of poorly structured Junk bond deals, raing intereat ratea, dechning earning In a torpld economy and buyer fight to Drexel to write down its extenatve junk bond
bolding and eventually driving it into
Remarkably. Drexel's fall has sent onily amall ripplee through the financlal world Without Drexed and ite customers to provide
capital. the already depressed junk bond sccondary market has few buyera and facea long recovery. That will especially huri Insurance companlea and thrifts in the Drexe orbl, which had heavily Invested in Drexel's portfolios shrink. But the stock market. whuch had watched
junk bond values plunge tast fall, seems aready to have adjunted ta the fact that Junk bond financing will no longer be readily avilibie to divive leveraged buy-outs and has preeted Drexel's collapoe seems to have
vindiceted the fudgment of the Federal Reserve and the Securities and Exchang damaging the nation's Inanclal markets. If Drexel's collapae caused the country litle harm, the game cannot be sald or has tenure as the darling of Wall Street. The junk bonds it

and provide fat fees to the companies that and provlde fat fees arranged the flnancing.

and cheerieader. Few Americans will mourn its passing.
