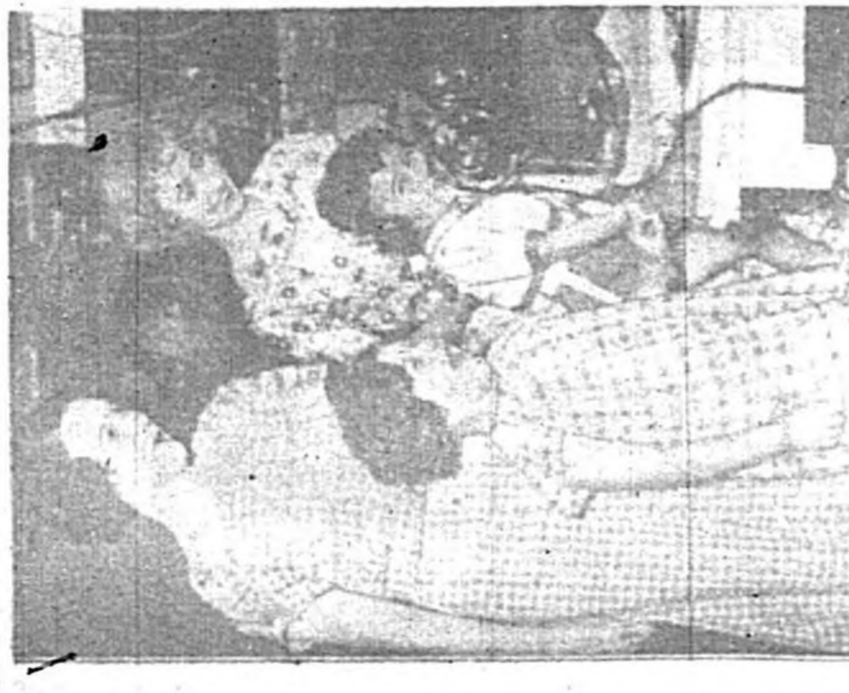

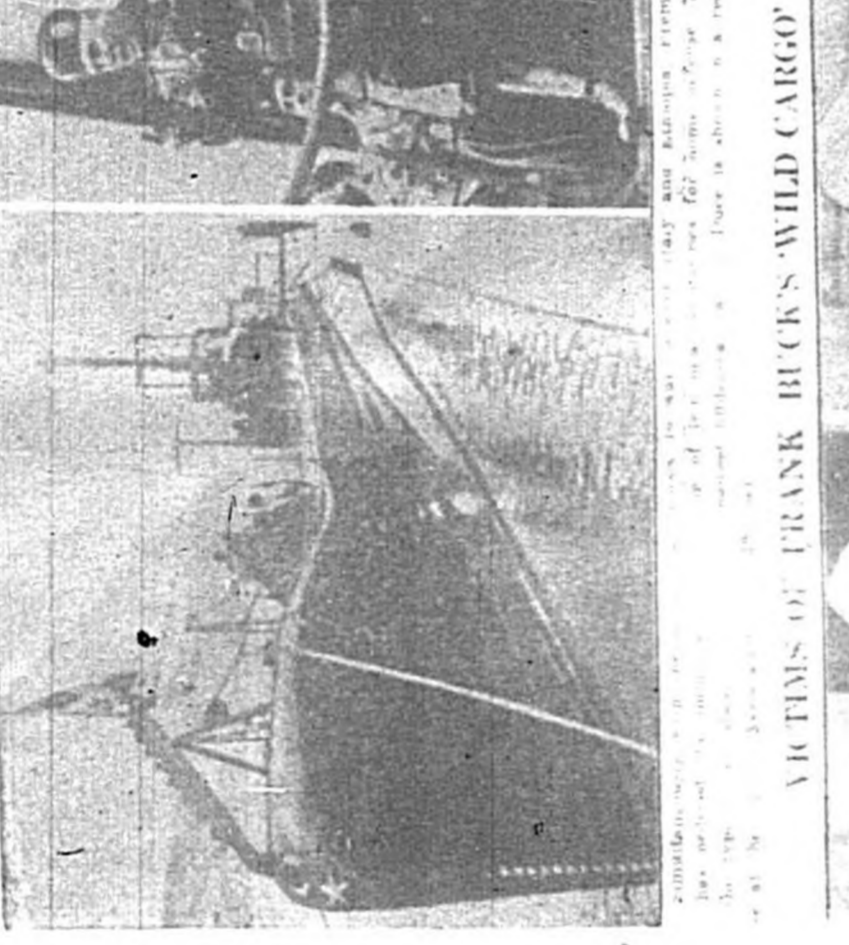

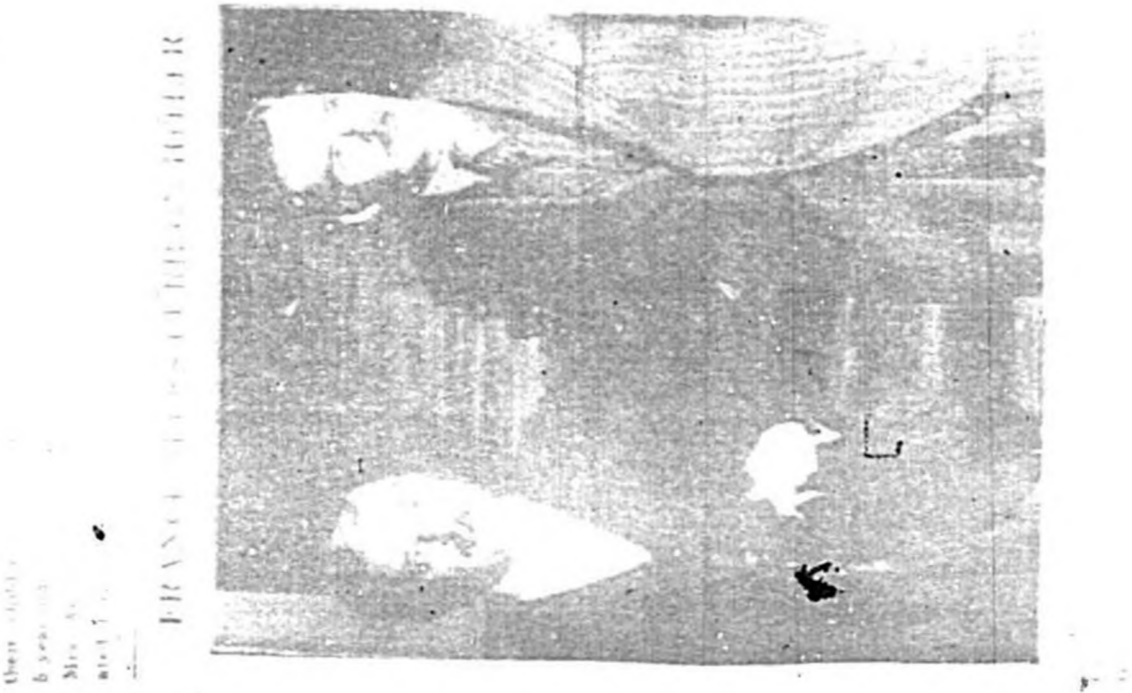

France Accepts Borah Advises

French Copy Of GOP On Choice "New Dealers" Of 1936 Nominee

WASHINGTON, July 10.—Senator Borah (R., Idaho), criticized Roosevelt's "brain trust," his acceptance of a French copy of a letter which he addressed to the New York Herald-Tribune that, in his opinion, the Republican party would make an error "if it sought to pick a presidential candidate from the Supreme Court."

He further expressed his belief that the Republican party should prepare a member of the high tribunal for the nomination due to the recent decisions handed down by the body which were adverse to the present administration.

"I feel very deeply that at this particular juncture it would be a great mistake to talk about the court in a political way," Borah declared.

