An investigation by The Herald into zoning practices by the City of Longwood has uncovered apparently systematic irregularities that favor developers, violations of zoning ordinances, and possible conflict of interest by Mayor Eugene Jaques, who acted as a developer's agent while sitting on city council.

The Herald investigation has revealed that Jaques, while vice chairman of the city council in November, 1971, signed building permit applications on behalf of developer W. H. Green and Sons in Lake Wayman Heights, Jaques, in a heated exchange with then-Mayor Kenneth H. Brown in September, 1972, defended this builder and other builders' failure to participate in \$62,500 water line extension costs footed by the taxpayers, admitting he "once worked for the man."

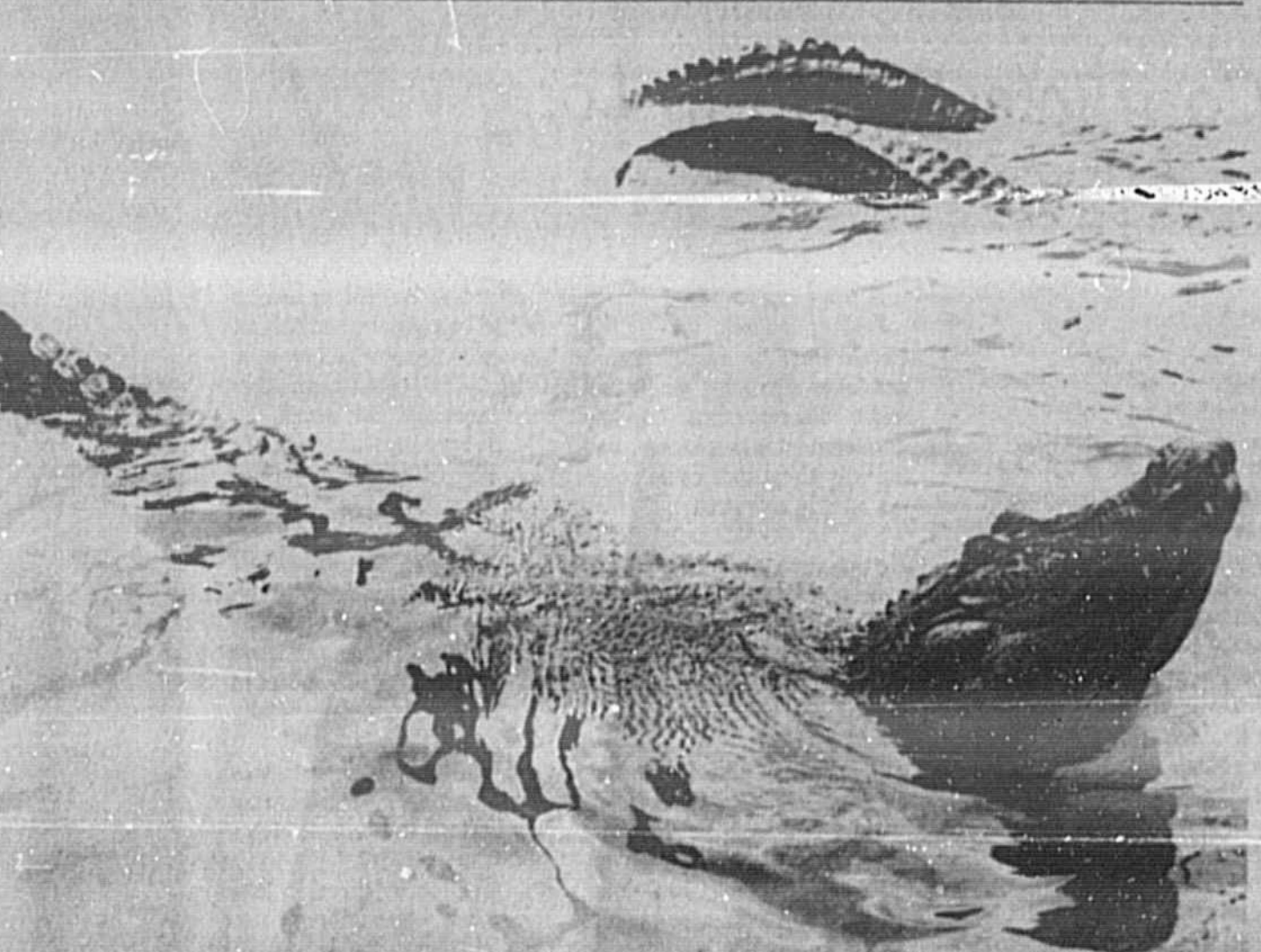
The Herald was told Friday, in the presence of Mayor Jaques and Council Chairman Bill Klossky, that no records of any such meeting exist.

