Challenger Leads In Number Of Delegates Reagan Upstages Ford In Three States

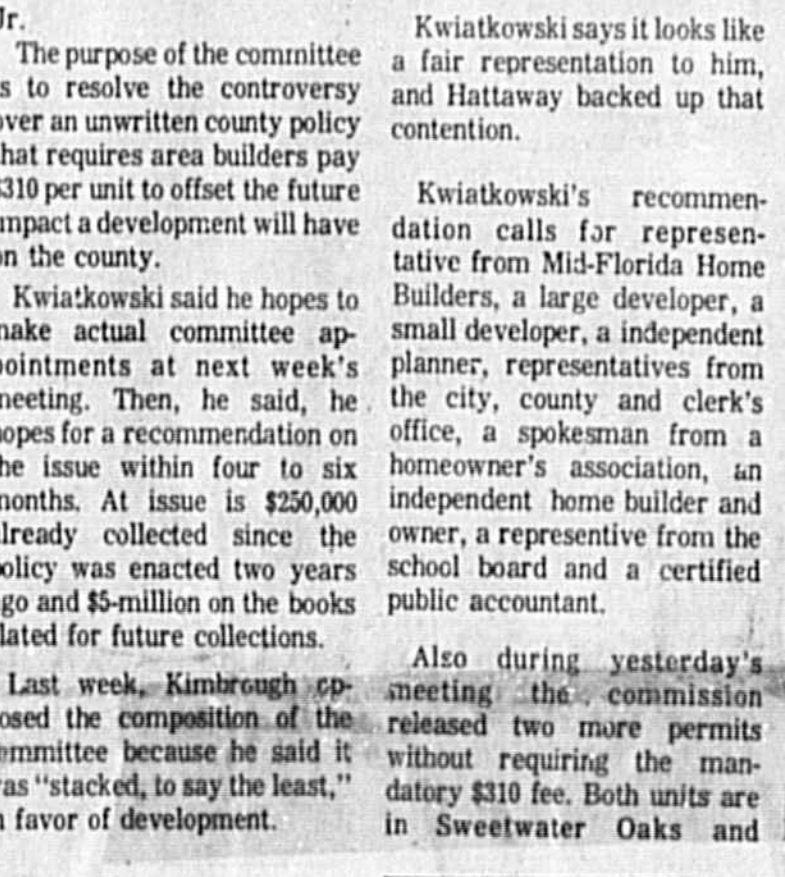