He stated that his letter was the direct result of articles which have appeared mentioning the names of Justices Brandeis, Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes, and Justices Sutherland, Roberts, and Phillips, as possible candidates for Roosevelt to pick.

Borah stated without naming names that the two justices he mentioned were "undoubtedly well qualified" to discharge the duties of the office.

"I am sure that the public would have no objection to either of them," he said.

Borah also criticized the "brain trust" of Roosevelt's administration, stating that it was "a group of men who are not qualified to make decisions of such importance."

He called for a "return to the principles of the Constitution" and for a "renewal of the American spirit."

Officials are warning that temperatures reaching 100 degrees could be deadly, especially for the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions.

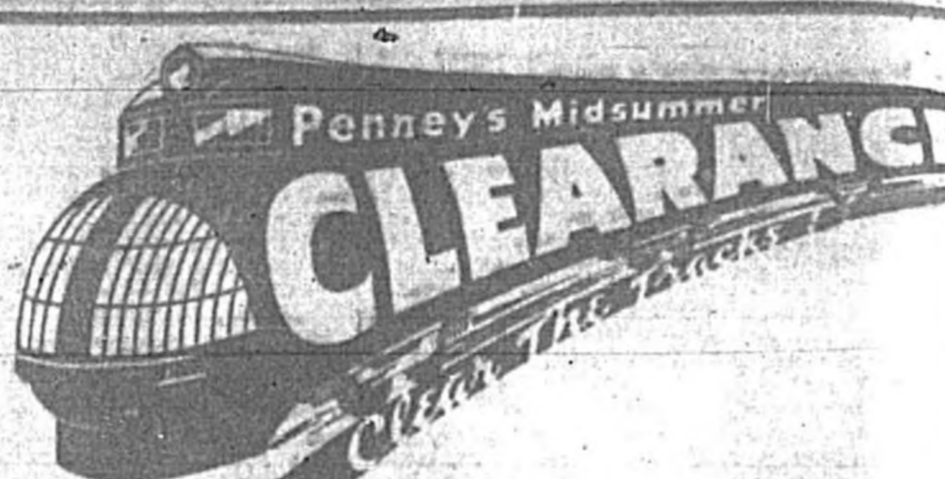

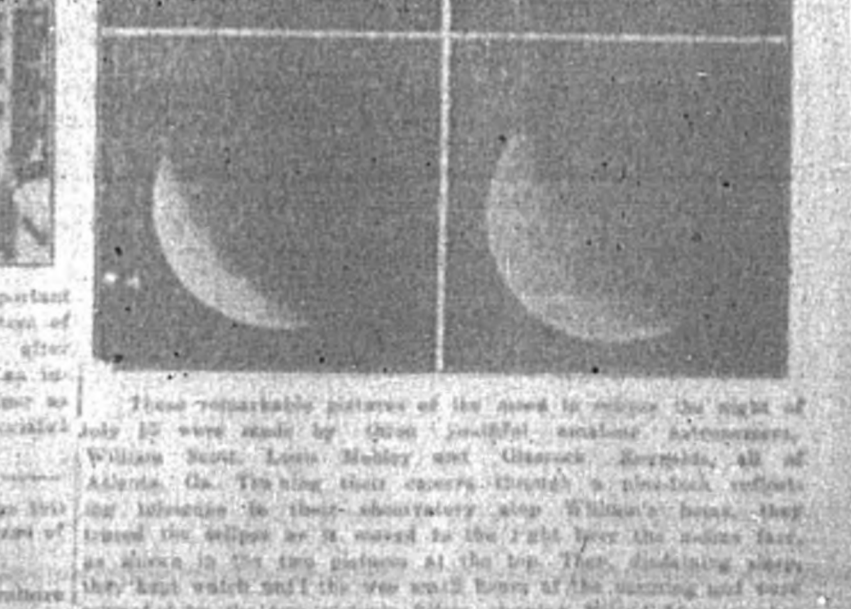