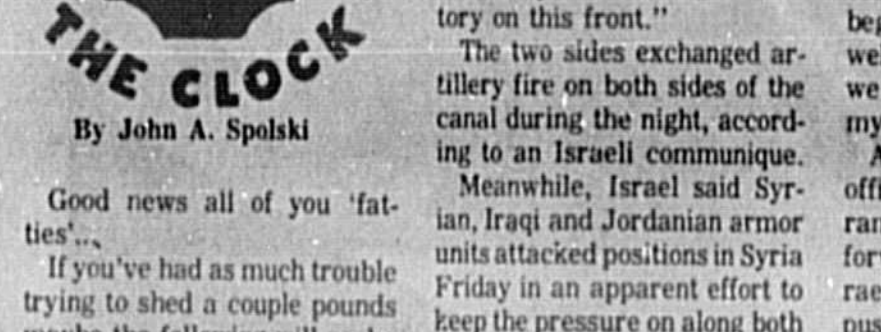

U.S., Soviets Launching Major Peace Offensive

# Inouye Calls For Nixon's Resignation, Says We 'Have Suffered Enough'



SENATOR INOUYE  
...Wants resignation

MIAMI BEACH (AP) — Sen. Daniel K. Inouye today called for President Nixon's resignation, saying Americans "have suffered enough" and "must be spared this new pain and trauma."

The Hawaii Democrat thus became the first member of the Senate Watergate Committee to urge the President to step down following the firing Saturday of special Prosecutor Archibald Cox and the ouster of the two top officials of the Justice Department.

In a speech prepared for the AFL-CIO convention, Inouye urged Nixon "to place our national interest and welfare above all other concerns and to resign from the office of the presidency."

The labor federation's executive council met in emergency session and recommended that the convention approve a resolution calling for Nixon's resignation or his impeachment if he refuses to step down.

Sources said there was only one dissenting vote among the 32 council members present for the emergency session called by President George Meany.

In his speech, Inouye suggested that if Nixon resigns, House Speaker Carl Albert, next in line of succession, should appoint as his vice president "a Republican of the highest caliber — not a caretaker or an agent, but one who can lead our people."

He said Albert should consider such Republicans as New York Gov. Nelson Rockefeller or Elliot Richardson, who resigned Saturday as attorney general after refusing Nixon's order to fire Cox.

The American public, Inouye said, is "stunned and numbed" by the weekend events and warned "that this numbness could well progress into dangerous anger."

"If our democracy, as envisioned by our founding fathers, is to survive and flourish, public trust and confidence in our government and in our national leadership must be restored," he said.

"Like many of you," the senator said, "I have sadly concluded that President Nixon can no longer effectively lead our nation."

He said that the great majority of Americans are now finding it difficult to accept Nixon as the country's chief executive.

The senator said that Nixon's actions over the weekend show that he "is prepared to tear apart the national spirit and system to protect himself and his taxes."

AFL-CIO leaders had prepared a resolution calling for Nixon's impeachment if he defied court orders.

## Cox's Firing Brings Calls For Impeachment

MIAMI (AP) — President Nixon's firing of Watergate prosecutor Archibald Cox has brought many calls from Floridians for Nixon's impeachment. In today's editions, the St. Petersburg Times said Nixon should resign or be impeached.

"Like most people in the country, The Times until now has sought solutions to Watergate that did not include the extreme step of resignation or impeachment of President Nixon," the newspaper said.

