Removal of Nearly All Wage and Price Controls Predicted

President Expected to Announce Final Ruling Next Week; Opposition Voiced

WASHINGTON, Nov. 7.—A high government official today said the administration has just about decided to drop overboard virtually all remaining price and wage controls.

President Truman will make a final ruling in a day or so and probably announce it next week, the official said.

The consensus among agency officials is that the time has come to junk nearly all of the control program, with exceptions for rents, sugar and rice.

Opposition to this decontrol plan has been voiced by Housing Administrator Wilson W. Wyatt and others, but observers said Wyatt is prepared for an adverse decision.

Republicans in and out of Congress have begun to make their attitude clear in response to the Presidential request for co-operation.
