







### Indict Grunewald On Perjury Counts

WASHINGTON (AP)—Henry W. (The Dutchman) Grunewald, reputed Washington wire-puller, was indicted here today on charges that he had repeatedly in denying tax-filing activities under the Truman administration.

The indictment returned by a federal grand jury, accused Grunewald of committing perjury 10 times in recent appearances before the jury itself and in testimony during April, 1953, before a House Ways and Means subcommittee investigating tax scandals.

The multiple charges in the indictment carry possible penalties up to \$12,000 in fines and 70 years imprisonment.

Grunewald, 62, who became an associate of prominent persons in the capital and a man of mystery, made some appearances before the grand jury late last year when he was completing a 90-day jail sentence for contempt of court.

That sentence, which cost him \$1,000 fine, resulted from Grunewald's refusal in 1952 to give the House committee anything more than his name when he answered a subpoena to testify. The jail term was originally suspended.

However, Grunewald and a woman companion were found apparently overcome by gas in a Jersey City apartment in August, 1953, and he was made to serve the time on grounds that he had left the jurisdiction of the District of Columbia courts without permission.

### Price Of Ranch Is Nearly \$1 Million

PALATKA (AP)—Homer Rodheaver, the musical evangelist, and Harry Westbury have sold their 24,000-acre Rainbow Ranch for nearly one million dollars in the biggest land sale ever recorded in Putnam County.

Westbury, Tilton, county commissioner, and his family, bought the property along the St. Johns River 12 miles south of here, including 2,000 cattle and about a dozen buildings. They made a \$100,000 down payment, another \$63,704 is due Dec. 1 and the remaining \$700,000 is payable in 20 installments to Westbury, Rodheaver and trustees of the Homer Rodheaver trust fund.

The Rodheaver Boys Ranch, on another 800-acre tract, was not involved in the sale.

### Four Of Five In One Family Are Drowned

ANCHORAGE, Alaska (AP)—Once there were five in the fishing Smith family. Then in the early 1920s Mrs. Mary Smith's husband drowned at the family fishing site near Tyeonok, 40 miles west of Anchorage. His body never was recovered.

The widow, with three sons to rear, continued to go annually to the fishing grounds, superintending operations during the season until the boys were able to take over.

Three years ago one of the sons, Roland, drowned at the same spot his father had perished.

Last year, another son, Byron, drowned on a hunting trip on the Olympic Peninsula in the state of Washington.

Gerard, 26, the last of the sons carried on Monday, his dory, its bow stove in like it had struck a barge or scow, was found at the spot where father and brother had died. His body has not been recovered.

Now Mrs. Smith, almost totally blind, alone remains.

### Rice's Estate Over \$30,500

Florence H. Butler, a daughter, of Venice, Calif., will receive the residue of the estate, except for a \$3,000 bequest to a nephew, Grantland Rice.