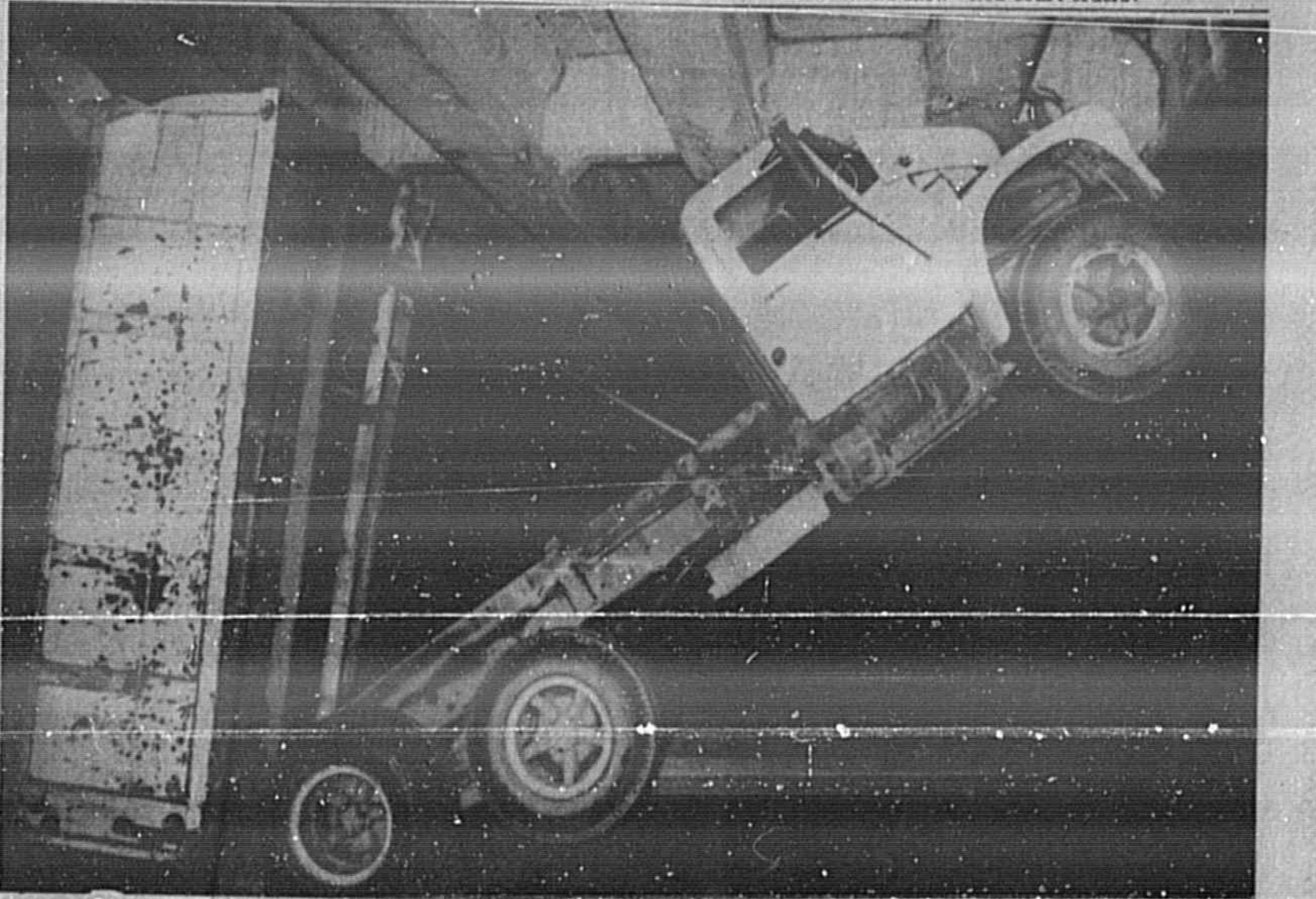
"But the President's unrestrained attempt to stop the independent prosecution of the Watergate crimes and his unreasonable purge of the Justice Department are so far outside the normal rule of constitutional government that the national interest now requires that Mr. Nixon resign, or if he refuses, that he be impeached."

The Times said that "by his own actions, the President has brought into question his own respect for the rule of law, the cement of every law-abiding society."

But Sen. Edward Gurney, R-Fla., a member of the Senate Watergate Committee, said impeachment proceedings will probably be filed and not get very far.

