

LIVES LOST AS FLOOD STRIKES IN PORTO RICO

Inundation Is Caused By Tropical Storm Now Menacing West Indian Territories

By the Associated Press. Heavy rains in Porto Rico believed to be due to a cyclonic disturbance which has been hovering over that part of the Atlantic for several days, early yesterday caused floods which resulted in a considerable loss of life.

Tropical Storm Is Said Diminishing

WASHINGTON, Sept. 4.—(A.P.)—The Weather Bureau today said the tropical disturbance in the West Indies had moved southward over Haiti with diminishing intensity and apparently was central early today between Guantamano, Cuba and Navassa Island. It is expected by the bureau to maintain its westerly course.

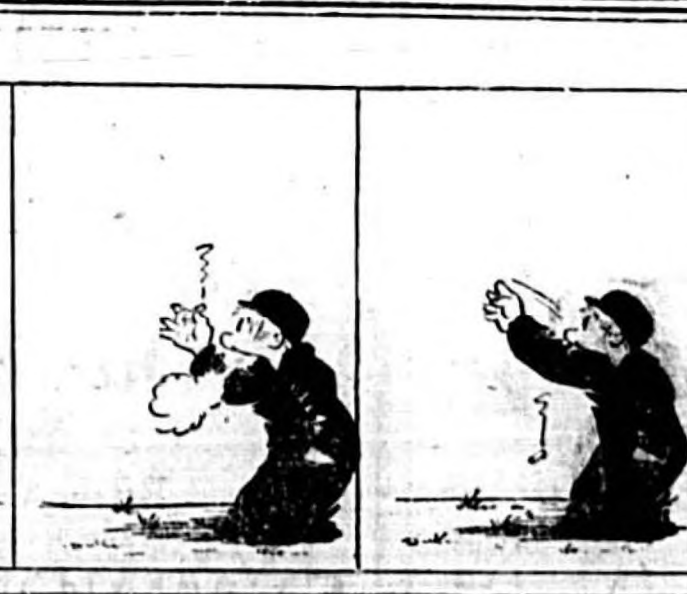
