A Normal Depression

Whatever may be the primary cause of the current economic depression—whether it be the Republican party, prohibition, high tariffs, capitalistic monopolies, the spread of Bolshevism, over-production, or under-consumption—it cannot be denied that credit is playing a vitally important part.

War debts alone, amounting to approximately eleven billion dollars, are not responsible for the break down of foreign finance. Europe is suffering not so much from reparations costs, as from the enormous expense of reconstruction following the war.

These armament appropriations, together with the various "doles", a sort of bribe offered by capitalistic European governments to the masses to prevent the spread of communism, are two important reasons why American industrialists are unable to find their usually important markets abroad.

American manufacturers, unable to sell in Europe, are forced to curtail production; hence unemployment here. American bondholders unable to collect interest on their money, are forced to reduce their own expenditures; hence further curtailment of production; further unemployment.

The bulk of American investments in England have gone into manufacturing, now amounting to approximately \$270,000,000, although there are some \$145,000,000 invested in bonds.

While this vast amount of capital was being poured by boatloads into these foreign countries, prosperity reigned. The destruction caused by the war furnished plenty of work; the American people supplied the capital.

But now the pendulum swings the other way. Necessary reconstruction has been completed. Credit exhausted, governments, cities, corporations are unable to borrow for further expansion.

There is nothing abnormal about this depression. It is simply the "paying up period". And as any good Floridian knows, the "paying up period" is a nightmare. There is nothing any one man can do about it.

An International Airport

The city of Miami is making tremendous strides in the development of aviation. A ride out from the center of the city, particularly in the northwestern, western, or southwestern directions, will reveal almost innumerable landing fields with a veritable mass of runways and dotted with mammoth hangars.

Miami has long been regarded as well located for an international airport. The arrival of the DC-X from South American waters bears out this theory.

The railroad and boat lines also make Miami an ideal freight terminus. Packages and freight arriving in Miami by train or boat, and leaving Miami by airplane to South America would arrive at their destination days, and sometimes weeks, ahead of the time that would ordinarily be taken.
