





## 48 States Differ On Size Of Estate, Inheritance Taxes

Only Nevada Refused To Levy Against Persons Of Wealth

KANSAS CITY, July 19.—Inheritance and estate tax statutes of the 48 states differ in that 47 states have enacted taxes on estates and inheritance taxes are not levied from the wealth men accumulate.