"There are always those in Congress who are more than ready to do such things, but I cannot see them meeting with great success," Gurney said Sunday in Nashville where he was to speak on executive-congressional relations.

Nixon announced Saturday that he had fired Cox and abolished the Special Watergate Task Force. Nixon also accepted the resignation of Atty. Gen. Elliot Richardson and dismissed Deputy Atty. Gen. William P. Ruckelshaus after he refused an order to fire Cox.

## Egypt, Israel Have Agreed To Cease-Fire

Israel and Egypt announced they would accept the United Nations resolution calling for an immediate cease-fire today in the Middle East fighting. The Syrians kept silent but were expected to follow Cairo's lead in heeding the U.N. appeal for a halt to the fighting on the 17th day of the fourth Arab-Israeli war since 1948.

The cease-fire was to be effective at 12:49 p.m., EDT.

But as the deadline approached, tough fighting was reported near the Golan Heights and on the western bank of the Suez Canal.

Syria said its troops were locked in a fierce battle with Israelis for control of a strategic position on Mt. Hermon overlooking the Golan Heights battleground.

Cairo said Egyptian infantry and tanks were attacking the Israeli invasion force on the western side of the canal in an apparent attempt to push them back as far as possible before the cease-fire hour.

Cairo radio announced four hours before the cease-fire deadline that Egypt would stop fighting. The Israelis agreed to the U.N. proposal hours earlier in a statement issued from Tel Aviv.

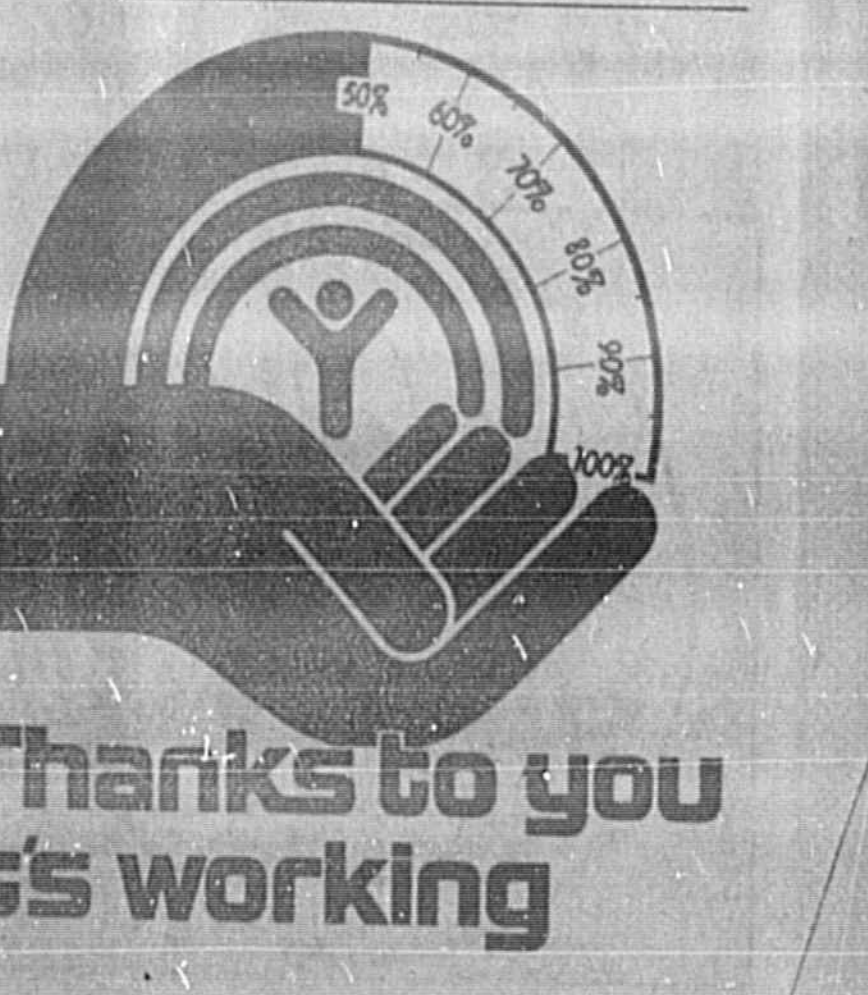
He made special mention of first-time contributors, particularly Clark Chrysler Plymouth for their \$2,269 contribution, and Florida Hospital North for \$1,637.

