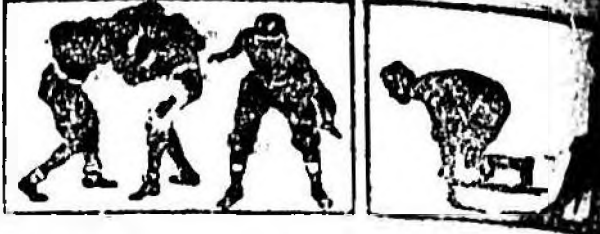

MERCER DOPED TO BEAT TARS BY 4 MARKERS

Bruins Have Been Seasoned by Hard Schedule; Have An Overpowering Line

Perfect football weather will greet the plucky warriors from Mercer and Rollins this afternoon when they clash here in the premier gridiron event in Florida today. The temperatures continued to be hot this morning and the prediction is for continued cool weather.

The Mercers are favored to win over the Rollins Tars by at least four touchdowns, according to the dopsters. Seasoned by a hard schedule, the Bears have the decided advantage over the Tars, whose schedule has not been as heavy this season as in other years. The Georgia invaders have a fine passing attack, an almost impregnable line and a good scoring record.

The Winter Park dopsters are confident the Tars will make a much better showing today than they did 10 days ago against Stetson, winner by a score of 32 to 0. The dopsters have been all wrong this year they say. The way the dope bucket has been knocked around makes old man dopster very unreliable, say Rollins men.

Here is the line of reasoning emanating from the Winter Park stronghold: The Tars' victory is about two touchdowns better than its freshmen team, which held the Mercer Cubs to 10 points last Monday. Princeton Severs Athletic Relations With Harvard In First Break Of 'Big Three'

PRINCETON, N. J., Nov. 11. (AP) One link of the 19c Three chain, strained to cracking point by the jibes of a Harvard humorous publication, has finally smashed and carried away with it the most colorful and ancient rivalry of the American college sport world.

Dr. Charles W. Keedy, chairman of the board of athletic control at Princeton University, announced that all athletic relations with Harvard have been broken. Resolutions adopted by the board and sent to Harvard authorities say that "Princeton would never accept the implications of the athletic policy recently adopted by the Harvard committee on regulation of athletic sports set forth in their resolution of Oct. 11."

The notice of the Harvard resolution was somewhat of a mystery until the break was announced in a report. The resolution was received at Princeton yesterday. It is understood that it provided only for Harvard's withdrawal from Princeton's athletic schedule.
