SARAZEN TAKES COAST TOURNEY TO WIN \$10,000

New York Professional Stages Big Comeback In Final Round

AGUA CALIENTE, Lower California, Jan. 24.—(AP)—Gene Sarazen, curly New York professional, today ushered that ancient and royal Scottish pastime, golf, into the big money arena of the sporting world. With the magisterial touch of his chosen club Sarazen yesterday transformed his 293 strokes for the 72-hole first annual Agua Caliente \$25,000 open tournament into \$10,000, the champion's share of the lateral stake over play of the 36-hole match.

A sharp comeback which recalled his advent into the list of the elite back in 1925 when he, as a 21-year-old youth, stepped out of the national open title, marked Sarazen's play. Fourteenth at the end of the 72-hole round, the former caddy finished his triumphant tour of the four-day event with a two-stroke edge over the pride of Missouri's Ozark region, Horton Smith, and the veteran Al Finner, Chicago professional, both of whom finished with scores of 297.

Sarazen set a course record of 68 in his startling finish. It was one of only two scores which closed the par courses of 71 during the tournament. At the conclusion, Wirt G. Bowman, president of the Agua Caliente Company, Inc., announced that the affair would become a permanent fixture among the Pacific Coast winter money events, to which it served as a stirring climax.

The other player to stroke his way beyond the par barrier was George Von Elm, member of the Walker Cup team, and one of the nation's ranking amateurs. The Detroit amateur was first for fourth place and finished first among the half dozen play-offers on extra holes which survived the 36-hole qualifications.

Tied with Von Elm were the Dutra brothers, Olin of Santa Monica, Calif., and Morris, Tacoma, Wash., 210, three strokes behind the champion. Smith and Finneron, otherwise in 53,700 each, a little behind Dutra collected \$1,250 each.

The tournament presented a variety of conditions to test the prowess of the 115 original starters. Monday's round was played on a sandy course while the second and third found a trying wind which reached a gale Wednesday. A fast course and dead weather, marked the concluding 18 holes of play.

The meeting of the Stamp Club this afternoon was one of the most enthusiastic of the season. Two exhibits were held, one of the foreign and United States covers, the second of foreign countries with initial "S". Among the U. S. covers, a number of "coco air mail" "first days", a "Bremen ship-to-shore", and a "Zurich" "Lakehurst to Lakehurst" were featured. Exhibits of Switzerland, Sweden, and Salsania, were among the prize winners.

Following the exhibits, the members present were given their opportunity for 1930 prizes by taking part in the test. Stamp from 1929 envelopes were exhibited and prizes were given to the country possessing the best in the world.

WHAT STAMPER HAS LABRADOR?

Some stamp fans have been asking about Labrador stamps. Labrador is an extensive peninsula of British North America, lying between Hudson Bay, the Gulf of St. Lawrence, and the Atlantic Ocean. The land is shared between Canada and Newfoundland, so that in one section Canadian stamps are in use, in the other section those of Newfoundland. The boundary line was in dispute for many years, but in 1925 an amicable settlement was reached. Collectors, examining the current 1c map stamp of Newfoundland will learn the portion of Labrador administered by "Britain's oldest colony".

NEW AIR MAIL APPROVED

The new design for the U. S. 6c blue air mail stamp has been approved, so that it is likely the new issue will appear within 30 days. There will be a first day of issue but the stamps will be distributed as needed to the various postoffices selling normal stamps.

The Canal Zone has two new provisional air mails, issued December 31. The first is the 10c violet, which has been circulating since the 1st of the year, with large figure "10" in the bottom. The second is the 15c blue, which is the right with the letter "C". The 15c is in large denomination, with 20c value.

The Newfoundland 2c and 4c in violet red exchange introduced in the week's Stamp Mart attracted the attention of the club collector, who is now appearing in British Columbia. He immediately wrote to a Philadelphia dealer, who advertised this "error" and found the postage stamp which had been used by him to find a collector in the U. S. Office.

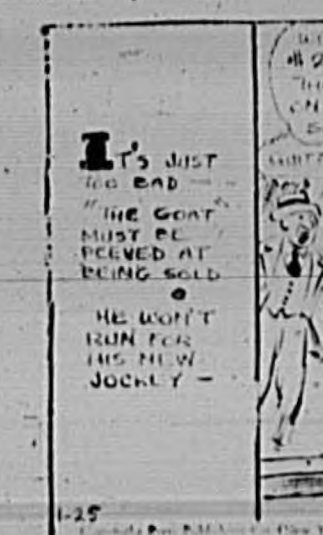