Only five out of the 17 persons interviewed in downtown Sanford this morning thought President Nixon should be impeached.

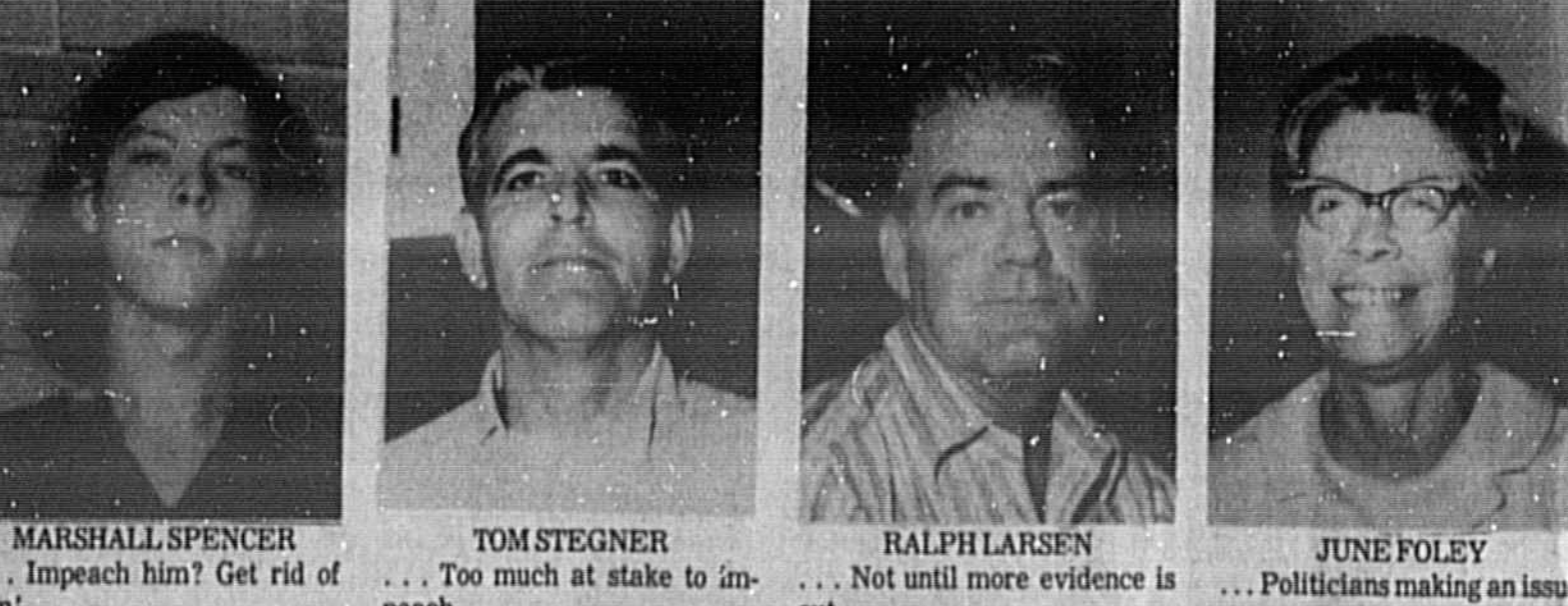
Several persons admitted they might change their favorable opinions of the president and support his impeachment if proof of his involvement in Watergate is brought to light.

It's not going to be easy, but now that we've made a beginning, it's imperative that we continue.

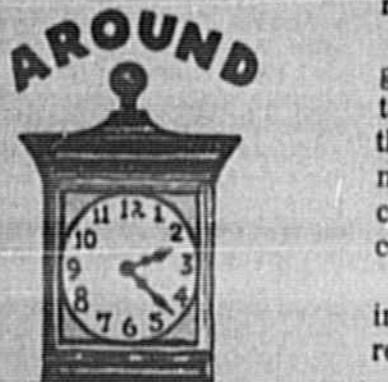
