Canton Troops Have Already Taken The City, According To Shanghai Dispatches

General Strike Is Called By Unions

Cantonese Capture Of Nanking Would Give Easy Road To Seaport

SHANGHAI, March 17.—Heavy fighting is in progress about Nanking and there are confirmed reports that it is already fallen to the Cantonese. Another report states that the Cantonese have not captured Nanking but are marching it.

Pi Shou Chen, Shanghai Commissioner, stated today that heavy fighting is proceeding in the vicinity of Nanking and predicted a sweeping an Kuan Chuan victory. He declared starting developments are imminent but refused to disclose details.

The General Labor Union has accepted the report of the fall of Nanking and in celebration has ordered a general strike. There are now idle already and it is expected that 250,000 will eventually be involved in the strike.

The capture of Nanking, the ancient capital of China and present seat of the Kuomintang, would be great news to the full of Nanking, and undoubtedly mean the eventual fall of Shanghai.

There are five American firms doing business in Nanking and the census showed over 400 American residents there, but it is noted that many of these have already left the city of Shanghai. The reports concerning the fall of Nanking have caused great excitement in Shanghai, particularly the native. Every precaution is being taken by the foreign authorities to prevent celebratory acts on the outskirts of the settlement, on the alert and volunteers are ready for a call to serve at any moment.

Former Arctic Explorer Is Set Free After Serving Over Four Years Of His Fourteen-Year Sentence

Government Is To Appeal From Ruling

North Pole Hoax Changed Cook From World Hero To That Of A Social Outcast

FORT WORTH, Tex., Mar. 17.—(INS)—Dr. Frederick A. Cook, former arctic explorer, was granted his freedom today from Leavenworth penitentiary.

Judge James C. Wilson, sitting on the federal bench here, extended leniency to the famous physician, explorer and oil promoter, who was found guilty in 1923 of using the mails to defraud and was sentenced to 14 years and nine months in prison.

District Attorney Henry Zweifel announced the government would appeal from Judge Wilson's decision. Dr. Cook's probational release amounts, in effect, to a five-year parole from the penitentiary, officials said.

Dr. Cook applied for freedom on probation, asserting his sentence was "excessive" and his health was in such condition that he could not stand the rigors of confinement.

His defense attorneys have prepared their appeal to carry the case to the district court of appeals. Sinclair's counsel have asserted they will fight the case to the United States Supreme Court.

Sinclair's conviction is the first on record in Federal courts for contempt of the Senate since 1896.

The case grew out of his refusal to answer certain questions before the Senate oil committee, on March 22, 1924, bearing upon his negotiations with former Secretary of the Interior Albert B. Fall for the Teapot Dome, Wyoming, naval oil reserve lease of April 7, 1922.

Fifteen Hallots were required to bring about the verdict in the jury room, with the count standing 11 to 1 for conviction from the first to the fourteenth. The conviction emphatically affirms the hitherto challenged right of the Senate to force testimony from reluctant witnesses. That age-old privilege will become a precedent in similar proceedings on the refusal of Samuel Insull, Illinois public utility magnate, to answer some of the questions of the Reed campaign fund investigating committee.

LONDON, Mar. 17.—(INS)—General Pitt has seized control of the Kiangnan docks in the native port of Shanghai where a number of American vessels are under construction, according to a Shanghai dispatch to the Daily Express. It is reported that General Pitt has declared the seizure of the docks necessary because of urgent need for repairs to northern war ships.

Admiral Williams of the United States naval forces has dispatched a warning to the Kiangnan dock district to protect American interests there.

DR. COOK FREED ON PAROLE BY COURT'S ORDER

Peace Efforts Abandoned In Nicaragua Because Of Impending Military Clash

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, Mar. 17.—(INS)—Efforts toward peace in Nicaragua have been abandoned for the time being, owing to the probability of a military decision in a short time.

Conservative headquarters announced that Moncada has withdrawn his forces to Matagalpa and is avoiding contact with the federal troops.

A peace mission which was to have started for Puerto Cabezas to attempt to urge Dr. Sacasa, Liberal leader to give up his efforts to win military success, has been abandoned as those interested feel that the war will have been brought to a conclusion by a decisive battle before they could reach Puerto Cabezas.

Although the government states that Gen. Moncada and his Liberal forces are striving to avoid battle, they announce that the Liberal troops are hot on the trail and will press for either a decisive battle or surrender.

The government announces that it lost 61 dead and 70 wounded in the battles at San Jeronimo and Sierra Argiles on Tuesday. It estimates that the Liberals lost 200 dead and 100 wounded.
