

ITALIANS AND FRENCH REACT AGAINST PLAN

Concern Is Felt Over Attitude Of Latins On British And U.S. Limitation Position

LONDON, Feb. 8.—(AP)—Naval conference circles today viewed with some concern attitude of France and Italy toward statements of Secretary Stimson and Premier MacDonald setting forth British and American views on naval limitation—views which are strikingly near agreement.

It was open to question in general opinion, whether the two statements of national aims advanced the procedure toward curbing of the naval arms of the five powers into a compact satisfactory agreement or endangered final adjudication of differences with the two Mediterranean powers.

Italy, through Dino Grandi, foreign minister and delegation head, emphatically expressed satisfaction with the British and American pronouncements on the ground that they hastened the conference work by getting down to figures.

The French, however, were extremely taciturn. Andre Tardieu, French minister, leaving for Paris for the week-end, was reported to have been greatly displeased with the contents of the two announcements and the methods employed in making them.

The Japanese officially had nothing to say. Reijiro Wakatsuki, Japanese premier and delegation head, said informally that he was "rather unfavorably impressed." He said also that Japan had no intention at present.

Paris Is Rocked As Oxygen Tanks Burst

PARIS, Feb. 8.—(AP)—Five 2½ gramme tanks burst to the ground and hundreds of oxygen tanks roared like big guns at the Vincennes arsenal on the eastern edge of Paris today. Not a single powder magazine exploded although five were all around them. The loss was estimated at \$3,000, 000 but may be much greater as buildings collapsed on artillery stocks. Despite the bombardment which lasted from late last night into the forenoon the only casualty was one fireman who was slightly gassed. Troops cleared inhabitants from a wide area around the arsenal as a precaution against any explosion in the powder magazines.

HOOVER SCORED BY LAFOLLETTE IN SENATE TALK

Sen. Says President Has Done Nothing To Aid Unemployment Except To Ballyhoo

WASHINGTON, Feb. 8.—(AP)—Senator LaFollette, Republican independent, Wisconsin, asserted in the Senate today that President Hoover had "done nothing to remedy the 'dismal unemployment situation'" and that "optimistic ballyhoo statements" on employment had been issued by the executive.

The Wisconsin senator said that while secretary of commerce, Mr. Hoover used "that great organization to improve and speed up mass production" and while no one could criticize that action except one hour "it would create a great human problem."

Since that time LaFollette added, Mr. Hoover and the Republican party had taken no concrete steps to remedy the situation.

LaFollette's remark followed a speech by Senator Guff, Republican, West Virginia, who had opposed tampering with present industrial tariffs, where no evidence had been shown before a congressional committee on the artificial tariff.
