



Latin American Growth Pictured By Johnson



MEXICO CITY (UPI) — Elected by the greatest welcome he ever experienced, President Johnson called today for efforts to "develop new energy" into Latin America and promised to work for a hemisphere summit conference on the subject.

He vowed, in months ahead, to join with other hemisphere leaders in setting up a meeting at "the very highest level" to explore common problems and give the Alliance for Progress "increased momentum."

"Any such a conference should be prepared with utmost care," Johnson declared. "We should examine every line which might advance our common interest, be it old or new. Careful preparation need not be the enemy of imaginative action."

Johnson made this pledge in the wake of a tumultuous welcome to Mexico City by upward of two million people in what he modestly described as a "neighborly visit" south of the border.

In a speech prepared for delivery at presentation of a statue of Abraham Lincoln from the United States to Mexico as a symbol of friendship, Johnson said:

"What Abraham Lincoln stood for in what binds our two nations and indeed, this hemisphere, together."

The ties that bind were emphasized by Johnson in still another way when he focused attention on the "several hundred miles of the Darien Gap" that remains to be filled to complete the Pan-American Highway system in Latin America.

Johnson said this hemisphere must "look to the day when the old pre-colonial links across the Isthmus are fully restored, the good lands opened for agriculture, and families and commerce can move back and forth anywhere between Laredo (Tex.) to Tierra del Fuego" (Argentina).

On a hemispheric basis, Johnson said that "we must give necessary impulse to new initiatives, open new paths, and breathe new energy into our efforts" to help Latin America.

Johnson declared: "To that end, I will in the months ahead join with Latin American leaders in exploring the proposal for a new meeting at the very highest level to examine our common problems and to give the Alliance for Progress increased momentum."

'Iron Cross' Member Sentenced To Death

PORT PIERCE (UPI) — James D. Purkiser began his wait for the electric chair today.

The 30-year-old motorcyclist was sentenced to die for shooting to death an 11-year-old girl during a dispute last Dec. 5 between Purkiser's "Iron Cross" motorcycle gang and a resident of a migrant labor camp in Pompano Beach.

Immediately after he read the sentence, however, Judge James F. Miami granted an appeal for the sticky liliash roofing worker.

A 15-man jury deliberated 54 minutes before they returned to the courtroom to declare Purkiser guilty of first degree murder in the death of Catalina Flores. There was no recommendation for mercy, which in Florida means the death sentence is automatic.

The state charged that Purkiser "barred" into the Flores' cottage thinking it was the home of camp resident Miguel Rivera and fired the fatal shot.

Purkiser, the only witness to take the stand for the defense in the four-day trial, said his dispute with Rivera began when the Puerto Rican slammed on his car's brakes in front of his motorcycle and "almost caused me to have an accident."

The highway incident was followed by a fight near a store at the labor camp, Purkiser said. He then went to get other members of the Iron Cross gang to return for "a fight."

He said when he entered the house he saw only Catalina's father, Tito Flores, and Rivera. He said it appeared one of them had a gun and was preparing to shoot. He fired two shots "in self-defense," he said, and fired more as he ran from the two-room cottage.

Three other members of the gang, which derived its name from the members' liking for German and Nazi insignia on their clothing, are awaiting trial on charges connected with the child's death.



Gov. Burns Plugs Disney Enterprise



United Press International — New charges of political meddling and questionable public opinion polls were leveled in the campaign for governor Thursday.

While his opponents were verbally smacking him and each other, Gov. Stephen Burns campaigned in Broward County, discussing reports and the \$10 million Walt Disney tourist attraction planned for the Orlando-Kissimmee area.

Burns told a news conference in Fort Lauderdale he would support creation of a water drainage district encompassing the 27,000 acres of Disney's Central Florida property. He said Disney's Florida representative, Gen. William E. Potter, was circulating petitions in Orange County seeking support for the district.

Earlier, he told the World Trade Conference he would help to develop deeper ports as a major step in taking advantage of Florida's \$483 million in merchandise in 1966, largest recorded between Baltimore and New Orleans, and exported \$547 million in goods in the first 11 months of last year.

Broad International trade, with few restrictions, "is one of the greatest contributors to the peace and stability of the world," Burns said.


Takoot dinners will be available. Reservations may be made by calling Rev. E. Ruth Grant, pastor, or Mrs. McDaniel.
