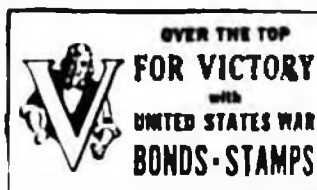

British Repulse Eastward Lunge By Axis Forces

Enemy Is Hard Hit By RAF Bombers; Matruh, German Base, Is Shelled

CAIRO, July 14. (AP)—Axis armored forces were repulsed in another eastward lunge today on the Egyptian corridor battle front and the enemy was heavy hit by RAF blasts, the British announced.

The British Mediterranean fleet has entered the battle of Egypt with its guns and its planes. It was disclosed last night, leaving flames and wreckage at Matruh, the Axis' most advanced supply port a scant 100 miles behind the front lines.

While the slugging power of Australian and South African troops kept the British army in possession of its newly won positions west of El Alamein, the fleet's warships swept in close to shore at Matruh Sunday in the pre-dawn darkness and sent salvo after salvo into the harbor. Naval aircraft had preceded the warships' assault with a violent raid on the Axis anchorage, scoring a direct hit on a supply ship. Guns of the fleet finished this ship off while the naval pilots pressed their own attack on the port.

"It was a magnificent sight," said one naval aviator who was aloft at the time of the bombardment from the sea. "The navy knocked hell out of the place."

This was the first time the fleet had found an opportunity and an adequate target ashore for its guns since the battle for Egypt began, and it struck with a vengeance at Matruh, which is only 170 miles from Alexandria. It menaced the base.

The devastation of Matruh was so complete, the Axis had been forced to evacuate the place in a 30-minute blasting that naval men said the port would be useless for a long while and the Axis would have to depend on Tadmek, 300 miles further west.

Single War Workers Will Be Called Before Married Men

WASHINGTON, July 14. (AP)—Draft headquarters specifically will direct local boards to take single war workers before married men. To be classified as a married man the registrant must have been married before Dec. 8, 1941, and be living with his wife.

Selective Service Director Hershey, in a formal statement clarifying new regulations governing induction of men with dependents, promised that established family groups will be "protected" as far as possible.

Pointing out that the draft act was passed to obtain sufficient manpower for the armed forces and to maintain production to win the war, he said bona-fide family relations would be safeguarded "insofar as practicable in carrying out these requirements."

He also announced that a list of 31 occupational activities, considered essential to conduct of the war by the war manpower commission, has been distributed among local boards so that special consideration may be given a man falling within those categories.

WPB Bans Making Of 250 More Articles

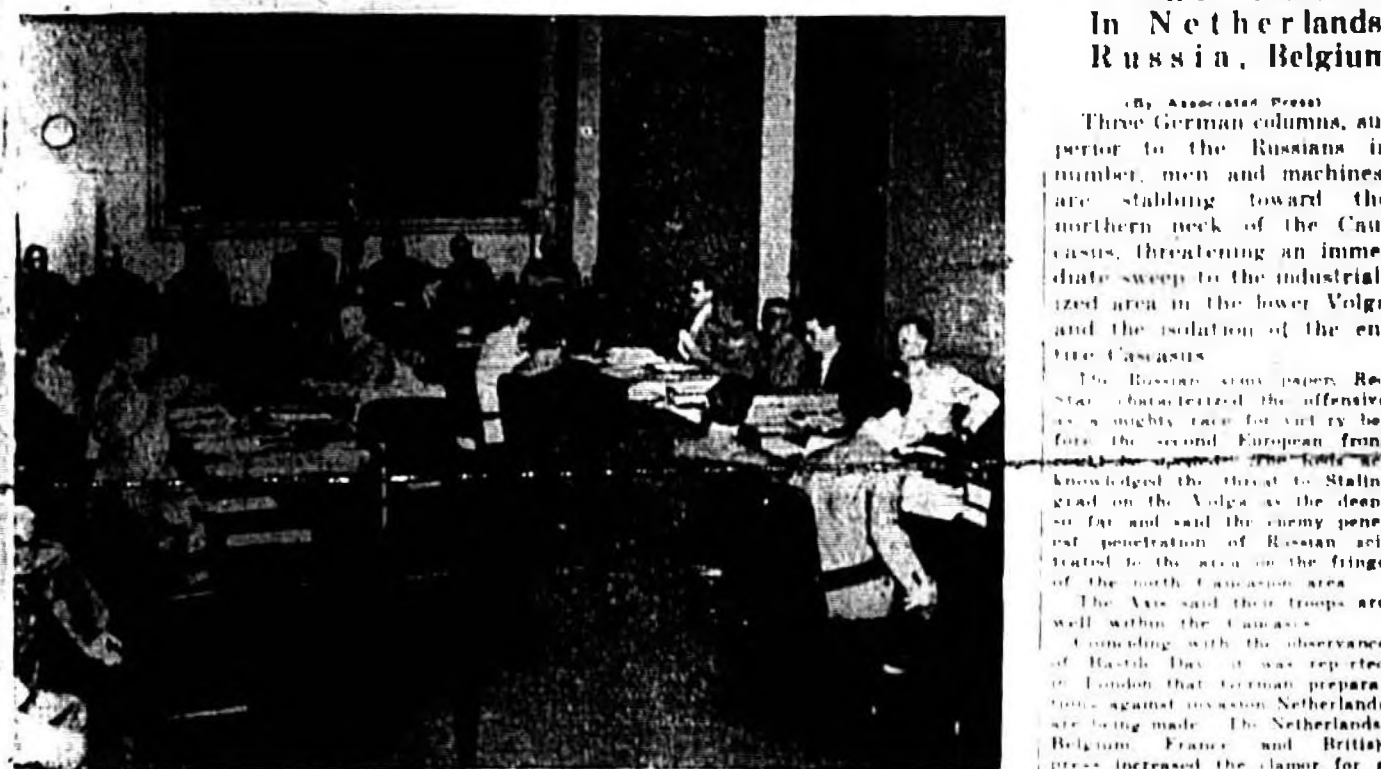

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Clamor For Second Front Increases In Netherlands, Russia, Belgium

Three German columns, superior to the Russians in number, men and machines, are stalling toward the northern neck of the Caucasus, threatening an immediate sweep to the industrial area in the lower Volga and the isolation of the entire Caucasus.

The Russian press, Red Star, characterized the offensive as a mighty move for victory before the second European front opens.

The Axis said their troops are well within the Caucasus. Considering with the observance of the day, it was reported in London that German preparations against invasion of the Netherlands are being made. The Netherlands, Belgium, France and British press increased the clamor for a second front to aid the battered Red Army.

German troops have smashed through the Red army at Voronezh and are continuing their swift advance toward the Caucasus on three great drives along a 200-mile front. The Soviets acknowledged early today in a communique which for the first time officially described the situation as grave.

In all three areas the Red army, pushed against overwhelming superior forces, fell back steadily. The communique said of this retrograde movement:

"The Red army is fighting a heroic battle. It is fighting for the freedom of its motherland and for the freedom of the world."
